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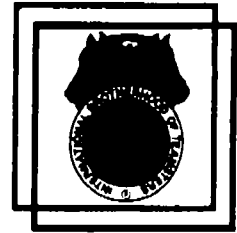

Dear President Clinton:

I am writing to you to express the support of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, AFL-CIO for the efforts of former air traffic controllers to finally and amicably resolve the lingering issues concerning their summary termination from employment with the federal government. These efforts have been led by a group of former air traffic controllers which includes a number of current Teamster members.

The Teamsters are concerned that for more than a decade these former air traffic controllers have been denied any semblance of justice. It is our hope that the Clinton Administration will soon grant appropriate and just relief to these former controllers whose careers were destroyed in a bitter labor-management dispute. Such relief will go a long way towards rectifying the overly harsh and misguided actions of the past two administrations.

The Teamsters fully support the expeditious implementation of those measures that will finally bring this matter to closure.
