"Is it an uphill battle? Of course it is," **Mrs. Clinton** told about 500 supporters at a fund-raiser in Dallas, where she began a three-city tour. "He ...

Mrs. Clinton's swing through Dallas, Fort Worth and Austin marked her first major political appearance since the uproar over allegations that President Clinton had a sexual relationship with a White House intern and asked her to lie about it.

Mrs. Clinton has blamed the scandal on a "vast right-wing conspiracy" but made no reference to it Thursday, focusing ...

... Organizations. " . . . I'm on Bill Clinton's side because he's on Americans' side and on Texans' side."

The governor dismissed the significance of **Mrs. Clinton's** appearance.

Asked at a Garland Chamber of Commerce dinner Wednesday night what difference it would make in the campaign, ...

... Mr. Bush added, "Let's just wait for the facts to come out on the scandal. I just welcome **Hillary Clinton** to the state. She's welcome to come to our state anytime.

"And Garry Mauro has been a longtime supporter and close friend of the Clintons, and one should not be ...

... lags both in the polls and in fund raising - Mr. Bush has amassed a \$ 13 million war chest.

With **Mrs. Clinton's** help, he added about \$ 600,000 to the \$ 1 million raised so far, at a \$ 50 per person reception and ...



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... who drove from Tyler to show support on behalf of his steelworkers union. Democrats at Thursday's events uniformly praised **Mrs. Clinton** for braving the spotlight at a time of turmoil back home in the White House.
