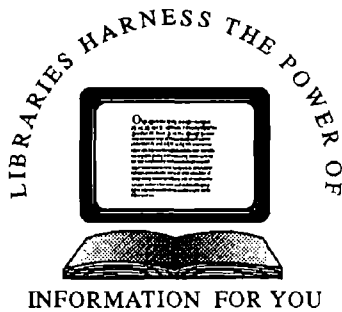

She didn't know until Tuesday morning that she might have a chance to see **Mrs. Clinton**. And when **Mrs. Clinton** arrived in Chaumeil, Allen was kept some distance away and up the hill.

She and another American managed to talk their way into the house where French officials were to meet **Mrs. Clinton**, but then they were ushered out when the officials objected, Allen says.

They were sent back up the hill. She saw **Mrs. Clinton's** motorcade drive by and thought that would be as close as she and the other three Americans might get.

But near the end of **Mrs. Clinton's** visit, a secret service agent beckoned to them. Allen thinks that a reporter for a French newspaper intervened on their behalf.

They were lined up against the wall. So excited was Allen that she burst into tears as **Mrs. Clinton** approached her. She did manage to introduce herself, give her the photos, some souvenirs from Truman State University and the letters written by Allen's students to **Mrs. Clinton**. Allen said **Mrs. Clinton** had asked her why she was crying.

"I told her I was fine," said Allen, adding that her mother was an admirer of
