1. DURING THE PERIOD AUGUST 30 - SEPTEMBER 15, 1995, CHINA WILL HOST THE UNITED NATIONS FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN (4WCW) AND THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION FORUM ON WOMEN IN BEIJING. THESE EVENTS WILL CONSTITUTE THE LARGEST SINGLE CONFERENCE EVER HELD IN CHINA. THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE ESTIMATES THAT BETWEEN THIRTY TO FORTY THOUSAND DELEGATES FROM AROUND THE WORLD WILL ATTEND. DURING THIS PERIOD, HOTELS, TRANSPORTATION, COMMUNICATIONS AND OTHER SERVICES IN AND AROUND BEIJING WILL BE HEAVILY TAXED NOT ONLY BY THE CONFERENCE DELEGATES BUT ALSO BY THE ROUTINE FLOW OF BUSINESS AND TOURIST VISITORS. BECAUSE OF THE COMMITMENT OF ROOMS FOR THE 4WCW, IT WILL BE VIRTUALLY IMPOSSIBLE TO RESERVE HOTEL SPACE FOR NON-CONFERENCE VISITORS.

2. THE AMERICAN EMBASSY BEIJING WILL BE DEVOTING ITS FULL RESOURCES TO THE CONFERENCE AND THE LARGE CONTINGENT OF OFFICIAL USG VISITORS. DURING THE PERIOD AUGUST 20 -

SEPTEMBER 16, THE EMBASSY WILL BE UNABLE TO ACCOMMODATE TDY VISITS TO BEIJING UNRELATED TO THE CONFERENCE. ACCORDINGLY, ALL DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES ARE ASKED NOT TO PLAN SUCH VISITS TO BEIJING DURING THIS TIME FRAME. FOR USDOC: EMBASSY IS AWARE OF SECRETARY BROWNIS PROPOSED LATE AUGUST MEETING OF THE ANNUAL JOINT COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND TRADE.

3. SUBJECT: DUTCH PM AND FORMIN TO VISIT ASIA

1. SUMMARY: DUTCH PRIME MINISTER WIM KOK AND FOREIGN MINISTER HANS VAN MIERLO, ACCOMPANIED BY A THROG OF LEADING DUTCH BUSINESSMEN, WILL BE IN EAST ASIA FROM JUNE 9 TO 20 FOR OFFICIAL VISITS TO VIETNAM, CHINA AND HONG KONG. THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE TRIP WILL BE TO PROMOTE DUTCH COMMERCIAL INTERESTS, THOUGH THE DUTCH EXPECT TO DISCUSS DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE IN BOTH COUNTRIES AND HUMAN RIGHTS AND NUCLEAR TESTING IN CHINA. END SUMMARY.

2. THE DUTCH PM AND FORMIN HOPE TO LEND THEIR WEIGHT TO EFFORTS OF LEADING DUTCH ENTREPRENEURS TO GAIN FOOTHOLDS IN ASIA. ABOUT 18 BUSINESSMAN WILL ACCOMPANY THE DELEGATION TO VIETNAM, AND ABOUT 30 WILL BE IN CHINA. EXECUTIVES FROM LEADING DUTCH BANKS, CHEMICAL, STEEL, AVIATION AND ELECTRONICS COMPANIES WILL BE AMONG THOSE REPRESENTED. ACCORDING TO MFA OFFICIALS, ABOUT HALF OF THESE COMPANIES ARE ALREADY ACTIVE IN THE REGION, AND THEY ALL PLAN TO SIGN NEW DEALS DURING THE VISIT. TO ENCOURAGE TRADE AND INVESTMENT, KOK AND VAN MIERLO ARE ALSO PREPARED TO INITIATE A BILATERAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM WITH CHINA WHICH WOULD FEATURE SOFT LOANS TO FINANCE EXPORTS.

3. KOK AND VAN MIERLO WILL BEGIN THEIR TRIP IN HANOI. THE VISIT IS DESIGNED TO REINFORCE DUTCH-VIETNAMESE RELATIONS, WHICH MFA OFFICIALS DESCRIBE AS "VERY, VERY GOOD." CURRENT TRADE WITH VIETNAM IS INSIGNIFICANT, BUT BUSINESS CONTACTS ARE ON THE RISE, PARTICULARLY IN BANKING. A MAJOR TOPIC OF DISCUSSION WILL BE DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE: ACCORDING TO OUR CONTACTS, THE VIETNAMESE HOPE TO CONVINCE THE DUTCH TO ESTABLISH A BILATERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO SUPPLEMENT THE DUTCH AID NOW ROUTED THROUGH MULTILATERAL FORA. THE VISIT MAY PRODUCE A DUTCH COMMITMENT TO ESTABLISH SUCH A PROGRAM, AS WELL AS CONCRETE ACTION IN THREE AREAS:

- A PROJECT TO IMPROVE DRINKING WATER FROM THE MEKONG;
- ASSISTANCE TO A WORLD WILDLIFE FUND-SPONSORED NATURE RESERVE;
- A PROGRAM OF EDUCATIONAL EXCHANGE.

4. OTHER TOPICS OF DISCUSSION ARE EXPECTED TO INCLUDE REFUGEES AND AVIATION. THE DUTCH HAVE HAD DIFFICULTIES IN REPATRIATING VIETNAMESE REFUGEES WHO HAVE BEEN DENIED ASYLUM IN THE NETHERLANDS. KLM WOULD LIKE VIETNAMESE PERMISSION TO ADD A THIRD WEEKLY FLIGHT BETWEEN AMSTERDAM AND HANOI, AS WELL AS TO INAUGURATE FLIGHTS BETWEEN KUALA LUMPUR AND HO CHI MINH CITY AND BETWEEN HANOI AND HO CHI MINH CITY.

CHINA, JUNE 14-19

5. BEIJING, SHANGHAI AND GUANGZHOU ARE NEXT ON THE AGENDA. KOK WILL MEET WITH PREMIER LI PENG AND PRESIDENT JIANG ZEMIN. ACCORDING TO THE MFA'S CHINA DESK, THE DUTCH, WHO CURRENTLY HAVE NO BILATERAL DEVELOPMENT RELATIONSHIP WITH CHINA, MAY OFFER ASSISTANCE FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECTS AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION, AS WELL AS THE EXPORT-FINANCING LOANS. THE DUTCH HOPE TO PERSUADE THE CHINESE NOT TO LEVY EXTRA TAXES ON SUCH SOFT LOANS, AS THEY HAVE THREATENED TO DO STARTING NEXT YEAR.

6. THE DUTCH INTEND TO RAISE SEVERAL POLITICAL ISSUES WITH THE CHINESE, INCLUDING HUMAN RIGHTS. OF PARTICULAR CONCERN ARE THE CHOICE OF LOCATION FOR THE BEIJING WOMEN'S CONFERENCE, AND THE CHINESE SCREENING OF WHICH NGO'S MAY ATTEND. THE DUTCH ALSO PLAN TO MAKE A STATEMENT OBJECTING TO CHINESE NUCLEAR TESTING, AN ISSUE ON WHICH WE HAVE BRIEFED OUR MFA CONTACTS. FINALLY, IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE CHINESE WILL RAISE THE QUESTION OF TAIWANESE

-- THE U.S. GOVERNMENT REGULARLY PROVIDES SUPPORT ON A NONREIMBURSEABLE BASIS FOR AIT OPERATIONS.

11. CHINA: NGO FORUM FOR THE U.N. FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN

Q. WHAT CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT THE SITE FOR THE NGO FORUM ASSOCIATED WITH THE U.N. FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN?

A. AS A RESULT OF DISCUSSIONS HELD THIS WEEK IN BEIJING, WHICH INCLUDED CHINESE, UNITED NATIONS AND NGO REPRESENTATIVES, NGO FORUM CONVENER SUPATRA MASDIT OF THAILAND HAS SIGNED A LETTER OF AGREEMENT CONCERNING A NUMBER OF ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE NGO FORUM. THE AGREEMENT INCLUDES THE PROVISION THAT THE FORUM WILL BE HELD IN HUAIROU.

-- WE HAVE NOT SEEN THE AGREEMENT AND CANNOT COMMENT UPON IT IN DETAIL. HOWEVER, WE ARE PLEASED THAT THE UNITED NATIONS, CHINA, AND THE WORLD NGO COMMUNITY HAVE REACHED AGREEMENT ON WHAT PROMISES TO BE THE LARGEST GATHERING OF ITS KIND EVER HELD.

-- WE LOOK FORWARD TO A SUCCESSFUL NGO FORUM AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE U.N. FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN, AND WILL CONTINUE TO WORK TOGETHER WITH THE UNITED NATIONS, OTHER MEMBER STATES, AND THE NGO COMMUNITY TO ENCOURAGE THIS OUTCOME.

12. VIETNAM: FORMER CONGRESSMAN HENDON

Q. DO YOU HAVE ANY COMMENT ON FORMER CONGRESSMAN HENDON BEING FORCED TO LEAVE VIETNAM?

A. DISTURBANCES BROKE OUT YESTERDAY IN HIGH ISLAND CAMP IN HONG KONG WHEN AUTHORITIES ENTERED THE CAMP TO REMOVE A NUMBER OF VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE WHO HAD BEEN FOUND NOT TO QUALIFY FOR REFUGEE STATUS AND WHO WERE SCHEDULED FOR MANDATORY RETURN TO VIETNAM.

-- IN PROTEST, A NUMBER OF THE VIETNAMESE IN THE CAMP SET FIRES IN THE KITCHEN AREA. TEAR GAS WAS USED BY THE HONG KONG AUTHORITIES TO DISPERSE THOSE SETTING THE FIRES. THIS LED TO GENERAL DISTURBANCES IN THE CAMP. THESE WERE BROUGHT UNDER CONTROL BY LUNCHTIME.

-- EIGHT PEOPLE WERE INJURED (SIX VIETNAMESE AND TWO HONG KONG CORRECTIONAL SERVICE OFFICERS). THERE

-- VIOLENT DISTURBANCES ALSO OCCURRED IN A CAMP IN MALAYSIA EARLIER THIS WEEK.

Q. HAS VOLUNTARY REPATRIATION COME TO A HALT? IS THE HOUSE LEGISLATION HAVING AN IMPACT IN THE CAMPS?

A. UNHCR IN HONG KONG WAS OBLIGED TO CANCEL A FLIGHT OF 250 VOLUNTARY RETURNEES SCHEDULED FOR EARLY JUNE.

-- ACCORDING TO UNHCR OFFICIALS, THE VIETNAMESE STATED THAT THEY HAD CHANGED THEIR MINDS ABOUT REPATRIATING BECAUSE OF THE RESCREENING PROPOSALS IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES BILL.

-- UNHCR EXPECTED THAT A SECOND FLIGHT OF SOME 240 VOLUNTARY RETURNEES SCHEDULED FOR TODAY WAS ALSO LIKELY TO BE CANCELLED.

-- WHILE THERE HAVE BEEN DISTURBANCES IN THE HONG KONG CAMPS ON OTHER OCCASIONS PRIOR TO THE REPATRIATION OF BOAT PEOPLE, UNHCR, THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT, AND OTHER FIRST-ASYLUM COUNTRIES BELIEVE THAT THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION HAS RAISED HOPES OF EVENTUAL THIRD COUNTRY RESETTLEMENT AND LED TO RESISTANCE TO FURTHER REPATRIATION TO VIETNAM.

Q. WHAT IS THE ADMINISTRATION'S VIEW ON THE LEGISLATION PASSED IN THE HOUSE YESTERDAY?

A. WE ARE OPPOSED TO THE LEGISLATION WHICH PROPOSES REOPENING LARGE-SCALE SCREENING OF THOSE ALREADY FOUND INELIGIBLE FOR REFUGEE STATUS AND THE RESETTLEMENT OF MANY OF THEM IN THE UNITED STATES.

-- SUCH ACTION WOULD ABROGATE, AT THE ELEVENTH HOUR, AN INTERNATIONAL UNDERTAKING, THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF ACTION (CPA), THAT HAS BROUGHT TOGETHER MANY COUNTRIES IN A UNIQUE HUMANITARIAN EFFORT TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM OF VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE.

-- WE BELIEVE THAT IT WOULD CREATE NEW LEVELS OF FALSE HOPE IN THE CAMPS AND HAVE THE EFFECT OF ENDING VOLUNTARY RETURN TO VIETNAM.

- WE ALSO HAVE NO REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE FIRST ASYLUM COUNTRIES WOULD COOPERATE IN THE MEASURES ENVISIONED IN THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION.
- THE U.S. BELIEVES THAT A SAFE RETURN HOME IS THE SOLE REMAINING OPTION FOR THESE BOAT PEOPLE WHO HAVE BEEN FOUND NOT TO QUALIFY FOR REFUGEE STATUS; IT IS ALSO THE MOST HUMANE.
- WE SUPPORT VOLUNTARY REPATRIATION AS THE PREFERRED OPTION FOR RETURN TO VIETNAM OF THOSE INELIGIBLE FOR REFUGEE STATUS. AT THE SAME TIME, WE RECOGNIZE THE APPROPRIATENESS OF ORDERLY RETURN

A. THERE ARE SOME 40,000 VIETNAMESE REMAINING IN FIRST ASYLUM CAMPS IN SOUTHEAST ASIA. MORE THAN HALF ARE IN HONG KONG. MOST OF THE REMAINDER ARE IN THE PHILIPPINES, INDONESIA, MALAYSIA, AND THAILAND.

Q. HOW MANY VIETNAMESE HAS THE U.S. RESETTLED?

A. THE U.S. HAS RESETTLED ALMOST A MILLION VIETNAMESE SINCE 1975.

14. BURMA: RELEASE OF DISSIDENT

Q. DO YOU HAVE ANY COMMENT ON THE RELEASE OF THE DISSIDENT, KYI MAUNG?

A. WE WERE VERY CONCERNED TO LEARN THAT KYI MAUNG, THE FORMER LEADER OF THE NATIONAL LEAGUE FOR DEMOCRACY (NLD), WHO WAS RELEASED THIS MARCH AFTER ABOUT FOUR AND ONE-HALF YEARS IN PRISON, WAS PICKED UP LATE LAST WEEK BY BURMESE AUTHORITIES AND DETAINED ALONG WITH FOUR OTHER PERSONS. WE HAD WELCOMED HIS RELEASE IN MARCH.

-- YESTERDAY MORNING WE WERE PLEASED TO RECEIVE WORD THAT HE AND ONE OF THE OTHERS DETAINED WITH HIM HAVE NOW BEEN RELEASED.

-- WE CALL ON BURMA'S MILITARY RULERS TO IMMEDIATELY AND UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASE THE OTHER DETAINEES.

15. SINGAPORE: VISIT OF SLORC CHAIRMAN

Q. CAN THE EMBASSY CONFIRM THAT THE U.S. AMBASSADOR TO SINGAPORE WAS ORDERED NOT TO ATTEND THE JUNE 8TH SINGAPORE GOVERNMENT EVENT IN HONOR OF THE VISITING SLORC CHAIRMAN, GEN. THAN SHWE?

A. THE UNITED STATES DID NOT SEND A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE CEREMONY FOR GENERAL THAN SHWE BECAUSE THE SLORC CONTINUES TO PURSUE POLICIES THAT ARE INTERNATIONALLY UNACCEPTABLE. IT IGNORES THE DEMOCRATIC ASPIRATIONS OF ITS PEOPLE AS EXPRESSED IN THE 1990 ELECTION, HOLDS NOBEL-LAUREATE AUNG SAN SUU KYI UNDER HOUSE ARREST, AND CARRIES OUT UNCLAS SECTION 07 OF 07 STATE 140744

A. AS THE PRESIDENT SAID LAST NIGHT, H.R. 1561 "WOULD TAKE US IN AN ISOLATIONIST DIRECTION AT A TIME WHEN AMERICA IS READY TO LEAD IN THE WORLD."

-- THIS IS A BAD PIECE OF LEGISLATION FROM TOP TO BOTTOM. IT TIES THE PRESIDENT'S HANDS TO CONDUCT FOREIGN POLICY, IT SLASHES FOREIGN ASSISTANCE, AND IT SEEKS TO ELIMINATE THREE KEY FOREIGN POLICY AGENCIES. THIS IS NOT A BILL THE PRESIDENT WILL SIGN IN ITS CURRENT FORM.

-- WE ARE PARTICULARLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE PASSAGE OF
THE HOYER AMENDMENT, WHICH WOULD FORCE A
UNILATERAL LIFT OF THE ARMS EMBARGO IN BOSNIA, A
MEASURE THAT WOULD BE COUNTERPRODUCTIVE TO OUR
EFFORTS TO BRING ABOUT A NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT.

-- WE ARE ENCOURAGED, HOWEVER, THAT 192 MEMBERS OF
THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES VOTED AGAINST THIS
BILL, PROVIDING A COMFORTABLE MARGIN TO SUSTAIN A
POSSIBLE VETO.

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
