1. IN LINE WITH REFTTEL REQUEST FOR INFORMATION, POLOFF ASKED MARINA KORUNOVA, DESK OFFICER AT THE MFA OFFICE OF HUMAN RIGHTS, ABOUT RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT PLANS FOR THE BEIJING CONFERENCE. KORUNOVA IS SET TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE AS AN ADVISOR TO THE RUSSIAN DELEGATION.
2. KORUNOVA TOLD POLOFF JULY 14 THAT AS IN THE PAST, THE RUSSIAN DELEGATION LOOKS FORWARD TO WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE U.S. DELEGATION, AND WOULD SUPPORT U.S. PROPOSALS. SHE EXPRESSED CONCERN, HOWEVER, THAT THE INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION WORKING ON THE CONFERENCE'S PLATFORM FOR ACTION IS NOT ADDRESSING THE PARTICULAR PROBLEMS OF WOMEN IN "COUNTRIES IN TRANSITION." WHILE ACKNOWLEDGING THAT WOMEN IN THE THIRD WORLD FACE THE WORST PLIGHT, SHE SUGGESTED WOMEN IN COUNTRIES EVOLVING FROM COMMUNISM TO FREE MARKETS HAVE THEIR OWN SPECIFIC PROBLEMS WHICH SHOULD BE ADDRESSED.
3. KORUNOVA INDICATED THAT THE RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT HOPES NAINA YELTSIN WILL BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE BEIJING CONFERENCE. THE HEAD OF THE DELEGATION WILL BE LYUDMILA BEZLEPKINA, THE MINISTER FOR SOCIAL PROTECTION OF THE POPULATION OF THE RUSSIAN

FEDERATION. OTHER PROMINENT DELEGATION MEMBERS INCLUDE YEKATERINA LAKHOVA, DUMA DEPUTY WHO HEADS THE PARLIAMENTARY FACTION, "WOMEN OF RUSSIA," AND ALEVINA FEDULOVA, DEPUTY SPEAKER OF THE RUSSIAN DUMA.

4. KORUNOVA PROVIDED A LIST OF THE 25 MEMBERS OF THE RUSSIAN DELEGATION AND SEVEN ADVISORS WHO WILL ALSO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE. POST IS FAXING THE RUSSIAN LANGUAGE TEXT TO THE DEPARTMENT (IO).

5. THE EMBASSY ALSO OBTAINED A LIST OF THE 27 MEMBERS OF THE RUSSIAN NGO DELEGATION TO THE BEIJING CONFERENCE (ALSO BEING FAXED TO DEPARTMENT/IO). THE FORD FOUNDATION AND THE MACARTHUR FOUNDATION ARE PICKING UP ALL OF THE DELEGATION'S TRAVEL COSTS. OUR CONTACTS WITH SOME OF THESE DELEGATION MEMBERS SUGGEST THEY WILL PRODUCE A LIVELY DEBATE AND WILL OFFER SUBSTANTIALLY DIFFERENT VIEWS THAN THE OFFICIAL RUSSIAN DELEGATION.

1. THE GOF IS IN SUBSTANTIAL AGREEMENT WITH U.S. PRIORITIES FOR THE FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN (REF), FRENCH MFA IO DESK OFFICER SOPHIE LAZLO TOLD US JULY 17. IN THE LIST OF PRIORITIES, THE GOF WOULD INSERT "EQUALITY BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN IN ALL FIELDS" AS NUMBER TWO, FOLLOWING THE U.S. TOP PRIORITY OF "HUMAN RIGHTS FOR WOMAN." THE GOF LIST OF CONFERENCE THEMES ALSO INCLUDES "TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE ROLE OF MEN AND WOMEN IN DEVELOPMENT: THE PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN."

2. ALTHOUGH LAZLO DID NOT HAVE A COMPLETE LIST OF THE THIRTY TO FORTY PERSONS WHO WILL COMPOSE THE FRENCH OFFICIAL DELEGATION, SHE TOLD US THE DELEGATION WILL INCLUDE PARLIAMENTARIAS, GOF OFFICIALS, BUSINESS EXECUTIVES, REPRESENTATIVES OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND EXPERTS ON WOMEN'S ISSUES. COLETTE CONDACCIONE, MINISTER IN CHARGE OF SOLIDARITY BETWEEN GENERATIONS, WILL HEAD THE FRENCH DELEGATION.

3. THE ONLY PROBLEM LAZLO NOTED IN CONNECTION WITH CHINA'S HOSTING OF THE CONFERENCE WAS THE LOCATION OF THE NGO FORUM. IN ITS CAPACITY AS EU PRESIDENT, SHE SAID THE GOF MADE TWO DEMARCHES TO THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT ASKING IT NOT TO ISOLATE THE NGOS AT A

REMOTE SITE. IN RESPONSE, THE CHINESE AGREED TO
DEDICATE ONE LANE OF THE ROAD TO VANS SHUTTling BETWEEN
THE NGO AN OFFICIAL CONFERENCE SITES, HOWEVER, THE TRIP
WILL STILL TAKE ABOUT FORTY MINUTES.

1. POST DELIVERED REFTEL DEMARCHES REQUESTED JULY 21 TO MS. MARO VARNAVIDES, HEAD OF THE CENTRAL AGENCY FOR WOMEN'S RIGHTS IN THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE. VARNAVIDES SAID THAT THE CYPRUS DELEGATION, IN ADDITION TO HERSELF, WILL CONSIST OF:

MINISTER OF JUSTICE - ALCOS EVANGELOU, HEAD OF DELEGATION UNTIL SEPTEMBER 7, WHEN HE WILL DEPART BEIJING

PERMANENT SECRETARY OF THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE - GEORGE ANASTASSIADES, ACTING HEAD AFTER SEPTEMBER 7

MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - KATY CLERIDES (ALSO DAUGHTER OF THE PRESIDENT OF CYPRUS, GLAFKOS CLERIDES)

AMBASSADOR TO CHINA, MYRNA CLEOPA
MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, DIRECTOR OF THE PERMANENT SECRETARY'S OFFICE, MS. ERATO KOZAKOU-MARKOULLI

2. WE RAISED THE ISSUE OF CYPRIOT SENSITIVITIES RESULTING FROM CHINA BEING THE LOCATION OF THE CONFERENCE AS REQUESTED IN REF A. VARNAVIDES STATED THAT AS THE DECISION HAD BEEN TAKEN LONG AGO TO HOLD THE CONFERENCE IN CHINA, CYPRUS SAW LITTLE POINT IN RAISING THE ISSUE.

3. IN RESPONSE TO TALKING POINTS IN REF B, VARNAVIDES SAID THAT SHE AND THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION WERE NOT AWARE OF THE NEW YORK INFORMALS, BUT WOULD SEEK FURTHER INFORMATION FROM THE CYPRUS U.N. MISSION. VARNAVIDES INDICATED THAT CYPRUS' POSITIONS WOULD MATCH BROADLY THOSE ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE LAST JUNE. SHE FURTHER INDICATED THAT CYPRUS WAS GENERALLY SUPPORTIVE OF U.S. OBJECTIVES AS STATED IN REF B AND WAS PARTICULARLY CONCERNED ABOUT IRANIAN EFFORTS TO INTRODUCE "CONFUSION" OVER THE ISSUE OF "EQUALITY" AND "EQUITY."

4. IN RESPONSE TO REF B, PARA 7, REQUEST, VARNAVIDES STATED THAT HER OFFICE WAS THE HIGHEST GOVERNMENTAL BODY TO DEAL WITH WOMEN'S ISSUES. IT ACTED AS A CENTRAL COORDINATOR FOR NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS INTERESTED IN WOMEN'S ISSUES. IN ADDITION, EACH MINISTRY HAD ASSIGNED AN OFFICER WHO SERVED AS A LIAISON WITH THE JUSTICE MINISTRY ON ANY ISSUES AFFECTING WOMEN.

5. DEPARTMENT MAY ALSO BE INTERESTED TO KNOW THAT TWO BICOMMUNAL GROUPS OF WOMEN WILL ALSO BE ATTENDING THE BEIJING CONFERENCE. UNDP WILL BE FUNDING THE TRAVEL OF SIX WOMEN (THREE GREEK CYPRIOTS AND THREE TURKISH CYPRIOTS) VIA TRAIN FROM EUROPE TO CHINA:

MARIA ROUSOU
DESPO HADIKOIZOU
GUL OZTEK
NESE YASIN

1. POLOFF RAISED REFTTEL A QUESTIONS AND DELIVERED REFTTEL B TALKING POINTS ON JULY 21 TO ALEXANDRU FARCAȘ, DIRECTOR OF THE MFA'S HUMAN RIGHTS DIVISION. BECAUSE THE ROMANIAN DELEGATION PARTICIPATING IN THE FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN HAS NOT YET BEEN CHOSEN, FARCAȘ WAS NOT ABLE TO ANSWER REFTTEL A QUESTIONS, THOUGH HE STATED THAT ROMANIA'S DELEGATION WILL PROBABLY INCLUDE CABINET MINISTERS AND PARLIAMENTARIANS AS WELL AS REPRESENTATIVES OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS. HE PROMISED TO ANSWER OUR QUESTIONS MORE PRECISELY IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

2. Q. WHAT IS THE STATUS OF CIVIL AVIATION TALKS WITH JAPAN?

A. THE JAPANESE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT SHIZUKA KAMEI
AND SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION PENA REACHED
AGREEMENT AT YESTERDAY'S MINISTERIAL TALKS IN LOS
ANGELES.

-- THE JAPANESE AERONAUTICAL AUTHORITIES HAVE NOW
APPROVED THE APPLICATION OF FEDERAL EXPRESS TO

Q. WHAT DO YOU EXPECT TO GET OUT OF THE TALKS TODAY?

A. THESE DISCUSSIONS ARE ONGOING SO I DO NOT WANT TO

Q. BUT DOESN'T THIS CONSTITUTE PAYMENT FOR FEDEX' ROUTE?

A. NO. THE U.S. POSITION HAS ALWAYS BEEN THAT ONCE
FEDEX'S ROUTES WERE APPROVED, WE WOULD MEET

-- WE ALREADY REPORT TO CONGRESS ON PROGRESS IN OUR CHINA RELATIONS IN SEVERAL DIFFERENT REPORTS AND HEARINGS, INCLUDING THE ANNUAL HUMAN RIGHTS REPORT, THE TRADE BARRIERS REPORT, THE ANNUAL TRADE REPORT TO THE CONGRESS AND OTHERS.

Q. UPDATE ON CONTACTS AND ACCESS TO DETAINED U.S. CITIZEN HARRY WU?

-- WHILE ARTICLE 35 OF THE U.S.-CONSULAR CONVENTION CALLS FOR ANOTHER CONSULAR VISIT AFTER 30 DAYS, WE ARE PRESSING TO SEE MR. WU BEFORE WE REACH THAT TIME LIMIT.

-- WE LAST VISITED MR. WU ON JULY 10 AND AT THAT TIME, HE TOLD US HE HAD NOT BEEN MISTREATED.

-- WE HAVE RAISED AND WILL CONTINUE TO RAISE MR. WU'S CASE WITH CHINESE OFFICIALS AT EVERY OPPORTUNITY AND CONTINUE TO PRESS FOR HIS IMMEDIATE RELEASE.

-- OUR CONSULAR VISITS ARE IMPORTANT, ESPECIALLY IN THE EARLY STAGES OF INCARCERATION, SO THAT WE CAN MONITOR THE WELL-BEING OF DETAINED AMERICANS AND DETERMINE IF THERE ARE PROBLEMS THAT NEED TO BE ADDRESSED WITH THE HOST GOVERNMENT.

7. CIVIL AVIATION TALKS WITH JAPAN

Q. WHAT HAPPENED IN TODAY'S CIVIL AVIATION TALKS WITH JAPAN?

A. THE TWO DELEGATIONS, LED BY SECRETARY PENA AND MINISTER KAMEI, MET FOR FOUR HOURS ON JULY 21 IN LOS ANGELES.

-- DESPITE SOME INITIAL DIFFERENCES, THE TWO SIDES WERE ABLE TO AGREE ON A PROGRAM OF NEGOTIATIONS AIMED AT LIBERALIZING ALL-CARGO OPPORTUNITIES FOR BOTH SIDES.

-- NEGOTIATIONS WILL BEGIN IN SEPTEMBER; THE EXACT DATE AND VENUE WILL BE DETERMINED LATER, THROUGH DIPLOMATIC CHANNELS.

-- DURING THE COURSE OF TODAY'S DISCUSSIONS, THE UNITED STATES AND JAPAN AGREED TO OPEN ANOTHER ROUTE FOR JAPANESE ALL-CARGO SERVICE FROM OSAKA TO CHICAGO.

1. I MET 7/21 WITH MFA DIRECTOR OF BILATERAL RELATIONS MARYSE ROBERTS TO DISCUSS AREAS OF COMMON INTEREST AND OUR GOALS FOR THE FWCW. MS. ROBERTS, WHOSE OFFICE HAS THE LEAD ON CONFERENCE PREPARATION, HAD A COPY OF THE MARCH PREPCOM TEXT ON HER DESK, BUT HAD NOT ANALYSED IT IN DEPTH. SHE WELCOMED WITH ENTHUSIASM THE CONFERENCE SECRETARIAT'S PLAN TO OFFER A NEGOTIATION TOOL IN MATRIX FORMAT TO AID IN RESOLUTION OF BRACKETED LANGUAGE.

2. MS. ROBERTS EXPECTS THE GOS DELEGATION TO CLEAVE FAIRLY CLOSELY TO THE UK "COMMONWEALTH PLATFORM OF ACTION" AND LINKED "GLOBAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM," WITH INFLUENCE ALSO FROM THE FRANCOPHONE AFRICAN AND SMALL ISLAND STATES POSITIONS. SHE OUTLINED THE GOS' THREE MAIN DOMESTIC FOCUS AREAS IN WOMEN'S ISSUES: FIRST, ERADICATION OF "POCKETS OF POVERTY" AND ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN THROUGH IMPROVED OPPORTUNITY NEXT, INCLUSION OF WOMEN AT ALL LEVELS IN BOTH POLITICAL DECISION-MAKING AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF POLICY ON WOMEN'S ISSUES; AND LAST, TARGETED ACTION IN SUPPORT OF THE GIRL CHILD, THROUGH EDUCATIONAL ACCESS, EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES, AND SLOW

CULTURAL SENSITIZATION LED BY AN ONGOING MEDIA CAMPAIGN.

3. THE FOLLOWING WERE MS. ROBERTS' COMMENTS IN OUR AREAS OF INTEREST.

HUMAN RIGHTS

GOS DELEGATION WILL SUPPORT THE VIENNA LANGUAGE ON HUMAN RIGHTS, AND WILL OPPOSE LANGUAGE THAT ASSERTS OR IMPLIES THAT HUMAN RIGHTS ARE CULTURALLY DETERMINED.

LEGAL EQUALITY/EQUITY

GOS SUPPORTS LANGUAGE CALLING FOR LEGAL EQUALITY BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN. MS. ROBERTS POINTED OUT, HOWEVER, THAT IN SOME USAGES GOS IS INCLINED TO UTILIZE THE PAIRED TERMS "EQUALITY AND EQUITY," THE INTENT BEING TO AFFIRM EQUAL ACCESS TO OPPORTUNITY AND EQUAL TREATMENT UNDER THE LAW, WHILE RECOGNISING THE DIFFERENT BIOLOGICAL AND FAMILY NEEDS OF WOMEN. SHE AFFIRMED THAT THE SINGLE WORD "EQUALITY" WOULD BE APPROPRIATE IN THOSE PLACES WHERE THE PAIRED TERMS WOULD WEAKEN A STATEMENT ON LEGAL/LEGAL EQUALITY.

VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

THE ISSUES OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND CHILD ABUSE ARE ON THE FRONT BURNER IN SEYCHELLES AT PRESENT, AS THE GOS IS EXPERIENCING ITS FIRST SUCCESSES IN SENSITIZING THE POPULATION TO THESE UNCOMFORTABLE ISSUES. GOS WILL SUPPORT LANGUAGE GIVING GOVERNMENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO TAKE ACTION ON THESE ISSUES.

MAINSTREAMING HUMAN RIGHTS OF WOMEN INTO THE UN SYSTEM

MS. ROBERTS HAD NO COMMENT ON THIS EFFORT, EXCEPT TO UNDERLINE THAT THE GOS' DOMESTIC POLICY EMPHASIZES THE ROLE OF WOMEN IN DETERMINING THE POLICY THAT AFFECTS THEM.

MACROECONOMIC POLICIES

THERE APPEARS TO BE SUBSTANTIAL AGREEMENT ON THE WSSD LANGUAGE, ALTHOUGH THE SOCIALIST HISTORY OF SEYCHELLES MAY LEAD THE DELEGATION TO A STRONGER POSITION ON EASING DEBT BURDENS AND BOOSTING THE ROLE OF LONG-TERM DONOR COUNTRY SUPPORT IN EASING THE NEGATIVE EFFECTS OF REFORM PROGRAMS.

DIVERSITY

THIS IS AN ACTIVE ISSUE IN SEYCHELLES, AND THE ALL-WOMAN DELEGATION WILL SUPPORT LANGUAGE ENCOURAGING WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION IN DECISIONS THAT AFFECT THEM, AND ENCOURAGING ACCESS TO EDUCATIONAL AND EMPLOYMENT

MOVING THROUGH OUR AREAS OF INTEREST POINT BY POINT, HOWEVER, IT IS CLEAR THAT THERE ARE ABUNDANT AREAS OF MUTUAL CONCERN WHERE COOPERATION SHOULD BE PRODUCTIVE. THE AREAS OF POTENTIAL FRICTION ARE: (1) THE EQUALITY/EQUITY DISCUSSION, WHICH THE GOS WILL WANT TO FINESSE TO AVOID A HEAD-ON CONFLICT WITH LONG-HELD IDEAS HERE ABOUT WOMEN'S ROLES, IDEAS WHICH THE GOS PREFERS TO INFLUENCE INCREMENTALLY THROUGH EDUCATION/MEDIA EFFORTS; AND (2) DEBT AND THE EXTENT OF THE DONOR COUNTRIES' ROLE IN SOFTENING THE IMPACT OF STRUCTURAL ADJUSTMENT PROGRAMS ON THE MOST VULNERABLE GROUPS--THIS IS A COUNTRY THAT DEPENDS HEAVILY ON INTERNATIONAL AID AT ALL LEVELS. 2. CHARGE, ACCOMPANIED BY CG DUBAI AND INTERN, MET MUHAMMAD AL-ABSI, AN OFFICIAL OF THE MFA INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES AND ORGANIZATIONS SECTION, TO DISCUSS UAE REACTION TO USG POSITIONS ON ISSUES SLATED FOR BEIJING CONFERENCE. (REF A)

3. AL-ABSI SEEMED UNAWARE THAT AN INFORMAL NEGOTIATING SESSION HAD BEEN SCHEDULED FOR JULY 31-AUGUST 4 IN NEW YORK. HOWEVER, HE SAID THAT THE UAE'S UN DELEGATION LIKELY WAS AND WOULD HANDLE IT. PER REF A, CHARGE INDICATED THE US MISSION WOULD WELCOME CONSULTATION PRIOR TO THE CONFERENCE ON ISSUES OF INTEREST TO THE UAE SIDE.

4. ON SPECIFIC POINTS RAISED BY US, AL-ABSI SAID HE SAW "NO PROBLEMS" FOR THE UAE, BUT THOUGHT ISLAMIC COUNTRIES MIGHT HAVE A DIFFERENT APPROACH ON CERTAIN ISSUES RELATED TO LEGAL STATUS, SUCH AS INHERITANCE, STEMMING FROM PROVISIONS OF SHARI'A LAW.

1. THIS IS IN RESPONSE TO REFTELS.

2. POLOFF MADE REF A DEMARCHE TO MS. EMILIENNE NGO BASSE, INSPECTOR GENERAL, MINISTRY OF SOCIAL AND WOMEN'S AFFAIRS (MINASCOF), ON JULY 21, 1995. BASSE EXPECTS TO SERVE AS THE DEPUTY HEAD OF CAMEROON'S DELEGATION TO THE FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN IN BEIJING. MINISTER OF SOCIAL AND WOMEN'S AFFAIRS, MS. AISSATOU YAOU, WILL HEAD THE DELEGATION.

3. BASSE TOLD POLOFF THAT THE GRC HAS NOT YET OFFICIALLY COMPOSED ITS DELEGATION. SHE EXPECTS THE OFFICIAL LIST TO BE MADE PUBLIC IN EARLY AUGUST. (NOTE: POST WILL PROVIDE LIST AS SOON AS IT BECOMES AVAILABLE.) ACCORDING TO BASSE, THE MINISTER AND FOUR DELEGATION MEMBERS WILL FILL THE FIVE ALLOTTED SEATS FOR CAMEROON, BUT APPROXIMATELY FIFTEEN ADDITIONAL OFFICIAL DELEGATION MEMBERS WILL ATTEND THE CONFERENCE AS OBSERVERS IN THE GENERAL SEATING AREA. BASSE ALSO MENTIONED THAT SOME REPRESENTATIVES OF NGO'S WILL BE PART OF THE OFFICIAL DELEGATION. SHE ESTIMATED THAT APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED FIFTY OTHER NGO REPRESENTATIVES WILL ATTEND THE NGO FORUM.

4. BASSE RESPONDED FAVORABLY TO REF A DEMARCHE, STATING THAT THE GRC IS IN AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. ON THE QUESTION OF BRACKETED LANGUAGE IN PARTICULAR. SHE DID ADD, HOWEVER, THAT CAMEROON AS WELL AS OTHER G-77 COUNTRIES HAVE TWO MAJOR CONCERNS WHICH THEY WILL PRESENT AT THE CONFERENCE: 1) THEY WOULD LIKE TO FOCUS A SPECIFIC CHAPTER OF THE CONFERENCE DOCUMENT ON THE NEEDS OF YOUNG GIRLS. WHILE CAMEROON IS AWARE THAT THE U.S., EUROPEAN UNION, AND JAPAN LIKELY WILL OPPOSE THIS IDEA, IT INTENDS TO FORCEFULLY ARGUE THE PROPOSAL AT THE CONFERENCE; 2) THEY ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THE LACK OF EXTERNAL FINANCING AVAILABLE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PROPOSALS. BASSE EXPLAINED THAT IT APPEARS EACH COUNTRY WILL HAVE TO RELY ON ITS OWN RESOURCES TO IMPLEMENT CONFERENCE PROPOSALS, BUT MOST G-77 COUNTRIES DO NOT HAVE THE NECQES. AS A RESULT, WOMEN FROM DEVELOPING COUNTRIES, WHO HAVE THE MOST NEED, WILL NOT BENEFIT FROM THE RESULTS OF THE CONFERENCE, SHE SAID.

5. BASSE AND AISSATOU DEPARTED JULY 22 FOR AN AFRICAN PREPARATORY CONFERENCE IN ADDIS ABABA. APPROXIMATELY FIFTY DELEGATIONS WILL MEET THERE THE WEEK OF JULY 24, PRIMARILY TO DEVELOP STRATEGIES TO WIN APPROVAL FOR G-77 POSITIONS SUCH AS THOSE DETAILED ABOVE.

6. FOR USUN: CAMEROON'S UN MISSION WILL REPRESENT THE GRC AT THE NEW YORK NEGOTIATING SESSION JULY 31 - AUGUST 4. USUN MIGHT WISH TO PROVIDE REF A AIDE MEMOIRE TO GRC UN MISSION.

7. COMMENT: THE CHINESE DCM TOLD OUR DCM JULY 21 THAT HE WAS SURPRISED BY THE NUMBER OF CAMEROONIANS EXPRESSING THEIR INTENTION OF TRAVELLING TO BEIJING FOR THE CONFERENCE. HE SAID THE NUMBER ACTUALLY GOING WILL BE LESS AS THE CHINESE EMBASSY WILL ONLY ISSUE A VISA TO APPLICANTS SHOWING AN INVITATION FROM THE CONFERENCE ORGANIZERS AND PROOF OF PRE-PAID HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS IN BEIJING.
