A: ISSUANCE OF VISAS BY THE CHINESE EMBASSY FOR THE
OFFICIAL U.S. DELEGATION IS PROCEEDING WELL. ALL MEMBERS
OF THE DELEGATION SHOULD HAVE VISAS IN TIME TO TRAVEL TO
BEIJING FOR THE MEETINGS.

WE HAVE HALF OF THEM; WE EXPECT THE REST TO BE ISSUED
SHORTLY.

Q: CAN YOU CONFIRM THAT CHINA HAS AGREED TO PURCHASE
BOEING AIRCRAFT?

1. WHILE CARRYING OUT THE REF C DEMARCHE AUGUST 21 WITH PIERRE DEFRAIGNE, DIRECTOR FOR NORTH-SOUTH RELATIONS IN THE COMMISSION'S EXTERNAL RELATIONS DIRECTORATE (SEPTTEL), THE POL MINISTER COUNSELOR RAISED THE EU REPRESENTATION ISSUE. DEFRAIGNE, A SENIOR MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION DELEGATION, ACKNOWLEDGED THE COMMISSION STILL OWES THE U.S. AN ANSWER ABOUT THE ISSUES ON WHICH IT WILL REPRESENT THE EU AT BEIJING.

2. DEFRAIGNE SAID THE QUESTION WAS DISCUSSED LATE LAST MONTH (REF A) BY EU MISSIONS IN NEW YORK. THE PROPOSAL FOR DIVISION OF RESPONSIBILITIES THAT THE COMMISSION MADE, WITH BACKING FROM THE SPANISH PRESIDENCY, WAS UNACCEPTABLE TO THREE MEMBER STATES. THE SPANISH HAVE UNDERTAKEN TO PRODUCE INTERNAL EU CONSENSUS ON ANOTHER VARIANT, DEFRAIGNE SAID, WHICH HE HOPED WOULD SOON BE SHARED WITH THE U.S. DEFRAIGNE SAID HE KNOWS IT IS IMPORTANT FOR THE COMMISSION TO PROVE ITS GOOD FAITH TO THE U.S. BY ADHERING STRICTLY TO THE TERMS OF THE

REPRESENTATION AGREEMENT SINCE THIS MAY AFFECT ITS
POSITION AT FUTURE CONFERENCES.

3. DEFRAIGNE SAID HE EXPECTS THE FINAL VERSION WILL
INDICATE ONLY MODEST COMMISSION COMPETENCIES- THIS WILL
BE SOMEWHAT MISLEADING, HE CLAIMED, BECAUSE THE
COMMISSION HAS BEEN MORE ACTIVE THAN ANY MEMBER STATE IN
DEVELOPING COMMON EU POSITIONS. NEVERTHELESS, BECAUSE
OF MEMBER STATE SENSITIVITIES, THE COMMISSION SEEKS TO
REPRESENT THE EU FORMALLY IN BEIJING ONLY IN A NARROWLY
LIMITED AREA, HE SAID.

1. POL MINISTER-COUNSELOR MADE THE REFTEL DEMARCHE AUGUST 21 TO PIERRE DEFRAIGNE, DIRECTOR FOR NORTH-SOUTH AFFAIRS IN THE EU COMMISSION'S EXTERNAL RELATIONS DIRECTORATE. DEFRAIGNE, A SENIOR MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION DELEGATION, SAID EU AND U.S. POSITIONS APPEAR VERY CLOSE ON ALL ISSUES.

2. DEFRAIGNE EXPECTS THE EU TO FIGHT ESPECIALLY HARD AGAINST BACKSLIDING ON HUMAN RIGHTS LANGUAGE AGREED AT EARLIER CONFERENCES OR IN INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS. HE SAID HE HOPES THE U.S. AND EU CAN AGREE TO SOFTPEDAL SEXUAL PREFERENCE ISSUES. THESE, HE SAID, TEND TO BE PARTICULARLY CONTROVERSIAL FOR MANY NON-WESTERN DELEGATIONS -- BUT ALSO WITHIN THE EU, WHERE THERE IS A WIDE SPREAD OF VIEWS BETWEEN NORDIC AND MEDITERRANEAN MEMBERS. DEFRAIGNE SAID HE HOPES THE STRATEGY OUTLINED REFTEL OF ISOLATING IRAN ON THE "EQUITY" VERSUS "EQUALITY" LANGUAGE ISSUE CAN WORK, BUT HE CAUTIONED THAT IRAN HAS TACIT BACKING OF MANY ISLAMIC STATES, BOTH AROUND THE GULF AND IN AFRICA, ON THIS ISSUE.

3. DEFRAIGNE GAVE US A COPY OF AN INTERNAL COMMUNICATION THE COMMISSION CIRCULATED TO MEMBER STATES IN JUNE DESCRIBING ITS PRIORITIES. WE ARE FAXING THIS

TO EUR/ERA FOR DISTRIBUTION TO INTERESTED DEPARTMENT
OFFICES.

1. ON AUGUST 22, POLOFF DELIVERED THE REF (A) AIDE MEMOIRE SUMMARIZING KEY USG POINTS REGARDING PRIORITY ISSUES FOR THE FOURTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON WOMEN (FWCW) TO BE HELD IN BEIJING SEPTEMBER 4-15 TO INDIAN MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS U.N. DIVISION DEPUTY SECRETARY NANDHINI IYER-KRISHNA. IYER-KRISHNA SAID INDIA WOULD STUDY THE DOCUMENT. SHE INDICATED THAT, DUE TO THE DYNAMIC NATURE AND SPEED OF THE PROCESS OF NEGOTIATING THE ISSUES STILL TO BE ADDRESSED IN THE PLATFORM FOR ACTION FOR THE FWCW, THE INDIAN POSITION IS LIKELY TO BE CONVEYED VIA ITS MISSION TO THE U.N. RATHER THAN IN NEW DELHI.

2. AS A GENERAL PRINCIPLE, IYER-KRISHNA SAID, INDIA SHARES THE USG VIEW THAT LANGUAGE WHICH HAS BEENW ACCEPTED AT PREVIOUS WORLD CONFERENCES SHOULD NOT BECOME THE SUBJECT OF RENEWED DEBATE AT THE FWCW. SHE NOTED THAT LANGUAGE ACCEPTED AT PREVIOUS CONFERENCES HAD BEEN ACHIEVED AFTER LONG EFFORT AND WAS THE RESULT OF COMPROMISE AND CONSENSUS. "THERE HAS NOT BEEN SUFFICIENT TIME SINCE ANY OF THE RECENT WORLD CONFERENCES FOR A SEA CHANGE IN ATTITUDES TO HAVE OCCURRED WHICH WOULD NECESSITATE RE-NEGOTIATING APPROVED LANGUAGE," SHE SAID. IYER-KRISHNA NOTED, HOWEVER, THAT THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT FEELS SUCH LANGUAGE SHOULD BE ACCEPTED "IN ITS TOTALITY," AND

NOT TAKEN PIECEMEAL AND OUT OF CONTEXT.

3. IN RESPONSE TO POLOFF'S QUESTION, IYER-KRISHNA SAID THE INDIAN DELEGATION TO THE FWCW HAS NOT YET BEEN DETERMINED, AND WILL LIKELY NOT BE "UNTIL THE EVE OF THE CONFERENCE." THE ONLY DEFINITE MEMBER OF THE INDIAN DELEGATION AT THIS POINT IS MINISTER OF STATE FOR HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT BASVA RAJESWARI, ACCORDING TO IYER-KRISHNA. SHE ADDED THAT THE OFFICIAL INDIAN DELEGATION WILL INCLUDE MEMBERS OF SEVERAL MINISTRIES, AS WELL AS MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT. INDIAN NGOS ARE ALSO EXPECTED TO BE AMPLY REPRESENTED. IYER-KRISHNA DID NOT KNOW IF THE INDIAN MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT WOULD BE REPRESENTED ON THE OFFICIAL DELEGATION (REF B). REF (C) PROVIDES ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING THE INDIAN DELEGATION AND INDIAN GOVERNMENT PREPARATION FOR THE CONFERENCE.

-- EGYPTIAN PRESS ALSO COVERED MRS. MUBARAK'S STATEMENTS IN A MEETING WITH THE EGYPTIAN DELEGATION IN THE CONFERENCE, AT WHICH SHE CONFIRMED THAT EGYPT WOULD NOT AGREE TO ANYTHING THAT HARMS ITS RELIGION OR CONTRADICTS ITS VALUES AND TRADITIONS.

LEHMAN JENSEN NOTED THAT THE TERM EQUITY WAS USED INTERCHANGEABLY WITH EQUALITY IN PREVIOUS DECLARATIONS (EG., AT THE WSDD), BUT IN TERMS OF HUMAN RIGHTS (AS OPPOSED TO ECONOMIC RIGHTS), DENMARK FULLY SUPPORTS THE LANGUAGE REFERRING CLEARLY TO EQUALITY.

--GIRL CHILD ISSUES: DENMARK WILL OPPOSE ANY REFERENCE TO ORGAN TRAFFICKING WHICH IS CLEARLY AIMED AT THE US. HOWEVER, LEHMAN NIELSEN STATED THAT SINCE THE PROBLEM EXISTS ON A GLOBAL SCALE, DENMARK WILL NOT OPPOSE REFERENCES TO WHAT SHE TERMED THE GLOBAL PROBLEM.

--DEBT RELIEF: DENMARK WILL DISCUSS THE ACTUAL LANGUAGE WITH ITS EU PARTNERS, BUT LEHMAN NIELSEN SAID THAT QUOTING THE WSSD TEXT DIRECTLY RATHER THAN PARAPHRASING WOULD PROBABLY BE ACCEPTABLE TO THE EU. SHE EXPLAINED THAT, WHEN APPROPRIATE, DENMARK PREFERS PARAPHRASING AN AGREED-UPON TEXT TO QUOTING IT DIRECTLY IN ORDER TO MAKE IT GENDER-SPECIFIC.

--ADDITIONAL RESOURCES ISSUE: SUPPORT FOR US POSITION.

--ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES: SUPPORT FOR US POSITIONS ON THE RISKS FOR WOMEN IN LOW-INCOME AREAS, INDIGENOUS WOMEN'S KNOWLEDGE, AND MOVEMENT OF HAZARDOUS WASTE. ON THE FINAL ISSUE OF THE DEMARCHE, LEHMAN NIELSEN REITERATED DENMARK'S STRONG SUPPORT FOR MAINSTREAMING, I.E., INCLUDING GENDER ANALYSIS AT ALL LEVELS OF ACTIVITIES (REFTEL (B)). DENMARK WOULD THEREFORE BE RELUCTANT TO SUPPORT THE REPLACEMENT OF PARAGRAPH 252 AS SUGGESTED IN REFTEL (A), BUT LEHMAN NIELSEN FELT SURE THAT A COMPROMISE POSITION WILL BE FOUND AT THE CONFERENCE.

3. COMMENT: DENMARK AND ITS EU PARTNERS WILL MEET FOR THREE DAYS IN CHINA PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE CONFERENCE TO COORDINATE POSITIONS. LEHMAN NIELSEN NOTED THAT THERE WILL BE A JOINT NORDIC STATEMENT TO CHINA OVER THE TREATMENT OF CHINESE GIRLS IN ORPHANAGES. THIS HAS BECOME A HOT ISSUE SINCE THE AIRING ON SWEDISH AND NORWEGIAN TELEVISION OF A BRITISH DOCUMENTARY ON CHINESE ORPHANAGES. DANISH TV HAS NOT YET SHOWN THE CHANNEL 4 PRODUCTION, BUT THE DANISH HEAD OF DELEGATION, MINISTER FOR SOCIAL AFFAIRS KAREN JESPERSEN, HAS VIEWED A VIDEO TAPE OF THE PROGRAM. THE NATURE OF THE NORDIC STATEMENT HAS NOT YET BEEN FINALIZED.

4. LEHMAN NIELSEN ASKED WHETHER MRS. CLINTON WOULD BE HEADING THE US DELEGATION. STATING THAT THE ENTIRE DANISH DELEGATION (REFTEL (B)) HAS RECEIVED VISAS, SHE REQUESTED A COPY OF A WASHINGTON POST ARTICLE "BEIJING BARS THOUSANDS FROM FORUM, WOMEN SAY." POST HAS FAXED HER A COPY OF THE ARTICLE. ELSON

1. SUMMARY:

-- LEAD: ALL PAPERS GAVE EXTENSIVE COVERAGE TO PRESIDENT MUBARAK'S REMARKS CALLING FOR AN ACCOUNTING OF ISRAELI SOLDIERS INVOLVED IN EXECUTING EGYPTIAN POWS, AND HIS NOTING THAT U.S. ASSISTANCE CANNOT BE THE SOLE REASON FOR CHANGING EGYPT'S POLICIES.

-- PEACE PROCESS: FOREIGN MINISTER MOUSSA STATED THAT THE GOE HAS MADE CONTACTS WITH ISRAEL OVER THE EGYPTIAN POW ISSUE AND THE RESULTS WILL BE REVEALED IN DUE COURSE. THERE WERE NEW REPORTS OF AN EGYPTIAN PRISONER DETAINED SINCE THE OCTOBER WAR. THE PRESS REPORTED THAT THE ISRAELI POLICE MINISTER BELIEVED THAT KILLING EGYPTIANS HARMED THE IMAGE OF THE ISRAELI ARMY. 3. ON HEALTH, ALL AGREE ON THE NEED TO REAFFIRM THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF CAIRO BY UNBRACKETING PREVIOUSLY AGREED UPON LANGUAGE. HMG HAS NO PLANS TO INTRODUCE NEW ISSUES IN THE HEALTH OR ANY OTHER SECTIONS OF THE PLATFORM. IN ITS VIEW, WE NEED TO ENSURE THAT EXISTING LANGUAGE IS AGREED. 5. THE EU IS EAGER TO FIND AN ACCEPTABLE WAY OF RESOLVING THE UNIVERSALITY ISSUE. IF THOSE WHO BLOCKED THE COMPROMISE IN NEW YORK CAN BE BROUGHT AROUND, SO MUCH THE BETTER. THE COMPROMISE TEXT ALSO HAS SOME MERIT IN DEALING WITH THE DESIRE BY SOME FOR A REFERENCE TO NON-SELECTIVITY IN A FAIRLY NEUTRAL WAY.

6. HMG ALSO SUPPORTS THE U.S. LINE ON LEGAL EQUALITY THOUGH, IN THEIR VIEW, THIS NEEDS TO BE THROUGH EQUALITY OF OPPORTUNITY AND NOT BY AFFIRMATIVE ACTION.

7. THE BRITISH ARE INTERESTED IN U.S. CONCERNS ABOUT THE SECTION ON THE GIRL-CHILD, BUT WANT THE PLATFORM TO BE AN ACCURATE REFLECTION OF THE PROBLEMS AND OPPORTUNITIES OF WOMEN AND GIRLS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

DEBT RELIEF

8. HMG AGREES THVT IT WOULD BE BEST TO USE SOCIAL SUMMIT LANGUAGE TO DEAL WITH THE TEXT ON DEBT RELIEF. IT ALSO SHARES OUR VIEWS ON PARAGRAPH 247 AND ON CONSISTENCY WITH THE CONVENTION ON BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY.
