SUBJECT: update

HAITI UPDATE FROM 11:30am CALL

--Bill Gray appearing tonight on NIGHTLINE

--12:01 tomorrow morning--re-processing begins but we are NOT confirming that UNTIL first group of Haitians are processed

--Aristide radio message--I have given Mort Halperin, as requested, a detailed press strategy for the radio plan including how it might be used by US radio.

--We need a policy decision on how we will treat HIV + people in Jamaica (as well as unaccompanied minors.) Networks are also asking about how we are handling journalists going in and out of Haiti

SHOOTDOWN--Jim Brooke of the New York Times says he would prefer to wait until we can background him, in advance if possible, of a new policy on Columbia and Peru. He will not be writing on this subject again until there is some new direction to address the loss of shared intelligence.

NORTH KOREA

We are inundated with requests for backgrounders on the sanctions proposal. Should we find a way to co-ordinate with State. Why not have Gallucci give a backgrounder HERE at the White House with Poneman also available. It is critical that we appear united and that we actually prevent leaks from different agencies on the contours of the package.

Miscellaneous Items:

--Do you want to do magazines tomorrow or will Tony do it on the road? My suggestion is for you to do the Time, Newsweek group. Tony has Business Week editorial board so they don't need to be in the group since he sees them for lunch tomorrow.

--Thanks for agreeing to do the International arm of the National Press Club. Chris and I will schedule it. Would you prefer that the group (30) come here to the WH--or would

SUBJECT: Vietnamese Participation in CDC AIDS Seminar

Nancy--

State has received an inquiry from the Center for Disease Control asking whether it is permissible for CDC to allow two Vietnamese doctors, specialists in HIV and infectious diseases, to participate in a two week seminar in early September on AIDS. CDC would cover expenses for the two doctors who have been nominated by their Ministry of Health for participation in this international seminar.

This issue is not covered specifically by existing NSC deputies guidance on interactions with Vietnam. State and I would be inclined to say yes to CDC's inquiry since the health area is one where a clear human needs rationale applies.

Please give me your guidance on this.
