Our 1999 Annual Conference will focus on the profound interaction between people's health status and their economic situation. 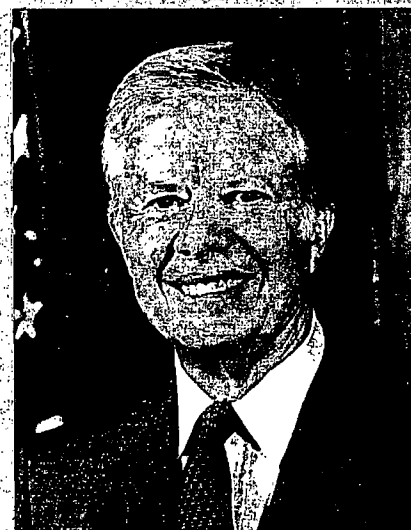
