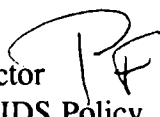

I am writing to invite you to join leading US based AIDS organizations in a briefing on global AIDS issues and the new UN Program on AIDS. This briefing will be given by Dr. Peter Piot, Director of the UN AIDS Program who is in the process of drafting the five year strategic plan for the agency. Phill Wilson will add to the briefing from his perspective on international issues.

You may be aware that the United States government has been instrumental in the creation of this new program. Historically, the US has worked closely with the World Health Organization's Global Programme on AIDS (WHO/GPA) and is a major contributor and member of a variety of management and decision-making committees.

I believe that US AIDS groups must involve themselves in global AIDS programs to increase our nation's efforts as a world leader in response to AIDS. We must continue to demonstrate our commitment and concern for other countries affected by HIV. In addition, we can learn from the experiences of other countries' AIDS programs. I am concerned from speaking to your staff that Dr. Piot seems to have booked all his available time without confirming a Congressional staff briefing or multiple meetings with Republican members. I urge you to consider whether such a Congressional briefing can still be undertaken under the initiative of yourself and supportive members of Congress. Representatives Morela, Pelosi, and Studds have in the past indicated a willingness to host such a meeting.

Allow me to raise GAAN's concerns in a more positive manner:

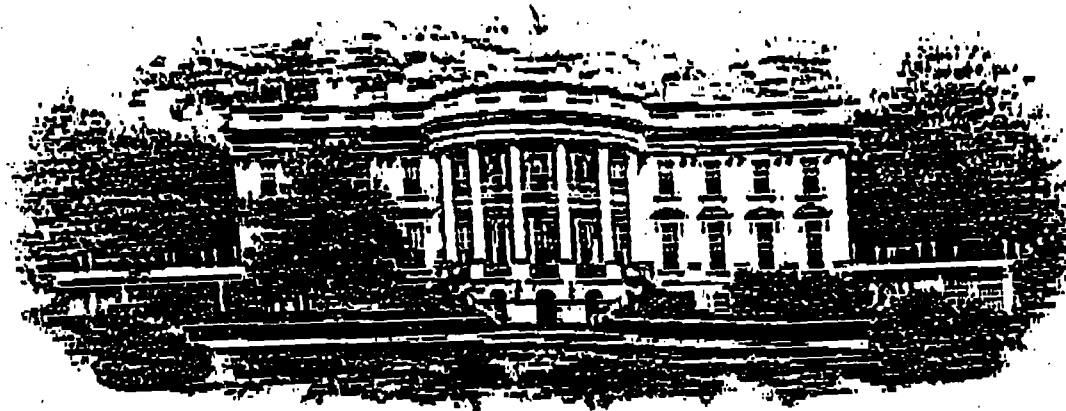
