Presidential Envoys for International Coordination of HIV/AIDS Efforts

The goal of the "Presidential Envoys for International Coordination of HIV/AIDS Efforts (PEACs) initiative" is to help correct "the inadequate coordination at the international level and the lack of funds, capacity, and in some cases, cooperation and commitment at the national level"¹ that exists in the face of the HIV/AIDS pandemic.

To meet this goal PEACs is designed around three broad concepts:

1. **Intensify:** The level of international efforts against HIV/AIDS must be drastically intensified.
2. **Coordinate:** International efforts against HIV/AIDS will only succeed if they are coordinated and focused on shared goals. The UN must continue to play a central role in this mobilization.
3. **Speed:** More bureaucracy is not the answer, this pandemic calls for streamlined and fast-tracked solutions.

The Plan

- 1) **Designation of Presidential Envoys for International AIDS Cooperation (PEACs) by all the major donor states (G-7+) and affected states.**

These Envoys then comprise a high-level international forum (the PEACs Forum) established to intensify and coordinate international action to combat HIV/AIDS.

The PEACs and their international forum² would be announced at a major AIDS event as a U.S. / ONAP - lead initiative³. A bolstered UNAIDS would be the nexus of the PEACs forum.

- a) International lobbying effort to urge other countries to create PEACs
- b) Coordinate concept with UNAIDS
 - i) Could require a re-engineering of UNAIDS mandate, role and stature⁴

- ii) UNAIDS to act as nexus for the PEACs forum. (Improving on the similar role of UNMAS in international mine action)
- c) National / International lobbying effort to coordinate the PEACs forum with major donor organizations⁵
 - i) ONAP, US PEAC and/or USUN Permanent Representative could hold coordinating forums with major US donors
- d) Announcement of PEACs and their international forum⁶ with initial plan of action (ONAP, US PEAC and int. Partners)
 - i) PEACs Forum then dedicated to creation and execution of a "specific plan [among African Governments, Donor Governments, the UN system, NGOs and the private sector] for major mobilization, intensification [and coordination] of international efforts to address the AIDS epidemic in Africa."⁷
- (1) PEACs Forum should create 2 reasonable but aggressive goals for international HIV/AIDS cooperation:
 - (a) A qualitative goal e.g. "Stop HIV growth in Africa by 2010"
 - (b) A quantitative goal e.g. "Raise, internationally, \$3 billion per year to combat HIV/AIDS."
- e) The UN Millennium Summit would have a heavy focus on the PEACs initiative, specifically the PEACs Forum's international goals for HIV/AIDS cooperation (a) and (b) above.
