Dear Patsy and Lehoma

May I take the opportunity to ask you to please pass on this fax to the INS in Washington, in order for me to try and clarify my situation, the urgency of needing to attend the meeting in the hope that I will be issued with an emergency waiver.

Let me begin with a few practical points.

1. We only received our invitations to attend the meeting on Monday, and received tentative travel itineraries on Tuesday. (My travel itinerary was only confirmed today - 26 October). This is as I am sure you are aware how the United Nations works as they have to go through various levels to get approval for expenditure, and it is difficult for us to apply for a visa, without the necessary documentation.
2. After the board meeting, a number of board members are attending the International HIV/AIDS conference in Santiago de Chile (15-18 November), they have been supported by GPA/WHO, and the money has been transferred to our central bank account in Amsterdam, I am supposed to bring their money (travel costs, registration fee, hotel accommodation and allowances) with me to New York to distribute. If I am not there these people (4) will not be able to attend the conference in Santiago.
3. As the delegates to the UNDP meeting are not receiving a per diem, GNP+ has managed to get a minimal per diem (US15) per person per day, and this money is also supposed to be taken with me to New York.
4. The meeting packages (with the necessary documentation, policy papers etc) is being prepared in Amsterdam, and I am meant to bring these with me.
5. At the meeting in New York, my new work contract has to be discussed and drawn up with the relevant portfolios on the board. This is even more urgent in that my partner has been denied a permit to stay in the Netherlands, (partly on the grounds of me not having a contract longer than a year) and we are in the process of appealing. His appeal expires on 9 November, and by that time the attorney has requested me to fax a copy of the new contract from New York in order to strengthen the appeal.

6. There are discussions and agenda items to be discussed at this meeting, that at this stage only I am able to give input into (Global Training Program, Global Speakers Bureau, environmental scan), as many of these programs have been initiated by me in my capacity as co ordinator.

I know that the INS does not have to take any of this into consideration, but I urgently request them to do so, as the opportunity created by this meeting will not be able to be repeated again in the foreseeable future. There are people coming from all over the world (and it is difficult to change their travel itineraries), facilitators coming from New Zealand, Australia and South Africa have confirmed their attendance from very busy schedules, and it is indeed very difficult to postpone or try and co-ordinate another time for this meeting.

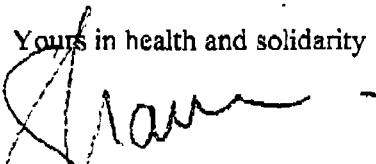
A number of our funders are awaiting the outcome of this meeting, as to whether to continue funding GNP+ or not, our external evaluation has taken 3 months to complete, and part of this workshop is culminating in the end result of the workshop. I cannot imagine not being able to attend the meeting, as it is indeed a very important and historical meeting for the network.

Circumstances have not allowed me to go through the proper procedures in order to apply for a waiver, and the lesson that I have learnt is that in future I have to ensure that agencies and organization that we work with have to allow sufficient time to apply for visas. I therefore, urgently plead with INS to allow me an emergency waiver to attend this meeting, I am scheduled to leave for New York on Saturday 28 October, and to leave New York on November 13 - and would therefore appreciate INS' understanding in this situation.

I have enclosed 3 Annexes (Letter from GPA stating that they are supporting the meeting in Santiago, a letter from our Financial Director stating that the discussions with regards to my work permit are taking place in New York, and a letter of support, sent to the American Consulate in the Netherlands, by the previous Chairperson of the Global Management committee of the Global Program on AIDS).

I look forward to hearing from you in anticipation, and thank you in advance for your consideration.

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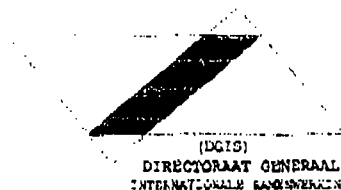

Dear Patsy

I am writing this letter to you as a matter of urgency, and requesting some advice and possible assistance from you. I do not wish to "abuse" my relationship with you, or my 'brother' Jacob Gayle, but I and GNP+ would be in a bit of a predicament if I am unable to attend our strategic planning meeting in New York.

I believe that Jairo Pedraza has been speaking to you about the importance of the board meeting, as well as the importance of us having the strategic planning meeting with UNDP. However, I currently have an American Visa which expires on the 29 October 1995, and therefore had to apply for a new visa in order to attend this important meeting.

On applying for my visa at the American consulate in Amsterdam this morning, they requested me to collect the visa this afternoon. When they punched in my name into the computer there was an alert from NIS, with regards to future visa applications from me. The code on the alert is the code for communicable diseases and when I enquired to the visa supervisor what it means, she said that they would have to contact South Africa to find out, and that she can only imagine that it has something to do with HIV, as I do not have any other communicable diseases.

It all came about last year, when I was in New York representing my country at the gay games. I had been issued with an American Visa a number of years ago, and decided to travel on this visa to the states. I also did not wish to apply for the HIV waiver, as I have been a vigorous campaigner to have this senseless and discriminatory law repealed.

While in New York I appeared on a television chat show, and was interviewed by a number of press with regards to being a positive athlete who had not applied for the waiver. The NIS had apparently no comment on the situation. It is clear however now,

that the alert stems from that source. The visa supervisor did also state that because of the "nature of the case", it could take anything from 3 - 6 weeks to apply for a waiver.

Applying for a waiver goes against everything that I have stood for and fought for in my contribution to the HIV restriction law, but the meeting that GNP+ is having in New York has taken months to organise and arrange, 16 board members are travelling from all over the world, and it is a historical moment and turning point for GNP+, and if it means having to apply for an emergency waiver to attend the meeting I will, and attempt to continue my battle on another front, and in another manner.

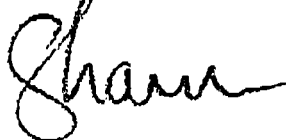

Dear Patsy and Lehoma

May I take the opportunity to ask you to please pass on this fax to the INS in Washington, in order for me to try and clarify my situation, the urgency of needing to attend the meeting in the hope that I will be issued with an emergency waiver.

Let me begin with a few practical points.

1. We only received our invitations to attend the meeting on Monday, and received tentative travel itineraries on Tuesday. (My travel itinerary was only confirmed today - 26 October). This is as I am sure you are aware how the United Nations works as they have to go through various levels to get approval for expenditure, and it is difficult for us to apply for a visa, without the necessary documentation.
2. After the board meeting, a number of board members are attending the International HIV/AIDS conference in Santiago de Chile (15 - 18 November), they have been supported by GPA/WHO, and the money has been transferred to our central bank account in Amsterdam, I am supposed to bring their money (travel costs, registration fee, hotel accommodation and allowances) with me to New York to distribute. If I am not there these people (4) will not be able to attend the conference in Santiago.
3. As the delegates to the UNDP meeting are not receiving a per diem, GNP+ has managed to get a minimal per diem (US\$15) per person per day, and this money is also supposed to be taken with me to New York
4. The meeting packages (with the necessary documentation, policy papers etc) is being prepared in Amsterdam, and I am meant to bring these with me.
5. At the meeting in New York, my new work contract has to be discussed and drawn up with the relevant portfolios on the board, This is even more urgent in that my partner has been denied a permit to stay in the Netherlands, (partly on the grounds of me not having a contract longer than a year) and we are in the process of appealing. His appeal expires on 9 November, and by that time the attorney has requested me to fax a copy of the new contract from New York in order to strengthen the appeal

6. There are discussions and agenda items to be discussed at this meeting, that at this stage only I am able to give input into (Global Training Program, Global Speakers Bureau, environmental scan), as many of these programs have been initiated by me in my capacity as co ordinator.

I know that the INS does not have to take any of this into consideration, but I urgently request them to do so, as the opportunity created by this meeting will not be able to be repeated again in the foreseeable future. There are people coming from all over the world (and it is difficult to change their travel itineraries), facilitators coming from New Zealand, Australia and South Africa have confirmed their attendance from very busy schedules, and it is indeed very difficult to postpone or try and co-ordinate another time for this meeting.

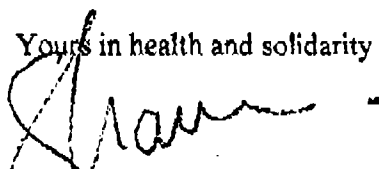
A number of our funders are awaiting the outcome of this meeting, as to whether to continue funding GNP+ or not, our external evaluation has taken 3 months to complete, and part of this workshop is culminating in the end result of the workshop. I cannot imagine not being able to attend the meeting, as it is indeed a very important and historical meeting for the network.

Circumstances have not allowed me to go through the proper procedures in order to apply for a waiver, and the lesson that I have learnt is that in future I have to ensure that agencies and organization that we work with have to allow sufficient time to apply for visas. I therefore, urgently plead with INS to allow me an emergency waiver to attend this meeting. I am scheduled to leave for New York on Saturday 28 October, and to leave New York on November 13 - and would therefore appreciate INS' understanding in this situation.

I have enclosed 3 Annexes (Letter from GPA stating that they are supporting the meeting in Santiago, a letter from our Financial Director stating that the discussions with regards to my work permit are taking place in New York, and a letter of support, sent to the American Consulate in the Netherlands, by the previous Chairperson of the Global Management committee of the Global Program on AIDS).

I look forward to hearing from you in anticipation, and thank you in advance for your consideration.

NOTE TO LAHOMA ROMOCKI

Re: Individuals stopping in the U.S.
enroute to the Vancouver AIDS Conference

Responding to your request, you will find enclosed a copy of a letter dated January 18, 1994 from the Assistant Secretary for Health to an official at the State Department recommending that she in turn recommend to INS the establishment of appropriate procedures to permit HIV-infected aliens to enter the U.S. to attend the Gay Games. The letter also suggested that the procedures avoid establishment of any permanent documentation in the alien's passport reflecting HIV status.

I am also including a general summary of INS procedures that had been in place until 1993 to address this issue. In October 1993 I was informally advised that INS had delegated responsibility for granting waivers to its district directors, and it was unclear whether the pre-existing procedures were any longer in effect except to the extent individual directors chose to employ them in their districts. Perhaps for that reason the January 18 letter was drafted in general terms. You may wish to check with State and/or INS as to whether a letter modeled after the January 18 letter will serve your purposes and, if so, whether the addressee is the same.

The conference about which you are concerned, of course, is not one that will take place in the U.S., and any letter dealing with aliens entering the U.S. in connection with that conference would have to address the issue of why it is nevertheless important to grant waivers in this distinguishable context. However, to the extent a letter is developed that reasonably justifies granting these waivers, I would anticipate that Dr. Lee would probably be willing to sign the letter, although I have not spoken to him about the matter.

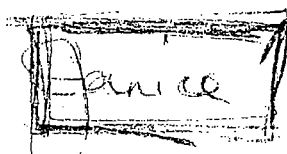

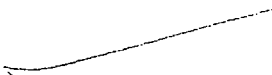

As you know, Section 212(d)(3) of the Immigration and Naturalization Act gives the INS discretionary waiver authority to temporarily admit as non-immigrants those aliens who would otherwise be inadmissible due to HIV infection. My understanding is that the waiver authority would most expeditiously be effected in connection with the Gay Games if an official recommendation were submitted to the INS from you.

The Gay Games is an international, noncommercial athletic event, modeled on the tradition of the Olympics. Some of the competitors will likely be persons with HIV disease. Denial of entry to persons with this disability, even though they are physically able to compete in a demanding sport, would be directly contrary to the public health policies of supporting participation by individuals with disabilities in our society, of acknowledging their achievements in a health-related context such as athletics, and of avoiding the stigmatization of persons with a particular disease.

Accordingly, I recommend that the INS put in place a mechanism to permit HIV-infected persons to travel to the U.S. under

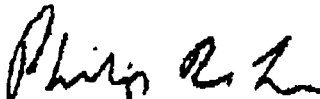

HIV Seropositive Travelers to the U.S.

In June 1993 Congress passed a law requiring the etiologic agent for AIDS to be included on the list of "communicable diseases of public health significance" for purposes of determining ineligibility for visas to the U.S.

However, HIV-infected nonimmigrant travelers may visit the U.S. under either of the following waiver procedures:

Thirty-day Waiver: HIV infected aliens may apply for a waiver to attend conferences, receive medical treatment, visit close family members, or conduct temporary business activities in the U.S. for a period of up to 30 days.

Ten-Day Waiver: A 10-day waiver is also available for nonimmigrants seeking to attend scientific, professional, and academic conferences, or other events which the Secretary of HHS advises are in the public interest.

The advantage of the 10-day waiver is that, when going to a conference so designated, the visa applicant is not required to address his or her HIV status in requesting a visa.
