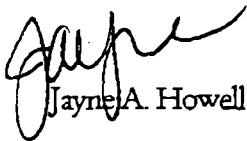
Sarah:

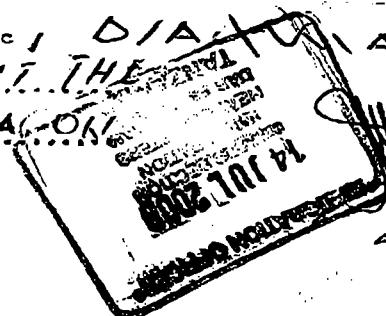
