As Jen notes, we need to vet the builders for the Westfield Village project that is intended to be the site of our LA climate change event. The event is to launch the Partnership for Advancing Technologies in Housing, a public-private partnership to develop and bring to market homes that are 50% more energy efficient, affordable, durable, etc. Westfield Village is in effect the first PATH pilot -- a planned development of 186 houses on the border of LA and San Fernando.

The builders are the Lee Group and Braemar Urban Ventures. A Fannie Mae flyer for the project (Fannie Mae is an equity partner) says "the principals of the two companies have over 100 years of combined experience in home building in Southern California. Both companies have received numerous awards for their developments and are recognized leaders in the development of affordable homeownership developments in Southern California."

I did not quite understand your e-mail this morning -- or I misread it --

If your question is whether we should have a member of the German Federation of Labor --or the a representative from the German Auto Workers -- this is the idea that I thought may be interested -- if the question is whether we should bring someone from the US Labor Movement -- like someone from the UAW --- I do not think we should do that at all ---

first, the afl-cio has basicially said to me -- if we want to do this -- they won't make a fuss --

second, we have also told the uaw that we may do this --- they have not said NO --- and I have not pushed it further, especially since this was an on again/off again thing

Third, and frankly we do not have a very good working relationship w/ the UAW -- they have opposed us strongly on just about every International economic proposal we have --so if we think that taking them on the trip would somehow inoculate us --- I think it would cause more problems --- sorry, if i was off in the wrong direction -- but thanks for checking w/ me -- i would be happy to talk w/ sylvia more extensively on her return.

This is an initial response to Karen's question about the unions involved -- are they the unions that affiliated with AFSCME under the collective bargaining law Gov. Rossello pushed through or the local, independent unions that opposed Rossello's public employee unionization efforts?

The two telephone company unions are local, independents. CWA President Morty Barr has tried to counsel them that (1) privatization is inevitable, (2) they should get to the bargaining table and not escalate the situation, and (3) GTE is a good company, but his advice has been generally ignored. He is trying to be helpful.

Some of the unions involved in the general strike are affiliated with the AFL-CIO.

AFSCME's Gerry McEntee has told members to respect the picket lines but privately recognizes the political motivations for the strike. Pres. Sweeney has expressed concern to the Governor about police handling of the matter and offered AFL help.

PRESIDENT CLINTON URGES CONGRESS TO TAKE ACTION ON CHILD CARE AND RELEASES REPORTS HIGHLIGHTING PRIVATE SECTOR EFFORTS

April 23, 1998

President Clinton called on Congress today to take action to make child care better, safer, and more affordable for America's working families. In a Rose Garden ceremony, the President released two reports highlighting private sector efforts to provide child care assistance to workers. These reports show that providing child care is good for workers, good for businesses, and good for the economy. Today more than ever, America's parents are working: three out of five mothers with children under age six work outside the home. Yet a recent study found that only one percent of revenues for child care and early education come from the private sector.

Treasury Department Working Group on Child Care Report Finds that Investments in Child Care Make Good Business Sense. At the White House Conference on Child Care (10/23/97), President Clinton asked Secretary Rubin to convene a group of business and labor leaders to look at child care problems facing working parents and to identify best practices in the private sector and in public-private partnerships. Today, the Treasury Working Group on Child Care released a new report, Investing in Child Care:

Child care problems can reduce productivity and profits. The Working Group report finds that businesses benefit from providing child care assistance -- through increased productivity, lower turnover, better recruitment, reduced absenteeism, and improved morale.

&The report carries an important lesson: investments in child care can pay off in real dividends for employers and employees. 8 --Treasury Secretary Robert Rubin, Investing in Child Care.

New Department of Labor Report Highlights Model Business Practices and New Initiative Aims at Increasing Private Sector Involvement. Today, the Department of Labor released a new report, Meeting the Needs of Today's Workforce: Child Care Best Practices, which examines best practices initiated by businesses, government agencies, unions, not-for-profits, and business/community partnerships to meet the demands of employees who are also parents. The key finding of the report is that, in today's global economy, providing child care and other family-friendly policies helps companies recruit and retain the best workforce for the future. The President is also announcing a new commitment by the Department of Labor to serve as a clearinghouse for businesses interested in child care, and to set up a business-to-business mentoring program on child care.

Businesses Can't Do it Alone: The President Calls for Congressional Action. - 4) At the October, 1997 AFL-CIO meetings he met Hazel Daws, a custodial worker who has led the AFSCME drive for workers on Capitol Hill
- 5) There are millions of workers who work in areas such as work with the elderly or mentally impaired, whose employers claim they are not covered by labor law -- these include home care workers in Michigan and California -- is there any reason we shouldn't mention either of these groups?
- 6) Many of the workers being blocked from joining AFSCME are in jobs partially financed by federal funds. The administration has been studying how to prevent Federal funds being used for union-busting activities -- how hard can we lean into this? Are there any concrete steps we've taken? Are there any steps we can promise to take?

WASHINGTON (AP) President Clinton acted swiftly to halt the American Airlines pilots' strike last year, but administration officials say such an intervention is unlikely in the case of Northwest Airlines pilots.

While a president has broad authority to intervene in strikes under the Railway Labor Act, important economic and political differences set the two situations apart.

American flies to many major metropolitan hubs, while Northwest's routes tend to be more regionally concentrated; Clinton is wary of setting a pattern that could encourage negotiators to expect him to intervene in all airline strikes, and unlike the American pilots, the flyers at Northwest belong to a union affiliated with the AFL-CIO.

With the Friday midnight deadline approaching, administration officials began sending signals that the president won't interrupt his Martha's Vineyard holiday to stop a walkout. Clinton would be unlikely to get involved, said the officials, who spoke on condition of anonymity, unless a strike dragged on to the Labor Day

Air Line Pilots Association President Randy Babbitt made it clear at a meeting of the AFL-CIO executive council in Chicago earlier this month that the union didn't want administration interference in the collective bargaining process. And AFL-CIO staffers in recent days have asked White House officials to stay out of the Northwest situation, a federation official said.

The 13 million-member AFL-CIO had only a muted response when Clinton stopped the American strike, in part because those pilots were not represented by an affiliated union, union presidents said privately.

Under the Railway Labor Act, the president, acting on the recommendation of the National Mediation Board, can avert a strike with a 60-day ``cooling off'' period if he finds ``a substantial economic threat'' would deprive a region of a ``central transportation service.''

The Vice President has been incredibly well-received at every single labor convention event since I have been here -- Firefighters and AFL-CIO Winter Meetings (in March before I was here), Building Trades Conference (April), Rural Letter Carriers (small union) (May), Machinists (June), International Union of Electronic, Electrical, Salaried, Machine, and Furniture Workers (IUE) (July), NEA (July), CWA and AFSCME (August), and Labor Day event in King County (September). He has been invited to address many other union events that we have been unable to accept because of scheduling conflicts.

In March at the AFL-CIO winter meetings, in July at the NEA, and on Labor Day he has sat down with union workers in small, closed roundtables to learn about their experiences on the job and why workers need to have their right to organize protected.

He is (in my opinion honestly) passionate in his remarks to these audiences -- you should see Paul O's remarks for examples of speeches as written, though the articles from Seattle yesterday back me up -- you might be able to get tape from C-Span of AFSCME remarks.

He has an excellent working relationship with many union presidents -- see Sweeney quote -- you should probably talk to Karen T or Monica for specifics. I don't know if you want to mention this, but we have an ongoing program where we bring in one union President every month for a private outreach meeting.

He has taken a strong stand on the Right to Organize, probably the most important issue for unions today. He also took a strong stand against Prop 226 in CA and similar efforts in other states, including attending a fundraiser in NJ in June.

His (and the Administration's) agenda, particularly in the past year, has coincided in many ways with the AFL-CIO's agenda -- raising the minimum wage, passing a meaningful Patient's Bill of Rights.

The VP was himself at one time a member of the Newspaper Guild, though he

doesn't usually mention this in speeches -- his father was TN's first Labor Commissioner, was the first person to oversee unemployment compensation, spoke out for first minimum wage law.

He has also met with local labor leaders when he has travelled on a number of occasions -- let me know if you want specific examples.

I don't have them, but if you can find the VP's AFL-CIO rating from when he was a Congressman and a Senator (from TN, no less), I think they're pretty good.

Let me know if this helps, if there is anything else I can provide.
