FOUR PARTICIPANTS FROM PRODEMU (FIRST LADY'S FOUNDATION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF WOMEN) SOCIAL, EDUCATIONAL, & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

1. PARTICIPANT: SONIA CARRASCO, AGE 58

OCCUPATION: HELPS RUN A CATERING SERVICE IN THE INDEPENDENCIA NEIGHBORHOOD

BACKGROUND: VERY POOR, NO FORMAL EDUCATION PRIOR TO PRODEMU

WHY CHOSEN: HAS BECOME A LEADER IN PRODEMU

2. PARTICIPANT: WILMA RIVERA, AGE 49

OCCUPATION: TEACHES DRESS MAKING. ONCE HAD A SHOP BUT NOW TEACHES FULL TIME.

BACKGROUND: NO FORMAL EDUCATION. HAS BEEN TAUGHT BASIC SKILLS BY PRODEMU

WHY CHOSEN: HAS BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN HELPING SEVERAL WOMEN START THEIR OWN DRESS MAKING BUSINESS.

3. PARTICIPANT: JACQUELINE LEIVA, AGE 27

OCCUPATION: COMMUNITY NURSE

BACKGROUND: SAME AS ABOVE

WHY CHOSEN: INFORMAL HEAD OF A GROUP OF 12 NURSES, EIGHT OF WHICH WORK IN SANTIAGO HOSPITALS. THE OTHERS WORK IN NURSING HOMES AND HOSPICES

4. PARTICIPANT: JUANA CAYUQUEO, AGE 58

OCCUPATION: WORKS WITH 40 MAPUCHE (INDIGENOUS) WOMEN. THEY TEACH THE NATIVE LANGUAGE (ALMOST DEAD). THEY ARE ALSO TEACHING YOUNG CHILEANS TRADITIONAL WEAVING AND FOOD PREPARATION TECHNIQUES TO PROMOTE THE INDIGENOUS MAPUCHE CULTURE.
