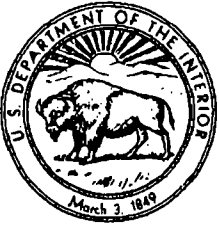

Update on Dr. Brown's calls:

Rep. Pat William: No on Rule; No on Bill
He does not want to take any more phone calls on the Crime Bill.

Rep. Frank Tejada: Undecided
He has problems with RJA and Assault Weapons. Said that he is in the process of talking with Steny Hoyer; if they are able to work something out, he will come through on both the Rule and the Bill. (We assume that you know what this refers to.)

Rep. Alcee Hastings: No on Rule; Probably support Bill
On political principle, he cannot support the rule, although he has a safe district and can do whatever he feels is right. He believes that the Senate mistreated the CBC on RJA and he will not break with this position. Also, he feels that there is support for everything in the criminal justice system except money for judges -- and that this is a real problem.

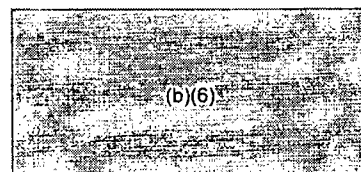
