Omnibus Crime Bill - Passage.** Passage of the bill to authorize more than \$27.5 billion over six years for various anti-crime initiatives, including \$13.5 billion for new prisons and more than \$7 billion for crime prevention programs. The bill would require life imprisonment for three-time violent offenders, expand the death penalty to apply to dozens of federal crimes and authorize grants to hire 50,000 additional police officers. Passed 285-141: R 65-107; D 219-34 (ND 149-21, SD 70-13); I 1-0, April 21, 1994. A "yea" was a vote in support of the president's position. (Story, 1994 Weekly Report p. 1001)
