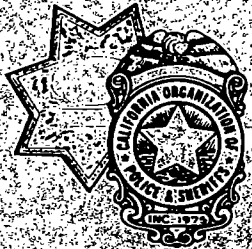

Dear Mr. Panetta;

The California Organization of Police and Sheriffs (COPS) fully supports President Clinton's efforts to pass the anti-crime package. As you are aware, California has been severely hurt by our current recession. Not only does this affect private sector jobs, it also affects the public sector--law enforcement in particular. With layoffs and hiring freezes, California cities are less safe today than they were four years ago.

Of particular interest to COPS is the provision within the crime bill that allocates funds to hire 100,000 more peace officers. Time and time again, it has been proven that a highly visible, uniformed police patrol, coupled with community based anti-crime programs has a profound-and immediate effect in reducing the crime rate. With more uniformed officers on our streets, both the public and small neighborhood businesses feel secure.

Unfortunately, we have a governor in California, who would rather mouth platitudes, and blame others--including your administration--than seek meaningful solutions to solve our crime problem.

COPS is confident that congress will pass the President's anti-crime package and send it to him for his signature. COPS would be privileged and honored to host a bill signing ceremony in California. Such an event would send a message to criminals, that President Clinton stands with our nation's police, and is serious about reducing the crime rate in the United States.

Such an event would also put our governor on notice that the Clinton administration is doing more than just wringing its hands over the crime issue. It would show the people of California, that it is President Clinton, not their governor,
