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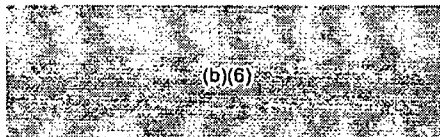

As you requested, here is a brief summary of some of the things Gil Garcetti has done to gain passage of the crime bill.

First, as you know, they early provided to us information on crime rates (juvenile, violent, etc.) in California and Los Angeles County in order to assist in making the case for the necessity of funds. You discussed this and the importance of the direct application process with Rep. Schumer in July.

More recently, as the House and Senate leadership engaged in efforts to pass the conference report, we volunteered our efforts, coordinating closely with both the crime subcommittee staff and western Whip Bill Richardson's office in the House, as well as with Senator Feinstein's office and the Democratic Policy Committee in the Senate.

Schumer's subcommittee and Richardson's Whip staff both provided us with lists of California "undecided" or "no, but possibly persuadable" members and requested contact by Garcetti. These lists were updated daily during preparation for the initial vote, and names were added. He sent letters to all the targeted members of the delegation, including Huffington, Horn, Dellums, Condit, Hamburg, Waters, Tucker, and Dixon.

The letter stressed the importance of the crime prevention program funding, citing the fact that the OJ Simpson case has served to highlight the very real problems of domestic violence faced by everyday citizens, and stating that the funding was not "soft on crime social spending" but rather was a vital tool to enable police and prosecutors to better do their jobs.

In addition, the DA's office contacted the California District Attorney's Association and solicited a letter of support for members from other areas of California (such as Hamburg, Dellums, Condit).

At the urgent request of Rep. Harman, who intended to support the conference report but was under strong pressure from groups in her district not to do so, he faxed a letter requesting her support to her office and offered to make any public statement she needed to help back up her decision.

At their request, we faxed copies of some of these letters to Schumer's and Richardson's office for their use in Whip meetings and on the floor.

After the conference report was initially defeated, we again worked with Richardson's office and targeted Reps. Horn and Huffington, who had voted for the bill but against the conference report. Garcetti placed calls to these members to personally argue for the funding.

In the Senate, we contacted Senator Biden's office, the California Senators offices (Senator Feinstein was a leader for the assault weapons ban which Garcetti publicly supported) and the Democratic Policy Committee. We sent letters to the two Senators and, at the DPC's request, Garcetti faxed a letter of support -- again stressing the importance to DA's of the spending in the bill -- to Mitchell's office for his use in floor debates.

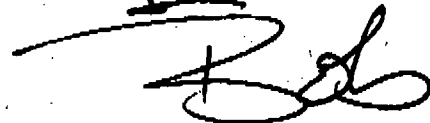
