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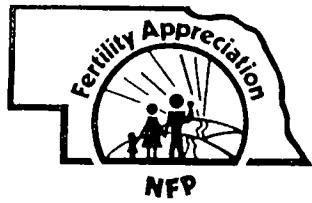

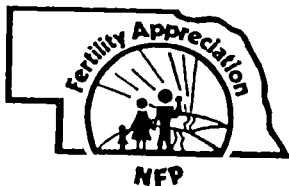

Dear Natural Family Planning of Nebraska Staff:

Your letter to President Clinton regarding the value of abstinence education has been forwarded to my office for reply. I apologize for the delay in responding.

As you know, in his State of the Union address, President Clinton discussed the seriousness of teen pregnancy and announced the creation of a nonpartisan, private-sector initiative entitled "The National Campaign to Prevent Teen Pregnancy." A group of many distinguished and prominent Americans has come together to support grass-roots community efforts to reduce teen pregnancy by one-third by the year 2005. The Campaign will work on the following five tasks:

- 1) taking a clear stand against teenage pregnancy and attracting the interest of more national leaders and organizations in this issue;
- 2) enlisting the help of the media to reduce teen pregnancy;
- 3) supporting and stimulating state and local action to reduce teen pregnancy;
- 4) fostering a national discussion about how religion, culture and public values influence both teen pregnancy and responses to it; and
- 5) strengthening the knowledge base for effective programming.

My office administers the Federal Adolescent Family Life Program (AFL). The AFL program supports demonstration projects aimed at preventing adolescent sexual activity primarily through abstinence-based education, as well as projects that provide comprehensive support services to pregnant and parenting teens. Enclosed are fact sheets on the AFL program and the National Campaign which includes the name of a contact person for more information and a listing of the founding board members. Thank you for sharing your views.

 words: "Sacred is sex."

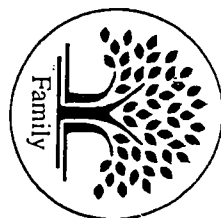

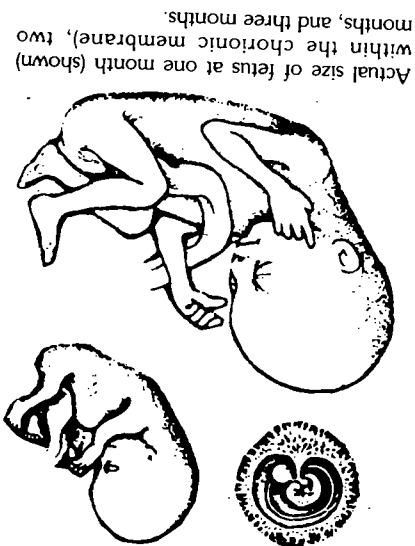

Everyone's Biography

- Heartbeat begins between the 18th and 25th day by the 20th day.
- At 42 days, the skeleton is complete, reflexes are present.
- Electrical brain waves have been recorded as early as 43 days.
- The brain and all the body systems are present by eight weeks.
- At eight weeks, if we tickle the baby's nose, he will flex his head backwards away from the stimulus.
- At nine to ten weeks, he squints, swallows, moves his tongue, and if you stroke his palm he will make a fist.
- At eleven to twelve weeks, he sucks his thumb vigorously and breathes his amniotic fluid to develop the organs of respiration.
- Fingernails are present by eleven to twelve weeks; eyelashes by sixteen.
- All the body systems are functioning by 12 weeks.

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In a way, sex is divine. By means of sex a person partakes of the power of God.

"You are gods!" says the Psalm. (82/6.)

By means of sex, men and women become creators.

They create "fruit" of their lives, *their bodies*, which lives throughout eternity.

Sex is the "occasion" which God uses for the making of immortality.

Thus the purpose or end of sex is in heaven.

The most noble physical faculty of man or woman is the sexual one. A child cannot be made by the eye or the mouth or the hand or the heart. No other human faculty can create new life. Only sex can.

Sex faculties are the most sacred of bodily faculties. We measure their sacredness by their purpose.

Sex must mirror divine purity.

It must be revered.

It reflects the light and life of heaven.

It is a sort of insanity to ridicule the bodily organs whereby a person was endowed with life and given an eternal destiny.

The sexual snicker-jerker cancers his tongue; he shames his own body; he degrades his mother and father.

Sex is sacred.

It is worth protecting like a pearl of great price.

It is worth enclosing within the armor of modesty.

Keeping sex pure is worth any sacrifice.

Keeping it sacred is worth dying for.

It is not meant to be flaunted.

It is not an instrument of seduction.
