International Family Planning: House approves funds for overseas family planning
URGENT

WASHINGTON (AP) Overcoming the objections of anti-abortion lawmakers, the House today approved the release of funding for international family planning programs.

In the first abortion test vote of the new Congress, the House by a **220-209** margin approved a resolution to begin providing \$385 million in overseas family planning funds on March 1. The Senate is to take up the measure soon.
