In its editorial on Dec. 23, the N.Y. Times wrote:

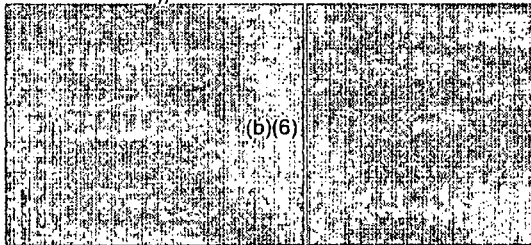

Dear Ms. Kincaid,

I am a lifelong registered Democrat. I wish to express my view of the impeachment process.

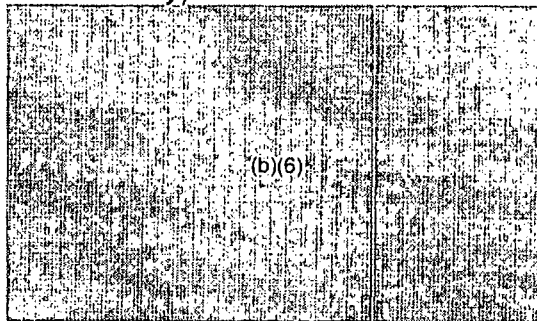
The President violated both of these oaths, which are the cornerstones of a society governed by the rule of law. No citizens, and a fortiori the President, is above the law.

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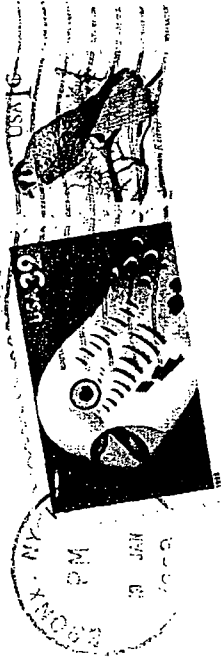
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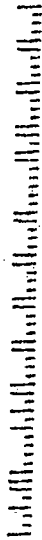
