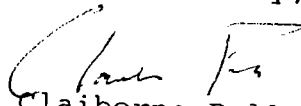

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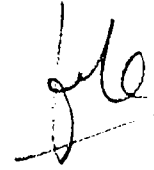

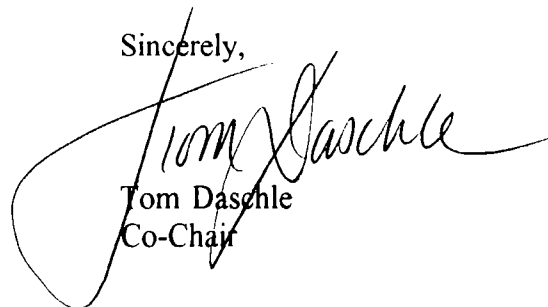
On behalf of Senator Mitchell and the Democratic Policy Committee, thank you for meeting with our colleagues at our weekly luncheon.
