
At this time, we are unable to make a commitment to your request. However, please be assured that we will keep your invitation on file for further consideration.

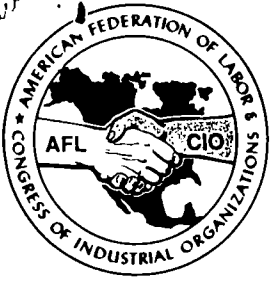
