The White House is presently unable to confirm the President's availability on March 2-4, 2000. You will be contacted when further information becomes available.

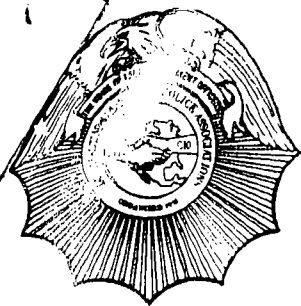
