The White House Switchboard in Santiago, Chile can be reached by dialing 500-6000. This is called our CO DIAL Number and it will help you reach members of the White House Staff Travelling to Santiago, as well as White House Offices in Washington, D.C..

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE AT THE PRIMARY STAFF HOTEL FOR AF-1, BACK-UP PLANE AND STAFF TRAVELLING ON THE SEC/STATE PLANE:

Guests and staff arriving on AF-1 and the Back-Up Plane (with the exception of USSS and some members of the press) will be staying at the HYATT REGENCY HOTEL. In addition, there will be staff arriving on the Sec/State plane who will also be at the HYATT.

On arrival at the Hyatt, there will be a White House Check-In Desk located to the left of the main doors. Please check the Rooms List for your room number prior to arrival. Those staying in rooms starting with 17, 18 or 19 may proceed directly to your room via the lobby elevators. Your room will be unlocked and keys will be on the bed, however, we would appreciate your stopping by the 16th fl. Regency Club Lounge at some point Thursday to present a credit card to cover extras.

Those staying on floors 16 and below, may pick up their key packs at the White House Check-In table. Please have a credit card ready so the hotel may take an imprint as they hand you your keys.

NOTES

PRESS CLIPS: Press Clips will be available in the Travelling Staff Ofc. located in room 123 on Level 1 (not M-1) and in the 16th floor lounge.

BREAKFAST: There will be a complementary continental breakfast served from 7 am to 10 am each day (including arrival day) for those whose rooms are on floors 16-19 and for guests who have received invitations in their welcome kits placed in their rooms. Others will find a good, but expensive, breakfast in the restaurant in the lobby or a more reasonable one at the mall located 2 blocks from the hotel. (Exit front doors - turn to the right)

MONEY EXCHANGE: Money Exchange is available at the front desk of the hotel or in the Embassy Control Room located on Level M-1 (not 1) during the hrs. of 7 am - 12 noon and 4 pm to 8 pm. Current rate is 448 pesos to \$1.

SHUTTLES: There will be a HOTEL SHUTTLE BUS leaving the hotel every 30 minutes going to overflow hotels starting at 7 am and going until 8 pm.

There will be a SUMMIT SHUTTLE BUS going from the primary hotel (Hyatt Regency) to the Summit (at the Sheraton) every 30 minutes starting at 6:30 am and running until 1 hour after the last Summit event of the day.

UPON ARRIVAL, PLEASE BE SURE TO CHECK THE MOTORCADE NOTICE POSTED IN YOUR ROOM FOR ANY CHANGES OR ADDITIONS. DEPARTURES WILL BE FROM THE FRONT OF THE HOTEL. BE SURE TO GET ON THE RIGHT SHUTTLE.

WE ARE PLANNING TO HAVE A FEW LOCAL VENDORS VISIT THE HOTEL LOBBY AREA ON SATURDAY FROM 10 AM - 4 PM FOR THOSE WHO WILL NOT BE ABLE TO HAVE ANY FREE TIME DURING THIS VERY BUSY AND HECTIC VISIT.
