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Draft Comment on Wall Street Journal story:

Considering the public nature of the White House, the President and Mrs. Clinton have worked diligently to create an atmosphere which would allow their daughter Chelsea to have as normal a childhood as possible. During the course of the past four years in particular, they have been particularly grateful to the media for cooperating with them in achieving that goal. The press have been very understanding.

Recently questions have arisen about Chelsea and her role as first daughter. Foremost, she is a private person concerned with high school and her friends. Chelsea is a sixteen year old teenager beginning her senior year at Sidwell Friends whose primary preoccupation is with the ritual of selecting the college or university she will attend next fall.

Like all children, she also is a proud daughter who naturally supports her father who happens to be the President of the United States. For almost her entire life, Chelsea has been at her father's side as he has campaigned for elected office. It would be unnatural for her to do anything else.

During her time in Washington, Chelsea has continued to grow-up and come into her own. This does not mean that she is ready for "primetime." From the point of view of the first family, the rules regarding access to Chelsea remain the same. They respectfully ask that the press honor her privacy and allow her the freedom to make personal choices, which may include attending a public event with her parents as she did when she requested a ticket to the State of the Union, without being penalized for her decision.
