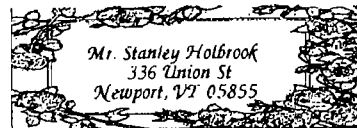

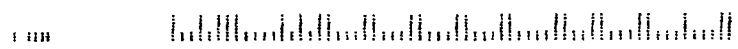

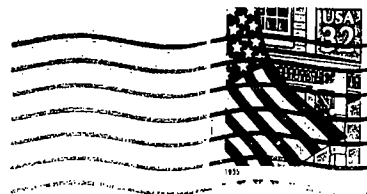

Q Are you trying to say that the list of names you put out are all personal friends of the president?

MR. MCCURRY: No. Let me do a little bit at the top here just to talk about what we have done today. You know the president ran for reelection last year. At times we forget that. He won, as I recall. A large part of his effort went to building a successful campaign structure. He did so knowing in the aftermath of the 1994 election that he had a very uphill fight and that he would likely be outspent and outfinanced by the Republican Party, and he put his shoulder to the wheel to raise the necessary funds to conduct an effective campaign. And even though we were in the end outspent by the Republican Party, the president did put together an effective campaign.

We've put together a lot of documentation today that is designed to explain further the circumstances under which we raised money for that campaign.

I think if you look at it, an observation that **Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan** once made, he wrote an essay entitled the iron law of emulation which I think was a rip off of Robert Michelle (sp) -- although he would not probably care to admit that -- but he made the observation that organizations in conflict become like one another and that's true if you think of navies or football teams or political institutions and political parties. And I think one of the things clear in these documents, as you look at the structuring of the various donor councils of the Democratic National Committee, the effort to do things to encourage and motivate supporters, a large part of what we did was similar to, in fact, in some cases, mirroring efforts that were underway at the Republican party. I say that because this is a fairly detailed release of information about the mechanics of a working national campaign. Now questions have been raised about the Republican party's fundraising for things like Team 100, the Eagle's Club, the Season Ticket Holder program. My strong guess is that when you see the documentation, the memoranda, the record of conversations between party officials about their programs,

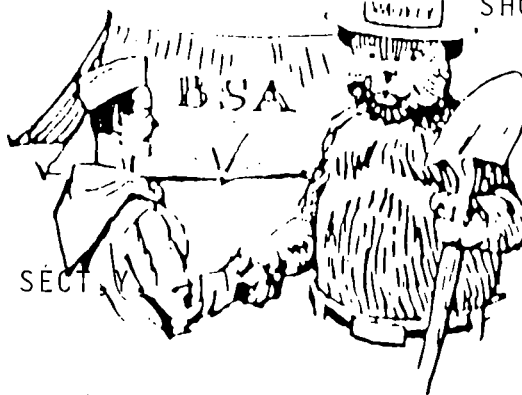

Collection pictures aviation history

WILMINGTON — Sanford Oringer doesn't recall just when he began collecting signed photographs, but one thing is certain. His binders of autographs tell the history of flight — from Orville Wright to astronaut Buzz Aldrin.

Oringer, 78, who moved to Wilmington last year from Harrisburg, Pa., likes to display his collection for schools, Boy Scout troops and Masonic organizations. When he lived in Harrisburg, he would do three or four exhibits a year, he said.

Oringer's collection, neatly kept in three-ring binders, fills two bookcases in his home. So many photos have come over the years, he said, that he doesn't know whose autograph was the first.

"It had to have been 50 or 60 years ago," Oringer said. "One of the first was Adm. Richard E. Byrd," the polar explorer.

Oringer has been involved with aeronautics since the late 1930s, when he graduated from high school in Boston and went to Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics. He worked for Grumman Aerospace Inc. and volunteered on the Apollo 11 project as an aircraft instru-

ment technician.

"It's been nice, as a volunteer, to receive nice letters from the astronauts congratulating me on my work with NASA," Oringer said. His collection also includes a piece of aluminum that was rejected from Apollo 11.

Oringer has been associated with the Boy Scouts for 64 years. He said he sends form letters to public figures.

requesting autographs.

In addition to aviation greats, his collection includes signatures of many baseball players as well as those of world figures, such as the late Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin.

His collection of American presidents' signatures includes Gerald Ford, John F. Kennedy, Jimmy Carter, George Bush and Bill Clinton. Gov. Carper sent Oringer and his wife, Vivian, a card on their 50th wedding anniversary last year.

Oringer currently is assistant commissioner in the Boy Scouts Three Rivers District. He has also received the prestigious George Meany Award for his service to the Scouts, and the Shofar award for Jewish adult leaders of Scouts.

Health Plan Failed — But Advisers Fared Quite Well

Fees ranged to \$49 an hour for experts on task force

The White House touted the long hours and sacrifices of those who crafted its ill-fated health care plan, but it turns out that the work brought healthy rewards for a small cadre of consultants.

Some businesses received six-figure contracts. For select advisers, consulting fees reached as high as \$49 an hour, allowing some to earn more than \$100,000, according to an Associated Press review of government records.

The payments were made despite a warning from White House lawyers to use full-time government employees, not consultants.

The Clinton administration has declined to say how much was spent developing its health care plan. The new Republican Congress has begun its own review.

In all, the White House consulted about 1,000 people to craft the plan. Most of the high-profile experts worked for free.

The few who were paid were members of a White House inner circle, hired as consultants for an extended period to work on the task force and beyond.

"To avoid ethical difficulties, the members of the cluster groups, and especially the heads of issue working groups, must be full government employees," aide Atul Gawande wrote to health czar Ira Magaziner in a Feb. 2, 1993, memo.

The White House counsel had advised that payments were "not clearly in violation of any law," but that they "would give antagonists leverage for attacking us in the

press and possibly in legal channels," Gawande wrote.

Avis LaVelle, a spokeswoman at the Department of Health and Human Services, said the payments to consultants were necessary to attract top-caliber advice without expanding the permanent federal work force.

Critics denounced the arrangement. "I think it is a very dangerous trend to have this kind of private-public partnership where it insinuates into the very process of government corporations and individuals that stand to profit from it," said Dr. Jane Orient, head of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons, which successfully sued to force the White House to disclose working documents from the task force.

At least a dozen advisers to Hillary Clinton were paid \$33 to \$49 an hour by HHS.

Among the highest paid was Walter Zelman, a consumer activist and former California state official. He received \$101,649 in consulting fees from January 1993 to March 1994, at a rate of \$48.39 an hour, according to HHS records.

HEALTH PLAN COST IN THE MILLIONS

The cost of creating President Clinton's failed health care plan remains a mystery. One reason: Payments to contractors were scattered across several departments, some of which have declined to provide figures.

The Treasury Department said it spent \$1.6 million in support of the Clinton plan.

The White House, although it oversaw the effort, said it spent just \$211,000.

The White House has very little money for contractors, so it shifted the lion's share of the cost to the Department of Health and Human Services, a spokeswoman said.

The department has declined to say how much it spent. But an Associated Press computer-assisted search identified \$2.5 million in contracts at HHS that officials have confirmed were in support of the health plan, as well as more than \$800,000 in consulting payments.

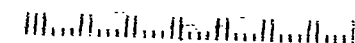
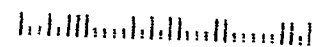

Dear President Clinton:

Senator Fulbright's most profound legacy, embodied in the above quote, was intended to warn Americans of the disastrous consequences of Presidential deception and the misuse of power. His quote results from President Lyndon Johnson's deceitful 1964 Gulf of Tonkin Resolution, used to stampede a misinformed Congress into supporting U. S. intervention in the unjust Vietnam War, an action all Americans have had much cause to regret. Tragically, the current Balkan quagmire now beckons America to repeat its shameful history.

How has it happened, Mr. President, that the most significant lesson Senator Fulbright tried to impart from the tumultuous Vietnam War years, while you were working on his staff, failed to make any impression on you? Today, however, his eloquent critiques would target your pervasive deceptions. His powerful voice would ring out in anguished protest of your illegal, unauthorized, clandestine, partisan U. S. military intervention in ex-Yugoslavia.

You have wasted more than two years of your term of office, wrought enormous suffering, injury and death on tens of thousands of innocents and recklessly expended billions of taxpayer dollars in pursuit of the dubious goal of creating Europe's first Muslim nation embracing all of Bosnia-Herzegovina. In this process, you have been deceitful throughout, pretending to be seeking peace while relentlessly promoting war; trying always to mask your misguided partisan militancy behind United Nations mandates your own policy initiatives brought on.

Right now, you have a large and growing contingent of U. S. military experts and technicians in Bosnia, covertly working feverishly to arm, train and prepare your proxy Croat/Muslim army for an all-out Spring offensive. All that remains is to

identify and publicize the "staged" international incident that will enable you to blame the Serbs for this premeditated Croat/Muslim aggression, as has been the pattern.

Very few Americans know that this U. S. military contingent engineered and participated in the Muslim government's atrocious attack on the "safe haven" of Bihac. Some 55,000 Muslim civilians, regarded as disloyal for lack of support of Sarajevo's fundamentalist government, were brutally uprooted and driven from their homes. It was, in fact, the largest "ethnic cleansing" operation of the Bosnian War! Many large European newspapers have been reporting the U. S. military intervention for several months. The government of France was so outraged by covert U. S. military assistance to the Bosnian government forces that it lodged a strong diplomatic protest with our government.

Imagine that, Mr. President. The world's only remaining super power -- the United States of America -- a full partner in the largest "ethnic cleansing" operation of the Bosnian War. Every member of Congress worth his salt should rise up -- become "Fulbrights" -- and denounce your unauthorized, indecent and immoral participation in the Bosnian government's disgraceful "cleansing" of its own innocent Muslim citizens from the U.N.designated "safe haven" of Bihac. Your actions violate international law and constitute gross abuse and misuse of Presidential powers.

Although President Johnson was untruthful relative to the Gulf of Tonkin Resolution, he, at least, had Congressional approval for entering the war against North Vietnam. You have no similar authority, either from Congress or the United Nations. Furthermore, I challenge you to point to a single vital national security interest at work here that might justify your clandestine, partisan military intervention.

The success of the Bosnian Serb counterattack at Bihac in December should have signaled the collapse and futility of your war promotion policy. Unfortunately, you have ignored this lesson just as you have repudiated the legacy of your friend and mentor, Senator J. William Fulbright.

Welcome to Vietnam, Mr. President!

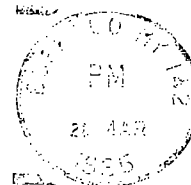

ALABAMA LAW

(Regular Session, 1994)

Act No. 94-633

H. 244 - Reps. Johnson, McClain

AN ACT

To provide that a defendant who has been adjudged in a paternity proceeding to be the father of a child may, except in the case of adoption, reopen the case upon scientific evidence that the defendant is not the father of the child.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of Alabama:

Section 1. (a) Upon petition of the defendant in a paternity proceeding where the defendant has been declared the legal father, the case shall be reopened if there is scientific evidence presented by the defendant that he is not the father. The court shall admit into evidence any scientific test recognized by the court that has been conducted in accordance with established scientific principles or the court may order a blood test, or a Deoxyribose Nucleic Acid test of the mother, father, and child. Whenever the court orders a test and any of the persons to be tested refuse to submit to the test, the fact shall be disclosed at the trial, unless good cause is shown.

(b) The test shall be made by a qualified expert approved by the court. The expert may be called by the court or any party as a witness to testify to the test results and shall be subject to cross-examination by the parties. The test results may be admitted into evidence. If more than one test is performed and the results are conflicting, none of the test results shall be admissible as evidence of paternity or nonpaternity.

(c) Compensation of the expert witness shall be paid by the petitioner.

(d) In the event the child has been adopted the matter of paternity may not be reopened under this act.

Section 2. In any decree setting aside an order of paternity pursuant to this act, there shall be no claim for damages against the court rendering the initial order of paternity nor any reimbursement

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or recoupment of money or damages against the mother, the State, or any employee or agent of the State.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.

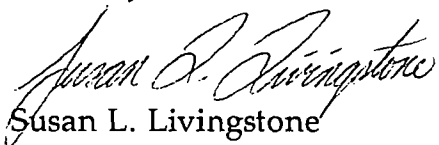
For the past three months, I have feverishly attempted to obtain VIP White House tour passes for my parents' upcoming visit to Washington next month, May 12-22, 1995.

published in 1991, put forth conspiracy theories typical of anti-semitic literature. Robertson is a master of denial. C.A.P. has heard him criticize "secular Jews" on his television program, "The 700 Club." He uses his support of Israel as a shield to deflect charges of anti-Jewish bigotry.

We urge cappers to watch the 700 Club, and for the record, to make note of Robertson's personal attacks and distortions. A policy group in Washington has advised C.A.P. that cable television is not subject to the personal attack provision of the FCC rules. It is important for a broader public to understand what Robertson stands for, and how he is fueling the fires of hate in our country.

PROPAGANDA AD FOLLOW-UP

In our last mailing, I included a copy of a letter I had sent to Donald Graham, publisher of the *Washington Post*, objecting to that newspaper's publication of an ad which deliberately distorted the facts in the suicide case of Vincent Foster. The aims of the group which placed this ad, the "Western Journalism Center," are akin to those of Jerry Falwell, to raise in the public mind the specter of some heinous secret crime involving the Clintons. I wrote with little expectation of a response, but in December I received this hand-written reply:

"Dear Mr. Miller,

Thank you for your letter. I appreciate your careful recitation of the Foster investigations; all have been reported on in the Post. I believe it is fair to say that our editorial page completely disagrees with the conclusions in the advertisement.

Why, then, did we run the ad? Because we give advertisers very broad latitude to say what they think, even when (perhaps especially when) we disagree.

We do not print ads which break the law (or ask others to do so); libel; grossly offend community taste; or say something provably false, or without some substantiation.

The last two criteria provide us with many close calls. But these are the standards we seek to apply.

PAT ROBERTSON: THE MOST DANGEROUS MAN IN AMERICA

On Friday, January 20th between nine and nine-thirty P.M. central time, Pat Robertson launched a venomous attack on Planned Parenthood. He implied strongly that they were Nazis, and he said "they lie and lie and lie." Mr. Robertson has become increasingly shrill during his 700-Club editorials, but his vicious remarks are delivered very often (previous speech excepted) in a reasonable tone, and they are preceded and followed by spiritually soothing material.

During the week of March 1st, Robertson went on another binge of accusation and innuendo, in the fashion of his fellow Jerry Falwell, talking of murders in Arkansas and hidden conspiracies involving President Clinton. Less than a week before the indictment of Neal Ainsly by Whitewater independent counsel Kenneth Starr, Robertson praised Starr and predicted "a progressive series of revelations" about these matters. Perhaps someone should investigate the Starr-Robertson connection to find out if information is improperly flowing between the two.

Robertson has ended up in the news again because of allegations that he is anti-Semitic. Frank Rich brought the issue before the public in his *New York Times* column of 3-2-95. He mentions articles written by a Harper's editor named Michael Lind for *Dissent* and the *New York Review of Books*. Lind's articles, according to Rich, show that Robertson's best-selling book, "The New World Order," published in 1991,

The Western Journalism Center continues its work of attempting to cast doubt on the Fiske report of Vince Foster's death. In its "Winter, 1995" newsletter it boasts of its propaganda campaign, but it is all described as work in the interests of the general public. The group is peddling a "new video documentary" for \$35.00. "Once you see this tape," says a flier contained within the newsletter, "you will never think about the Foster case in the same way again."

The group recently held a dinner honoring the right-wing columnist Robert Novak, ABC news reporter John Stossel, David Brock and others.

The Wall Street Journal is peddling a book of its very own Whitewater propaganda. The following is quoted from that newspaper's March 1st edition: "The Wall Street Journal has published a bound collection of editorial page commentary on Whitewater, complete through the congressional hearings and the appointment of a special prosecutor-586 pages, \$14.95 plus \$5.00 shipping and handling." An 800 number is given.

The basement of the Capitol has become the underground lair for some very base broadcasting. The scene during the House debate on the balanced budget amendment is vividly described in an article of 2-16-95 in the *Winchester (IN.) News-Gazette*. The Republican radio hosts took their booths out of boxes like snake oil salesmen and set up shop: "One conservative host, Steve Brown of Omaha, NE was assisted for two days by Todd A. Blodgett, associate publisher of a magazine making fun of President Clinton called 'Slick Times.' Copies of 'Slick Times' -full of highly off-color jokes about the first family- were lying around Brown's booth and Blodgett handed them out freely."

(The magazine, which comprises 46 pages of personal attack thinly disguised as humor, advertises a variety of anti-Clinton products including "Impeach Clinton" bumper stickers. Each issue comes with a three dollar bill called a "Queer Reserve Note," which carries a likeness of the President blowing a whistle. On the back cover is an ad for the "National Lampoon" which depicts Lee Harvey Oswald with a rifle in one hand and a magazine in the other.)

The Associated Press and others have described how Rep. Robert Dornan was banned for a day from speaking on the floor of the House after he said Clinton was a traitor. He was treated as a hero by Basement Radio, and the snake oil men were competing for his time. Dornan has been known to appear as a substitute host on the Limbaugh show.

LOGIC AND MR. LIMBAUGH by Ray Perkins, Jr. paperback, \$9.95 ISBN 0-8126-9294-2 will ship in late April or early May. It will be published by Open Court Publishing Company. The book is both an entertaining introduction to the elements of logic (the author is a philosophy professor) and a serious critique of the practical logic of a major conservative propagandist. Professor Perkins takes 50 examples of logical reasoning from Rush's statements, identifies the logical arguments, and points out fallacies.

THE GREAT LIMBUAGH CON by Charles M. Kelly, paperback, \$14.95 ISBN 1-56474-102-8 is available now. The book is published by Fithian Press, a division of Daniel and Daniel. The author holds a Ph.D in industrial communications from Purdue University. This is perhaps the best refutation in print of the philosophy behind Rush Limbaugh's broadcasts. If you read this, you'll understand why Limbaugh's entire project is actually an attack on working people. Read this and learn how to refute Limbaugh's favorite sound bites.

PROPAGANDA CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE PRESIDENT

The right-wing continues its campaign against the President. Kenneth Starr is digging, digging, trying to find something, anything. And, according to a story by Serge F. Kovaleski published on the front page of *The Washington Post* on 2-9-95, the independent counsel investigating former Agriculture Secretary Mike Espy is engaging in a witch hunt. Those are my words, not the Posts's.

The story, entitled, "Independent Counsel Is Casting a Wide Net," begins with the assertion that Donald C. Smaltz has, in a five-month period, become "one of the most controversial independent counsels since the first one was appointed 16 years ago."

While C.A.P. knows nothing about the politics of Mr. Smaltz, his actions appear to serve the interests of those who would bring down the current President. A 58-year-old chicken packer who was just one of the 2,200 people on a list of Tyson workers who have filed workers' compensation claims, remembers her visit from the FBI. Smaltz has apparently used this list as a source. It seemed to the chicken packer that the agents were "just hunting for something, anything."

Many critics of Smaltz's "wide net" are quoted in the article.

The recent **FRONTLINE** program on PBS about Rush Limbaugh received mixed reviews. "Rush Limbaugh in America" aired in Chicago on 2-28-85. "If you've been convinced that PBS is run by a nasty liberal cabal" Writes Ginny Holbert of the *Chicago Sun-Times*, "you might expect a vicious attack on the twice-divorced college dropout who calls himself 'the most dangerous man in America.' This ain't it..."

One caller to Rush's program after the show aired expressed her pleasure at getting a chance to see pictures of Rush as a young man, at which point Limbaugh told her about his autobiographical video, of which, he said he had sold "70 or 80,000 copies."

Some new radio hosts have just begun their programs. **Judy Jarvis is, according to the Hartford Courant of 1-30-95, a politically independent host** whose new show was already being carried by 50 stations at the time of the newspaper write-up. The show originated at WPOP-AM in Newington, CT.

For more than six months **Aaron Harbor's program, AFTER THE RUSH** has been airing at stations around the country. It is produced by USA Talk Network in Boulder, CO. Mr. Harbor is left of center, but confounds stereotypes of the kind Rush Limbaugh trades in. He is a welcome alternative to hate radio. Citizens Against Propaganda wishes to extend special thanks to the USA Talk Network for airing a brief Info-commercial about our group.

Former Virginia governor L. Douglas Wilder also has a new show. It airs on station, WRVA-AM in Richmond. Wilder, says the Washington Post (1-12-95), plans to interview guests across a broad political spectrum.

Getting considerably more ink than the above additions to the talk radio line-up is **Oliver North**. At the time of writing he could be heard on only two stations, one in Virginia, and one in Houston.

THREE BOOKS WE RECOMMEND

A new book entitled, **THE WAY THINGS AREN'T ships** from The New Press in April. It will provide black and white documentation of Rush Limbaugh's lies. The book will be in paperback at \$5.95, ISBN # 1-56584-260-X. The media watchdog group FAIR is listed as the author, and Molly Ivins will write the introduction. The subtitle is "A Dittohead Deprogrammer, 100 outrageously false and foolish statements from America's most popular radio and TV personality." The publisher will provide bookstores who order at least eight copies with envelopes so that readers may send copies to friends.

Both Don Imus and Rush Limbaugh increased their audience, but the demise of local talk in Providence should force all talkers to put their ears to the ground.

Letters to newspapers are divided between those who, in an outraged fashion, defend or applaud right-wing radio, and those who are outraged by it. What struck CAP about the pro-radio letters was that many of them use the same sorts of phrases and arguments. They often say that talk radio extremism provides "balance" because liberals control all the major television networks, newspapers, and magazines.

In this regard, we couldn't help noticing a certain hysterical tone creeping into the rhetoric of the Right. Fred Barnes, the Republican pundit whose facial expression is often one of baffled outrage, told a conservative group at a meeting earlier this year that, **"there is no liberal talk show audience."** This, CAP thinks, was an attempt to deny that liberals exist at all. Indeed, liberals as depicted by the Republicans do not.

A viewer of C-Span's morning program faxed a letter which was read on the air during a recent exchange between Eric Alterman representing the left, and another man representing the right. The viewer said the program was not balanced although it appeared to be, because liberals represent no one. While the statement makes no sense in logical terms, we might see in this comment a kinship with the Barnes statement. Perhaps if we pretend varying points of view (or any alternatives to right-wing views) do not exist, those who hold views antithetical to right-wingers will disappear.

And speaking of disappearing, Rush Limbaugh has disappeared from television in northwest Ohio. **The Akron Beacon-Journal reported on 2-9-95 that a Christian television station, WTLW, has dropped the Limbaugh program,** despite high ratings. According to Robert Placie, the general manager of the station, some viewers found Limbaugh's "off-color humor" offensive.

In this vein, a letter to the editor of the Courier-Post (Cherry Hill, NJ) published on 12-27-94 says that Christians should not support **Limbaugh**, because his behavior is "sinful." Because of his boastful behavior and his personal attacks on people, Limbaugh's "words and actions," says the letter-writer "are filled with sin."

The *Lexington Herald-Leader* published a letter on 1-21-95 which CAP could not resist quoting. Under the title, **"Limbaugh's True Love"** the writer offered this conjecture: "If someone were to lobby for and get a bill passed allowing him to do so, I believe Rush Limbaugh would marry himself."

Mr. Naureckas ends his story with an observation we should all take to heart: "In fact, the Grant controversy shows that it is possible for major media corporations to air blatant racism. All they have to do is deny that that's what they are doing."

To be fair, CAP is quick to acknowledge that **CAPITAL CITIES** has some liberal hosts. Jim Hightower is carried week-ends by some of the company's stations, and Ronn Owens, who recently returned to the air waves via KGO-AM in San Francisco is, we gather, not a hater. The *San Francisco Chronicle* carried a story of 2-28-95 in which the reporter describes Owens as thinking of himself as "the voice of centrist reason when all of talk radio is in a race to become the biggest hotbed of right-wing reaction..." Owens recently beat Limbaugh in the ratings race in his listening area. His show will now attempt to gain a national audience.

NEWS BITES

The *Dallas Morning News* reported on 1-11-95 that The Democratic Party in Texas is mounting a program they call "Crush Rush With The Truth." The Chairman of the Party, Bob Slagle, said "hate radio is playing a major role in forming political opinion." The Texas Democrats are fighting back! They are encouraging large numbers of people to "talk back" by calling in to radio programs, and advertising on them with another point of view. They will also use television and newspapers to rebut lies and distortions. CAP has spoken with one of the "Crush Rush" team who is a veteran of radio production, and he is very upbeat about the whole Texas effort.

The *Daily Gazette* (Schenectady, NY) reported on 1-14-95 that the **Bob Grant** show was being syndicated nationally by Westwood One Entertainment in Los Angeles. WQBK-AM in Albany will now carry the show. Another clipping that caught attention at CAP Central was *The Morning Call's* (Allentown, PA) announcement on 1-12-95 that WAEB-AM would carry the show.

John Martin reports in the *Journal* (Providence, RI), a very significant bit (or bite as the case may be) of news which cappers may be glad to read. His column of 1-20-95 carried the headline, "**Radio Ratings Reveal Local Talk Is In Trouble.**" It seems that many listeners prefer soothing music to talk radio. "Every local talk host's ratings were down from the same time a year ago," says Martin.

nation of Beethoven could fill so many millions of files of death..."

Writing for the *West County Times* (Pinole, CA.), Tim Goodman calls KSFO "a 50,000-watt stupid magnet." He continues: **"KSFO is boring radio...It's billed as 'Hot Talk' but 'Hate Talk' is more appropriate.** The new format is a headline-grabbing ploy, since it enrages people and makes targeted groups feel like protesting. That brings out the cameras. That makes a station that couldn't buy an Arbitron ratings point get noticed. But these are short-term gains. A volatile mix of controversy and conservative politics will open some eyes, but nothing closes them faster than screaming hosts, "yes men" parading as callers, and inane repetition." (See Limbaugh, Boredom...Above)

Police Detective Michael Spearman works in El Cerrito, CA. He was (*Contra Costa Times*, 2-15-95) censured by the police union after he "called for the **lynching of liberals** and expressed other controversial views on women, homosexuals, and the Holocaust..." Spearman was hosting a show on Sundays on KSFO-AM.

The El Cerrito Police Officers Association wrote "a powerfully worded letter" calling some of his remarks, **"racist, sexist, and homophobic."** Detective Spearman agreed to read a disclaimer on the show so that people won't think his views have the sanction of the police department.

Capital Cities/ABC was in the news again on 2-16-95, because its station KSFO-AM fired J. Paul Emerson, a foul-mouthed host whose racist and anti-gay comments were causing a great deal of negative publicity for the company. Emerson had been fired less than a year before by his previous employer, KFRC, after he referred to "stinking Japanese" on the air during a discussion about WW II.

Capital Cities/ABC will become a sort of curse word in the mouths of liberals and moderates across the country because of the thugs and barbarians employed by that company. **The January/ February issue of *Extra!*, the magazine of FAIR (Fairness and Accuracy in Reporting) includes an excellent piece by Jim Naureckas about WABC and its most controversial host, Bob Grant.** Grant has repeatedly used the word "savages" when referring to blacks in America. In response to a caller who asked what he could do about the country falling apart, Grant told him to "get a gun and go something then."

The FAIR piece also tells us that Jay Diamond, another WABC talker "has repeatedly talked to police officers on the air, urging them to arrange for criminal suspects to 'commit suicide in police custody.'"

CAPITAL CITIES AND THE A-B-C'S OF HATE

Capital Cities/ABC owns two talk stations in San Francisco, KSFO-AM (560), and KGO-AM (810). During the first two months of this year, events surrounding these outlets generated a blizzard of press clips. In December of '94 KSFO fired people like Emil Guillermo (See his op-ed, above) and opted for what the station calls its "Hot Talk" format, thus turning the station into yet another outlet for right-wing catch phrases, and extremist hate-mongering.

Brad Kava, who writes a column called "Ear" for the *San Jose Mercury News*, made the following comment which appeared on 1-6-95: **"After a week of listening to the new 'Hot Talk' KSFO-AM (560), I can only think if one thing to say: Sieg Heil!"** He lists the shows and gives readers a sample of the wisdom of the KSFO ranters.

Here's a couple of examples: "Tom Kamb (9-Noon weekdays) insists an armed militia should harass and hurt violent criminals after they've served their prison sentences and have been released. Michael Savage (3-6 p.m. weekdays) argues you shouldn't hire the handicapped when, clearly, people with all their faculties can do a better job."

"What I've learned from this lineup of Limbaugh imitators" says Kava, "is that liberals are always bad; you can be a patriot and still launch personal smear attacks on your commander-in-chief, as long as he is a Democrat; crime and murder are bad except when they're aimed at abortion doctors; the only people with reason are those who agree with neo-Republican doctrine." Kava suggests ignoring these programs, but, he says, if you are "really ambitious" you can let those who advertise on these shows know that "the station doesn't speak to you or your community." **Bravo, Kava!** May there be many more like him....And, come to think of it, there are!

Rob Morse's column of 2-19-95 in the *San Francisco Examiner-Chronicle* points out that hateful words can have fateful, even fatal consequences: **"Suddenly, hate is in fashion.** This year's styles in the Bay area are cut from bedsheets. Law students at UC Berkeley who don't happen to be white are finding hate mail in their boxes. A San Francisco radio station makes money with talk show hosts who urge the murder of liberals and illegal immigrants, and say the holocaust gets too much attention. It clearly doesn't get enough attention. **Recall that Nazism started with hateful talk too...**If conservatives are serious about studying the history of civilization, the core of the curriculum must be the holocaust. To be civilized, to be truly conservative, one must struggle to understand how the

The question here is this: Is the Limbaugh program entertaining? If it is, how will it remain so? If Mr. Limbaugh becomes too genial and does not rant enough, will he lose his popularity? How often must he come up with new material?

CAP's reading of all this, folks, now just listen, is that Limbaugh is becoming less popular and he is worried. There are, shall we say, hairline cracks and fissures in Humpty Dumpty's wall. Mr. Limbaugh was heard to say on a recent program, "I've bored myself talking about Clinton's budget!" On March 1st, he prefaced some remarks about welfare reform by saying, "food stamps might sound like a boring thing to discuss..."

And now, the portly, multi-millionaire ranter who opposes welfare and once accepted unemployment compensation, has jumped head-first into the giant pool of OJ coverage. He used to boast that his motto was "no OJ, none of the time." He explains his conversion by saying that he is "driven by passion" to discuss OJ. But the more logical explanation is that he suspects the public is more interested in the trial than in his tiresome repetitions. And so it has become apparent he is just another ratings chaser.

Limbaugh's television program of March 16th showed him playing games with a mannequin leg, a plate of blood, an extra-large glove and a sock, his way of commenting on the issues before the judge and jury. He attempts to cover the trial as if OJ's side represents liberals, and the prosecution represents Republicans. The absurdity of this contention is plain to any but the most benighted sensibility.

But there's the rub: Limbaugh must be increasingly strident and racist to keep up with the talk radio competition and make himself controversial, but such an approach will ensure his status as a recognized extremist. He will alienate his more politically moderate listeners in the same way the Republican Party's 1992 convention frightened centrists. But if he backs away from the strident talk and the racism he will become boring.

Yes, folks, it's really unbelievable, it's amazing, you can hear it! Just listen to him. On one day he will attempt to moderate slightly, and to ice his hatred, on another day he will be blatantly racist as he was in a recent attack on the singer of the RAP group NWA. The rapper went public recently with the fact that he has AIDS. He said he did it so he could warn young people against the same fate. Limbaugh derided the singer, and called the whole incident "disgusting."

The article also discusses Don Baker of KVOR in Colorado Springs and his critics' claims that his broadcasts inspired Francisco Martin Duran to attack the White House.

The second article was written by Timothy Egan, and was given headlines such as (*Orlando Sentinel* 1/15/95) "Newt's in, so what's left to talk about?" or (*Missorian* 1-5-95) "Who's Left?" The article says that Clinton bashing is not the hot topic it once was, and that the radio hosts who have dedicated themselves to the Republican cause may find it difficult to sustain the same level of popularity they had as critical outsiders, now that their team is playing.

"Nationally" says Egan, **"the fastest growing new radio host in syndication is Jim Hightower, the Texas liberal."**

Robert Unmacht is the editor of the "M Street Directory" which identifies trends in radio. He told Egan that Limbaugh, "succeeds because he is an entertainer. He will die as soon as he ceases to be entertaining."

LIMBAUGH, BOREDOM AND THE "GENIAL RANTER"

The New York Times ran a puff-piece about Michael Reagan in its "living arts" section on 2-22-95. John Tierney, the author of the piece, described Reagan as, "a genial ranter." CAP thought this a curious way to describe him. For those who have heard Mr. Reagan or read his propaganda when it was available through America Online, there is nothing genial about him. His willingness to serve as a mouthpiece for the far-right, attacking health care reform, and disseminating articles from British tabloid newspapers carrying vile allegations about the President, is truly disgusting.

But, despite all this, we cappers have a sense of fun, and we try to give newspaper men the benefit of the doubt. Perhaps this oxymoron, "genial ranter," was meant to capture something of the spirit of the man, and the contradictions of his character. Whatever his intent, Mr. Tierney's turn of phrase brings up an interesting point. We will discuss it in terms of Rush Limbaugh because he is the most popular ranter, and, of late, one of the most boring.

It is difficult, the author tells us, to explain Limbaugh's success, just as it is difficult to explain why Iago plots Othello's destruction. Limbaugh tells people "what they want to hear." He gives people simple answers to complex and troubling questions. Rush, says Wooten, "has also made some ugly aspects of human nature acceptable...There are wrinkles in the human psyche which mature, civilized folk express only in private: prejudice, racism, cruelty, derision, and rejection of minorities and others who are 'different.' Rush had made a lot of this stuff acceptable by making it the subject of humorous monologues. It's not obscene; it's merely mean."

INDIANAPOLIS BUSINESS JOURNAL, 3-5-95: "Guns, Ammo, Threats, and Talk Radio" by Jeff Cohen and Norman Solomon

"Ask members of the public to describe the right edge of talk radio" begins the Cohen-Solomon piece, "and they're likely to mention Rush Limbaugh. Not even close. The spectrum has moved so far rightward that in many markets, Limbaugh sounds like a moderate."

The major media companies are behind people who talk about eliminating "traitors," believe in bizarre conspiracy theories, and support right-wing militias. Chuck Baker, who some say inspired Francisco Martin Duran's attack on the White House, is still on the air (CA.P. italics). He advocates "armed revolution" against the government. Gordon Liddy told his listeners to shoot ATF agents in the head to avoid the bullet proof vests they wear. During the same program he said, "kill the sons of bitches."

San Francisco hosts can be heard talking about lynching liberals and shooting illegal immigrants.

TALK ABOUT TALK

GEMS OF THE TIMES

Two January articles from the *New York Times* were reprinted in newspapers all over the country.

Our clipping of the first of these articles comes from the Albany, NY *Times-Union* of 1/1/95. It carried the headline, "On Talk Radio, A Tendency to Take Free Speech Too Far." **Bob Mohan of KFYI in Phoenix** said Sarah Brady "ought to be put down...Because of all her barking and complaining, she really needs to be put down." Mohan doesn't like gun control.

"Mr. Armey has now won a permanent place in the annals of Congressional disrepute. But his is only one man, and some Republicans will warn against making too much of this incident. But the greater danger for serious citizens is to ignore the pattern of accumulating incidents. Senator Jesse Helms's quip about physical harm to President Clinton was a single incident. So was Rep. Robert Dornan's absurd declaration that Mr. Clinton is a traitor. It was, indeed, but a single speech in which the Speaker advanced the crackpot charge that 'there is no grotesquerie, no distortion, no dishonesty too great' for his opponents to use against him.

"Such individual showers of hyperbole have produced a venomous mist that now envelops Capitol Hill..."

THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE, 2-24-95: "Who Asked for Your Opinion?" by William H. Rentschler

The writer condemns the constant attacks by Rush Limbaugh and his conservative brethren on the mainstream media:

"The increasingly powerful organs of the right-print and electronic-contrive to blunt the impact and counter the influence of what they deride as the 'liberal media,' especially the nation's largest daily newspapers and a handful of TV superstars, which they are convinced pose a danger to 'their' America. This assault to me is patently phony, strictly strategic in its intent to undermine public trust in traditional sources of news and opinion..."

"...The ultimate effect of this frontal attack on the mainstream media is to sew seeds of doubt in the public mind; to narrow- not broaden- rational debate, and thus widen the chasm that separates Americans from one another..."

ARGUS (Rock Island, IL.), 3-5-95: "What Makes Rush Popular?" by Don Wooten

There is no doubt in Wooten's mind that Limbaugh helped elect a Republican congress: "He ran a propaganda mill of innuendo and slander couched in such amiable terms that it garnered a huge audience which simply went to the polls and did as it was told.

"The new Republican majority won with little more than 20 percent of the voters. But it was a 20 percent which was focused, purposeful, and single-minded. In a Presidential year, Rush's followers would have been but one of several constituencies. In an off-year election, they were the margin of victory."

Hightower. A fervent, irreverent, provocative thinker and a fast, funny talker, his seven-month-old talk show, 'Hightower Radio,' is now carried week-ends in 180 markets..."

"Local program executives who have so far been cool to Hightower say they are driven by commercialism, not conservatism. 'Hightower Radio,' with its new feature, 'Eye on Newt,' (complete with Macbeth's cackling witches) is a hoot, and could be a hit.

"How about it, WRKO?"

THE WASHINGTON POST, 1-29-95: "Ideological Cleansing on Talk Radio" by Emil Guillermo

The writer is a former host of NPR's "All Things Considered," who took a job at KSFO radio in San Francisco, a station owned by Capital Cities/ABC. He was fired December 30th, after just four months on the air.

"It wasn't about my performance, which they praised. Nope," writes Mr. Guillermo, "the station managers said they were merely following a trend evidenced by the November elections...Their news release proclaimed, '1995, OUT: Liberal Media, Political Correctness, the Democratic Party, IN: HOT TALK 560.'"

Mr. Guillermo tell us that his show was "compelling, youthful, and different. I parodied the Rush-meister loudly, proclaiming that I had 'talent on loan from Buddha.' " He concedes that the change might make money for the stations owners: "As a business move, All Newt Radio could be a stroke of genius. But its really more of the same on the talk show air waves, where diversity has been a real joke. Just 30 percent of talk show hosts identify themselves as liberal. And more than a few of those have token slots on under powered stations.. Divergence of opinion? Nowhere to be found."

THE NEW YORK TIMES, 1-29-95: "Hate Speech Comes to Congress"

In our December mailing, we wrote: "Those of us who have listened to talk radio and have been shocked at what we have heard can't help observing that the tail is now wagging the dog. The talk radio ethic, like toxic gas, pervades the civic and political landscape."

The New York Times editorial says the "Republican Congressional leadership has coarsened American political discourse to a remarkable degree in a very short time." House majority leader Dick Armey is justly criticized for his reference to Rep. Barney Frank, as "Barney Fag."

commentators are so powerful and unaccountable because their listeners don't demand better of them. But this is a relatively new phenomenon and novelty is part of the appeal. A daily dose of outrage is likely to become boring after a while. Discerning listeners will figure out that rabid partisanship -of the right or left- is not by definition 'telling it like it is.' It is merely propaganda, no matter how much fun."

ATLANTIC CITY PRESS (Pleasantville, NJ), 12-22-95: "Hating The Clintons, It's Getting Scary"

The editorial poses the following question: "So is Rush Limbaugh responsible for the fact that bullets have hit the White House twice in the last two months?" No, says the writer, but goes on to make it a qualified no.

There is no conspiracy, "but it is not so far-fetched to see these incidents as a natural and unfortunate outgrowth of the kind of personal hatred of the Clintons that is spreading through the land...Limbaugh and his talk show clones are part of it. CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR, 12-5-94: "T.V. and the Public Interest"
by Jerry M. Landay

A professor and former news correspondent tells us that the Communications Act of 1927 gave the federal government the power to enforce a public interest standard: "The renewal of station licenses to run a lucrative business on a public frequency was to be based on the extent to which their programs served 'the public interest, convenience and necessity.'"

The government deliberately left open the question of exactly how the "PICON standard" was to be applied. Nonetheless, it was a sort of "guardian" of the public trust.

"Starting with the Reagan years," Prof. Landay says, "the federal government began to dilute the public interest standard. Now, under the Clinton Administration, it is virtually dead." PBS has suffered a "chilling muzzle" imposed by Senate conservatives, and right-wing talk radio hosts have "abused the public interest, and misused the power of the public air..."

According to the Professor, the current FCC continues Reagan-like policies, allowing a single owner to buy more stations than ever before. Money raised from an auction on frequencies (for telephone and computer) will be applied to reduce the federal deficit. This money would better be used, says Landay, for "the upgrading, expansion and improvement of mass communications in the public sector."

PITTSBURGH POST-GAZETTE (Pittsburgh, PA), 12-12-94: "Talking Trash" subtitle: "Outrageous radio pundits may be a passing phenomenon."

Begins by quoting Leon Panetta from the previous week as saying that Newt Gingrich was like an out-of-control talk-show host. "As a group" says the Post-Gazette, "radio talk-show hosts *are* out of control." The final paragraph is worth quoting: "Talk-show

According to the day-care operators, the requests originated with parents. "That may speak volumes" says Mr. Parker, " about the popularity hereabouts of Mr. Limbaugh or other mindless-media outlets."

Thus, fraudulent advice or misleading advertising, because of the palpable economic results, may lead to legal action by the state or by consumers. Even more damaging to the society as a whole, however, are the falsehoods, distortions, and soundbite summaries of complex problems blaring from the talk radio speakers.

Tune in to AM radio, or look through newspapers large and small, and you will find examples. *The Spokesman Review* (Spokane, WA) reported on March 1st that negotiations between the Kaiser Aluminum Corp. and the United Steelworkers regarding a strike have been made more difficult because of "erroneous reports and misguided gossip." This sentiment, according to the newspaper, was shared by both labor and management.

Larry Schreiner, a columnist for *The Daily Herald* (Palatine, IL.), reported on March 15th that a talk radio host in Chicago violated the privacy of a certain wealthy suburbanite, by describing his home and making it plain how one might find the place. Gawkers and trespassers have now become a problem for this individual and for police.

The three-hour tirades of talk radio hosts seemed designed, at their worst, to incite violence, and at best, to encourage hatred. Gordon Liddy tells his listeners to shoot ATF agents in the head, while others suggest liberals should be lynched. (See the summary of the op-ed GUNS, AMMO, THREATS AND TALK RADIO, below)

We have become a society which, under the guise of free speech, curtails it, allowing radical hawkers of hate unprecedented control of the airwaves. The uniformity of the talk radio viewpoint has been startling. Taken as a whole, a vast river of propaganda is rushing against the U.S. government. The right-wingers, whether of Capital Cities/ ABC, or religious stations, tell listeners the government is their worst enemy.

But there are many hopeful signs that things are beginning to change. Let us work together, as we embrace Spring, 1995, to

MISLEADING OR FRAUDULENT? HATEFUL OR CRIMINAL? A FAINT AND FADING LINE

On January 29th of this year, Henry Gilgoff of *New York Newsday* reported that Harry "Sonny" Block, a financial advice guru and self-styled consumer advocate who hosts a radio show carried by 170 stations, "now faces accusations that he betrayed his listeners' trust by recommending questionable investments that he either failed to adequately check, or that benefited him personally. And a federal inquiry is under way into a deal that Bloch himself put together and pitched." The story also reveals that 250 investors in a are suing Bloch for "recklessly" endorsing a company which has since closed.

Allan Sloan, in his column of the same date, gives *Newsday* readers some common-sense advice: "...listening to the radio is a fine way to pass the time and pick up some useful tidbits. But it's no way to decide how to invest your money."

Another newspaper columnist, Roy Parker Jr. of the *Observer-Times* in Fayetteville, N.C. warned his readers on 12-17-94 to beware of those who would use "false advertising" to peddle "snake oil." He was referring to the Federal Trade Commission's move against a product known as "Hooked on Phonics," which has been advertised regularly on the Rush Limbaugh program and elsewhere. It was announced on 12-14-94 that the company which produces this product was forced by the FTC to sign an agreement to quit making "unsubstantiated claims" in its ads.

"According to the advertising," writes Mr. Parker, "your child will become a Shakespearean scholar in about 72 hours by listening to these...It doesn't work that way. Reading takes a lot more than listening...learning requires hard work..."

Mr. Parker goes on to point out that such false advertising can have immediate and dangerous consequences, as it almost did in Cumberland County, N.C. Day-care center operators there asked for state funds to purchase the \$230.00 "Hooked On Phonics" kit as part of grant applications to a new state-supported pre-school program. Fortunately, state "evaluators" caught this in time, thus saving the tax-payers from becoming a victim of specious advertising claims.

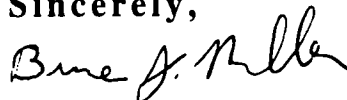
Dear Cappers,

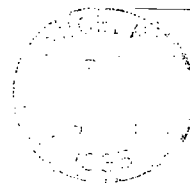

Japan wins war of words; V-J Day out

A Washington Post Report

TOKYO — And now another familiar turn of phrase has become politically incorrect. Please, don't ever say "V-J Day."

With the combatants of World War II gearing up to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the war's end, Japan's diplomats have been asking other countries to eschew the term "V-J Day" to describe Aug. 15, 1945 — the day Japan's surrender ended the war.

That date has been known ever since in many English-speaking countries as "V-J Day" — that is, "Victory-over-Japan Day."

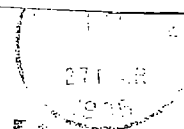
But the term has long troubled the Japanese. People here note that the date of Germany's surrender, May 8, 1945, is known as "V-E Day" for "Victory in Europe" — not "Victory over Germany." To the Japanese, that means they have been singled out for linguistic hostility.

Accordingly, Tokyo has been asking other nations to find some less Japan-specific nomenclature to describe the historic day.

The effort has scored some successes. Australia's government has agreed to drop "V-J Day" and use the term "Victory in the Pacific Day" instead. The U.S. government will use the term "end of the war" in all commemorative activities.



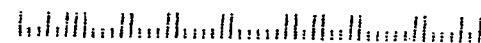

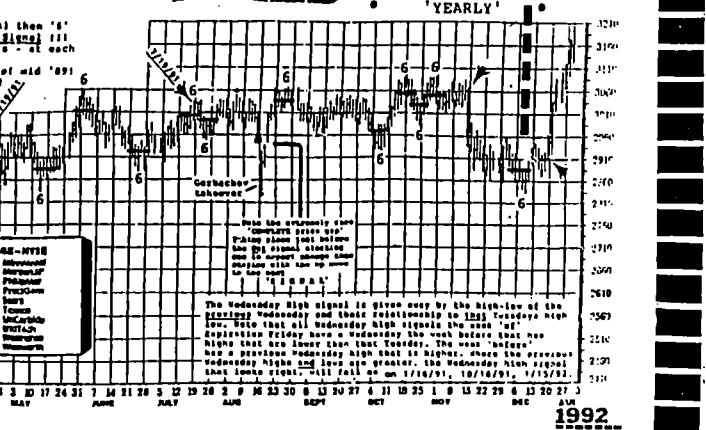
