MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, EAST ASIA AND PACIFIC REGION (ISA)

SUBJECT: Transfer of Defense Articles to the ROK

Section 509 of the FY94/95 Foreign Relations Authorization Act, signed by the President on April 30, 1994, requires that the President notify the Congress of the items we intend to transfer to the Republic of Korea (ROK) and the concessions we expect to receive in return. The attached draft letters to the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate, the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House, and the Congressional defense committees, serve that purpose (Tab 1). The letters are based on terms which have been coordinated by United States Forces, Korea, and approved by Department of the Army.

Request you obtain State Department and National Security Council approval of the letters, and have the letters signed by the appropriate Administration official and forwarded to the Congress. Please also provide copies of the signed letters to my office so that we may determine when the 30-day notification period has ended.

We also will need State Department authorization to negotiate and conclude an agreement with the ROK concerning the transfers and the concessions. A draft agreement is also attached (Tab 2). Such authorization to negotiate and conclude an agreement should be delegated to the Department of Defense and should include authority to begin negotiations with the ROK on a second set of transfers and concessions. **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES
AND THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL DEFENSE OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA
CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES
FROM UNITED STATES WAR RESERVES STOCKS TO THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA
AND THE WAIVER OF UNITED STATES MUNITIONS STORAGE COSTS BY THE
REPUBLIC OF KOREA**

1. The Department of Defense of the United States of America (US) and the Ministry of National Defense of the Republic of Korea (ROK) have agreed that the Department of Defense will transfer certain war reserve equipment and supplies from the US Army war reserves to the ROK Army, and, in return, the Ministry of National Defense waives some of the past storage costs which arose as a result of ROK Army's services in support of US ammunition stockpile.

2. The equipment and supplies to be transferred to the ROK are listed in Appendix A, munitions for which the storage costs will be waived and the periods of waiver in Appendix B, and the value of the transferred equipment and supplies and the value of the waived past storage costs of US munitions in Appendix C.

3. The Department of Defense (US) will:

a. Transfer equipment and supplies listed in Appendix A to the Republic of Korea, Ministry of National Defense in an "as is, where is" condition.

b. Transfer title and accountability of the equipment and supplies to the ROK Army upon ROK Army's signature on the receipt within one month after exchanging written notification as stated in Article 6.

c. Provide 200,000 rounds of 155mm dual purpose, improved conventional munitions (D563) and 200,000 fuzes (N235) to the WRSA stockpile to replace 155mm high explosive munitions retrograded to CONUS prior to completing the retrograde of the high explosive munitions.

d. Complete the retrograde of US munitions planned to be withdrawn from the Korean Peninsula, within the period stated in Appendix B.

e. Reimburse ROK Army for the storage costs which exceed the period described in Appendix B, and transportation and port handling services performed by the ROK Army for the WRSA munitions described in Appendix B in accordance with the SALS-K Memorandum of Understanding on SALS-K Reimbursement Rates in effect at the time the services are performed.

f. Retain the munitions identified in Appendix B as WRSA until retrograded.

4. The ROK MND will:

a. Waive past storage costs, as listed in Appendix C, for munitions stored in the ROK which the US Army will transfer to the ROK, demilitarize or retrograde from the ROK.

b. Waive the storage costs for the munitions mentioned in Paragraph A, Article 4, for the period described in Appendix B.

c. Dispose of certain excess or obsolete munitions which are requested by the US to be destroyed, except munitions included in Appendix A, in accordance with current procedures for destruction of WRSA munitions under the SALS-K MOA (25 Nov 1974).

d. Certify that the property transferred to the Republic of Korea in accordance with this agreement is intended for use by the armed forces of the Republic of Korea.

e. Not sell, barter, export, or otherwise transfer the equipment and supplies provided under this agreement to any third party without the express written consent of the US Government.

5. This memorandum of agreement is executed in duplicate, in the English and Korean languages, both texts being equally authentic. In the case of divergence in executing or interpreting this MOA, it will be adjusted through negotiation between representatives designated by each party.

6. This agreement shall enter into force on the date when the Parties exchange written notifications that the Agreement has been approved in accordance with their respective internal legal procedures.
