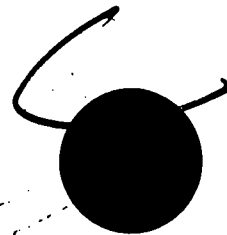

Dear Tony,

I am alarmed by Lynn Davis' article in the Post on January 26, 1994. I assume it was an official statement of policy, duly cleared.

Yet it contains this astonishing sentence. "If the North launched military operations, it would be defeated, but we would be engaged alongside our South Korean Allies in a major war that could leave destruction throughout much of the peninsula." I had thought, from what the President has said on the subject, and what Senator Nunn and Senator Lugar said on television last night, that our objective is to prevent North Korea from acquiring even one nuclear weapon. Kim Il Sung's strategy is based on the hypothesis that we would not send ground troops into action against the risk of their being attacked by nuclear weapons. Kim will read Lynn's sentence to mean that we would not act decisively unless he did invade South Korea again--that is, that we would not act against the possible acquisition of a nuclear weapon as Kennedy did at the Bay of Pigs, and as Israel did at Osirak in 1981. This is the kind of reasoning lawyer's call a "negative pregnant"--by saying "no" to one possibility, you say "yes" to another. Kim Il Sung expects to get his way without having to invade South Korea at all. That is Saddam Hussein's reasoning, too. And that is why the proliferation problem is so difficult.

I agree that we must act to prevent the North Korean acquisition of any nuclear bombs. I am aware of intelligence estimates here, in Britain, and in Russia that conclude Kim already has at least a few nuclear weapon. And I believe the President of the United States should never be placed in the position of having to choose between abandoning a major security interest of the United States and sending troops into battle against a nuclear Saddam Hussein, Kim Il Sung, or Castro.

I won't add (again) that it is long since past the time when we should have given up the silly farce of economic sanctions, which have never done any good but have often done a great deal of harm, i.e., at Pearl Harbor.
