Dear President Clinton:

1994 is a very special year for Korean Americans in the Bay Area of San Francisco. It marks the twentieth anniversary of the founding of the Korean Center, Inc., a nonprofit community based organization dedicated to educating and training newly arrived immigrants, in order for them to become productive and contributing citizens of American society.

A December 1st celebration of the Korean Center's outstanding record of service to the Bay Area is planned, and your participation and recognition would be most appreciated. The Korean Center needs your encouragement, especially as new and greater challenges of multiculturalism have been brought to bear. It has been a beacon and cultural institution for the oldest Korean community in the United States, playing the lead role in preserving the ethnic history of Korean Americans and their rich ancestral heritage. Yearly events held by the Korean Center such as the Min Sok Festival reinvigorate the Korean American community and serve as a positive demonstration of the diversity which makes our

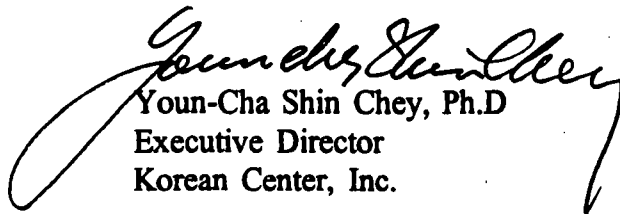

Your encouragement would demonstrate that the promotion of social harmony in our increasingly multicultural society is a collaborative effort for which we all share responsibility.
