^EU's Prodi wants truth on ``Balkan syndrome``

ROME, Jan 4 (Reuters) - European Commission President Romano

Prodi said on Thursday he wanted to light to be shed on claims linking depleted uranium from spent NATO ammunition to deaths or illnesses among alliance soldiers who served in the Balkans.

In an interview with Italian state radio RAI, Prodi said arms coated with depleted uranium should not be used if there was even the slightest risk for soldiers or for civilians.

``I want the truth to be ascertained, not only concerning the soldiers, but also for the people who lived near them, the population,`` Prodi told RAI.

``It is clear that if there is even a minimal risk, these arms must be abolished. And even if this risk was not there, I don't like the idea of using these particular weapons,`` he said.

The so-called ``Balkan syndrome`` has come under the spotlight over the past few days following claims that six Italian soldiers who served in the former Yugoslavia developed leukaemia and died after exposure to the ammunition.

Italy asked NATO on Wednesday to investigate the cases. Similar requests also came from Portugal and Belgium, which have also reported deaths among soldiers who served in the Balkans. Five soldiers have died in Belgium and one in Portugal.

Prodi said he was not only concerned about the ``Balkan syndrome`` but also about the environmental damage caused by the wars in Bosnia and Yugoslavia.

``As Commission president, I propose starting immediate contacts with the governments of Bosnia and Serbia to discuss pollution and the problems linked to depleted uranium,`` he told the radio.

NATO sources said on Wednesday the North Atlantic Council and NATO's political committee would discuss the issue next week.

^ICRC says tests of Kosovo staff showed no uranium

GENEVA, Jan 5 (Reuters) - The International Committee of the Red Cross said on Friday that it had tested more than 30 of its staff deployed during the Kosovo war and none showed traces of depleted uranium.

But the Swiss-run humanitarian organisation said that it was following the so-called "Balkan Syndrome" closely and awaited the results of further scientific research.

The U.S. Defense Department said on Thursday there was no proof that depleted uranium bullets used by U.S. warplanes in Bosnia and Kosovo caused cancer or other ills among European peacekeeping troops in the Balkans.

"Last May, we tested 32 expatriate and local staff who had served at least three months in Kosovo and volunteered for 24-hour urine tests," ICRC spokesman Vincent Lusser told Reuters in Geneva.

"All the tests were negative for any abnormal concentration of uranium. We concluded that these people were not exposed to uranium," he added. "There is no immediate reason to be concerned about the health of our staff, but we cannot draw general conclusions from this limited test."

The ICRC delegates, who represented a "significant sample" of those deployed, had worked especially in western Kosovo around Jakova and Prizren, according to the agency spokesman.

Depleted uranium is used in the tips of missiles, shells and bullets to increase their ability to penetrate armour and can be pulverised on impact into a toxic radioactive dust, defence experts say.

European Commission President Romano Prodi demanded on Thursday to know the truth behind a spate of recent claims that debris from depleted uranium used in NATO weapons had caused death or illness among peacekeepers.

The syndrome came under the spotlight following reports that six Italian soldiers who served in the former Yugoslavia had developed leukaemia and died after exposure to spent ammunition.

(U) IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED IN THE 23 APRIL EDITION OF THE FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE, PROFESSOR MAXIME SCHWARTZ, DIRECTOR OF THE PASTEUR INSTITUTE, ADDRESSED THE ISSUE OF THE LEAKED OFFICE OF SCIENTIFIC INTEGRITY REPORT ON PROFESSOR ROBERT GALLO AND OF THE FUTURE OF THE JOINT ANGLO-FRENCH PATENT AGREEMENT REGARDING THE

AIDS TEST.

2. (U) PROFESSOR SCHWARTZ IS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT THE ARTICLES PUBLISHED IN LIBERATION (REFTEL) DID NOT SURPRISE HIM, SINCE THEY CONTAINED BASICALLY THE SAME INFORMATION AS THE ARTICLES BY JOHN CREWDSON, PUBLISHED IN THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE.

3. (U) ON THE SUBJECT OF USG RESPONSE, SCHWARTZ IS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT HE "IS BEGINNING TO LOSE PATIENCE. IT IS NOW MORE THAN THREE MONTHS SINCE WE SENT A MEMORANDUM TO THE AMERICAN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, AND WE HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED A RESPONSE. WE ARE GOING TO END UP THINKING THAT THE AMERICAN AUTHORITIES ARE LOOKING TO BURY THE AFFAIR."

4. (U) THE ARTICLE ENDS BY STATING THAT, IF THE USG CONTINUES "WITH THIS ATTITUDE", SCHWARTZ ALONG WITH PASTEUR LAWYERS AND THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT ARE PREPARED TO TAKE OTHER ACTIONS TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE.

5. (LOU) FOR WASHINGTON. POST WOULD APPRECIATE AN UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF THE OSI REPORT AND ON THE USG RESPONSES TO THE VARIOUS GOF REQUESTS FOR MEETINGS. POST WOULD ALSO APPRECIATE INFORMATION ON THE TYPE OF COVERAGE THIS ISSUE IS RECEIVING IN THE US PRESS. IN PARTICULAR, COPIES OF THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE ARTICLES ON THE SUBJECT WOULD BE

VERY HELPFUL.

1. (U) IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE FRENCH DAILY
LIBERATION (25 APRIL EDITION, PAGE 28), FRENCH
MINISTER FOR RESEARCH, TECHNOLOGY AND SPACE
HUBERT CURIEN STATED THAT THE FRANCO-AMERICAN
ACCORD SIGNED IN 1987 WAS "CONCLUDED ON ERRONEOUS
DATA". HE ALSO SAID THAT THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT
WOULD NOT HAVE SIGNED THE ACCORD, HAD IT KNOWN
THEN WHAT IT KNOWS TODAY. LE MONDE ALSO CARRIED
A STORY ON CURIEN'S POSITION.
2. (U) IN THE LIBERATION ARTICLE, CURIEN GOES
ON TO STATE THAT HE IS INVOLVING HIMSELF IN THE
MATTER BOTH BECAUSE, AS MINISTER OF RESEARCH, HE
HAS A RESPONSIBILITY TO DEFEND THE EFFORTS OF
FRENCH SCIENTISTS AND BECAUSE THE PASTEUR
INSTITUTE HAS REQUESTED HIS ASSISTANCE.
3. (U) IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION REGARDING HIS
FUTURE ACTIONS, CURIEN STATED THAT HE IS
INCREASING CONTACT WITH THE USG. HE HAS
DISCUSSED THE MATTER WITH PRESIDENTIAL SCIENCE
ADVISER BROMLEY AND AMBASSADOR CURLEY. HE STATED
THAT HE HOPES TO DISCUSS THE MATTER WITH HHS
SECRETARY SULLIVAN DURING HIS UP-COMING TRIP TO
WASHINGTON.
4. (U) WHEN ASKED ABOUT PURSUING THE MATTER IN
THE COURTS, CURIEN DID NOT RULE OUT THE
POSSIBILITY, BUT POINTED OUT THE HIGH COSTS OF
LITIGATION IN THE US SYSTEM. HE CONTINUED BY
SAYING THAT "THIS IS WHY I AM HOPING FOR A LOT
FROM MY MEETINGS WITH ALLAN BROMLEY MY COLLEAGUE
WHO IS ALSO A FRIEND."
5. (LOU) POST CONTACTED THE MINISTRY OF
