The President and Mrs. Clinton are pleased to invite all EOP passholders, and **2** guests, to the Arrival Ceremony for His Excellency Carlos Saúl Menem, President of the Argentine Nation, on the morning of Monday, January 11, 1999 at 9:30 a.m.

Passholders and their guests enter the South Lawn using the **Southwest** Gate, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. **The gate closes promptly** at 9:00 a.m. No one is admitted after that time.

EOP passholders, with hard passes that display the passholder picture, may attend if the pass is one of the following types: CONTRACTOR, E/EOB, LE, MAC, MIL, N/NEOB, NGS, OGA, RES, SE, U, and W. Other pass types, or those whose passes do not bear their photo, may not attend using this procedure.

Please fill out the bottom portion of this memo with your guest's name (as it appears on his or her picture ID), date of birth, social security number, and citizenship and submit **this original form with the label intact** to the Visitors Office by 12:00 p.m. on Monday, January 4 at 12:00 noon, (no photocopies accepted).

If you or your guests have special needs, please notify the Visitors Office by January 8, 1999. Passholders must pick up guest tickets in the OEOB Pennsylvania Avenue lobby on **Friday, January 8**, at 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. Tickets are not required for passholders; present your pass at the Southwest Gate upon entry. *Passholders must accompany their guests.*
