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NORTH_KOREA NUCLEAR ISSUE - PRESS THEMES

- o North Korea's non-compliance with the nuclear safeguards obligations its treaty with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) and its announced decision to withdraw from the Nuclear Non-proliferation Treaty (NPT) potentially pose a grave threat to peace and stability on the Korean Peninsula and possibly even elsewhere.
- o The U.S. has joined the international community in deploring North Korea's actions, and in urging that it comply with its treaty commitments and remain a party to the NPT.
- o The U.S. is consulting closely with members of the U.N. Security Council about next steps. The U.N. has available to it a wide range of diplomatic measures from which to chose. The Security Council President's April 9 statement supportive of the IAEA and the NPT was a good first step.
- o We have said that we are prepared to play our part in that process. We have not ruled out a U.S. meeting with North Korea if it could help resolve the situation.
 - But as we have consistently said, this is an issue between North Korea and the international community, and our task is to support the efforts of the appropriate international bodies.
- o The U.S. remains fully committed to a Korean Peninsula free of nuclear weapons, and to the security of the Republic of Korea.

SUBJECT: TASKER: MEMO TO THE PRESIDENT ON FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

NOTE FROM WILL ITOH:

Tony Lake has asked this office to draft a memorandum to the President which would focus on international developments over the next 6-8 months. The memo would consist of three sections:

- (1) A checklist of major issues of interest to the President with 1-3 sentences explaining how we think each issue might develop over the period (Russia, Bosnia, South Africa, Middle East Peace process, Cambodia, POW/MIAs, etc).
- (2) A listing of events which could involved the President over the period, including visits, trips, and speeches. (UNGA participation, APEC meeting, etc).
- (3) A calendar of major international events including those involving the President.

I have asked State to (1) provide an updated internation affairs calendar and (2) a draft of their proposed list of visits for the second half of 1993.

Each office is asked to provide by 10:00 a.m. tomorrow (Tuesday, April 20) input in draft for the checklist of major issues and the listing of events.

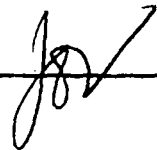
