NORTH KOREA PRESS THEMES

- Our goals are clear: a non-nuclear Korean peninsula and a robust international nonproliferation regime.
- We do not seek a confrontation with North Korea, nor do we want to use the current situation to bring about political change in the DPRK. *not
2d pt*
- We must, however, respond seriously to evidence that North Korea breached its treaty obligations, and may be pursuing a nuclear weapons capability.
- This is not a bilateral U.S.-North Korea issue. Countries around the world have joined in deploring North Korea's actions and in calling for it to return to compliance with its nonproliferation commitments.
- [-- The Security Council has gone on record calling for North Korea to reverse its course.] [For use after the resolution is adopted.]
- Nonetheless, we are prepared to meet with North Korean officials, if that will help resolve the current situation.
- We will say to them that we are not threatening their country with nuclear weapons or in any other way.
- We are also prepared to discuss their security concerns, [and to listen seriously to their ideas] }
- We will again tell them that if they honor their nonproliferation commitments, we are prepared to begin a broad-ranging dialogue that could lead to improved relations with the U.S. and other countries. (?)

- But North Korea's leaders must also understand that the international community has a critical stake in the integrity of the nonproliferation regime. Neither we nor others can ignore either actions that undermine that regime or the prospect of nuclear weapons proliferation in a volatile region like the Korean peninsula.
- There should be no doubt that the U.S. is prepared to take tough actions to meet this challenge to the nonproliferation regime.

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**JOINT STATEMENT
OF THE DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA
AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

New York, June 10, 1993

The Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the United States of America held government-level talks in New York from the 2nd through the 10th of June, 1993. Present at the talks were the delegation of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea headed by First Vice Minister of Foreign Affairs Kang Sok Ju and the delegation of the United States of America led by Assistant Secretary of State Robert L. Gallucci, both representing their respective Governments. At the talks, both sides have discussed policy matters with a view to a fundamental solution of the nuclear issue on the Korean Peninsula. Both sides expressed support for the North-South Denuclearization Declaration and adherence to the international nuclear non-proliferation regime.

The Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) and the United States have agreed to continue discussion of principles on:

- peace and security in a nuclear-free Korean Peninsula, including acceptance of fullscope safeguards and non-interference in each other's internal affairs,
- support for peaceful reunification of Korea, and
- assurances against the threat and use of force.

In this context, the two Governments have agreed to continue dialogue and negotiations on an equal and unprejudiced basis. In this respect, the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea has decided to unilaterally suspend as long as it considers necessary the effectuation of its withdrawal from the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, and thus remain subject to international safeguards.

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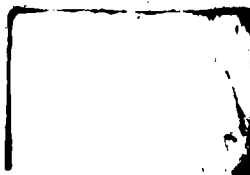

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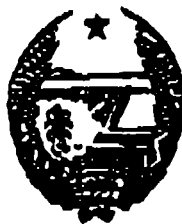

I have the honour to draw the attention of the Security Council to the systematic abuse of Safeguards Agreement between the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) by some officials of the Secretariat of the IAEA.

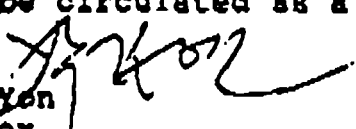
Some officials of the Secretariat of the IAEA have demanded the inspections of the military sites of the DPRK on the basis of the fabricated "satellite intelligence information" provided by the United States, in violation of due observance of the sovereign rights of States, which is stipulated in Paragraph D, Article 3 of the Statute of the IAEA.

They systematically handed over the secret information of the inspections to the United States and made public of the results of the inspection, in contravention of the principles of neutrality and impartiality and non-disclosure of secret in the performance of their duties, which is defined in Paragraph F, Article 7 of the Statute of the IAEA.

The United States, in violation of its obligations under the NPT, has imposed a nuclear threat against the DPRK, systematically interfered in the IAEA's inspection and manipulated some officials of the Secretariat of the IAEA into forcing "special inspection" against the DPRK.

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honor to request the Security Council to consider the issue on the abuse of Safeguards Agreement by the IAEA at a meeting of the Security Council, if it is convened to consider the issues of implementation of the Safeguards Agreement between the DPRK and the IAEA.

It shall be appreciated if this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
