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DRAFT RESOLUTION (AS OF 4/29)

-- NOTING THE CRITICAL IMPORTANCE OF THE TREATY ON THE NON-PROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS (THE TREATY) TO THE MAINTENANCE OF INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY, AND EMPHASISING THE INTEGRAL ROLE OF INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY [IAEA] SAFEGUARDS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TREATY AND IN ENSURING THE PEACEFUL USES OF NUCLEAR ENERGY;

-- NOTING WITH SATISFACTION THAT THE DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA [DPRK] IS PARTY TO THE TREATY AND HAS CONCLUDED A FULLSCOPE SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT AS REQUIRED BY THAT TREATY;

-- RECALLING THE JANUARY 31, 1992 DECLARATION OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL SUMMIT MEETING THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL WILL TAKE APPROPRIATE MEASURES IN THE CASE OF ANY VIOLATIONS NOTIFIED TO THEM BY THE IAEA;

-- HAVING CONSIDERED WITH REGRET THE LETTER FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE DPRK DATED 12 MARCH 1993 ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL CONCERNING THE INTENTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DPRK TO WITHDRAW FROM THE TREATY;

-- HAVING ALSO CONSIDERED WITH REGRET THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY [IAEA] BOARD OF GOVERNORS' FINDINGS CONTAINED IN ITS RESOLUTION OF 1 APRIL 1993 THAT THE DPRK IS IN NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ITS OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE IAEA-DPRK SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT [INFCIRC/403], AND THAT THE IAEA IS NOT ABLE TO VERIFY THAT THERE HAS BEEN NO DIVERSION OF NUCLEAR MATERIALS REQUIRED TO BE SAFEGUARDED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE IAEA-DPRK SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT TO NUCLEAR WEAPONS OR OTHER NUCLEAR NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVE DEVICES;

-- NOTING THE 1 APRIL 1993 STATEMENT BY THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION, UNITED KINGDOM, AND UNITED STATES WHICH QUESTIONS WHETHER THE DPRK'S STATED REASONS FOR WITHDRAWING FROM THE TREATY CONSTITUTE EXTRAORDINARY EVENTS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THE TREATY;

-- WELCOMING THE JOINT DECLARATION BY THE DPRK AND THE ROK ON THE DENUCLEARISATION OF THE KOREAN PENINSULA, WHICH INCLUDES ESTABLISHMENT OF A CREDIBLE AND EFFECTIVE BILATERAL INSPECTION REGIME AND A PLEDGE NOT TO POSSESS FACILITIES FOR REPROCESSING OR URANIUM ENRICHMENT;

1. CALLS UPON THE DPRK TO REAFFIRM ITS COMMITMENT TO THE TREATY AND TO RETRACT THE ANNOUNCEMENT CONTAINED IN THE LETTER OF 12 MARCH 1993, WHICH HAS SERIOUS IMPLICATIONS FOR REGIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY;

2. FURTHER CALLS UPON THE DPRK TO HONOR ITS NON-PROLIFERATION OBLIGATIONS AND COMPLY WITH ITS SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT WITH THE IAEA AS SPECIFIED BY THE IAEA BOARD OF GOVERNORS' RESOLUTION OF 25 FEBRUARY 1993;

3. REQUESTS THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE IAEA TO CONTINUE TO CONSULT WITH THE DPRK WITH A VIEW TO RESOLVING THE DPRK'S NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ITS SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT AND TO REPORT TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL ON HIS EFFORTS NO LATER THAN ONE (1) MONTH FROM PASSAGE OF THIS RESOLUTION;

4. URGES ALL UN MEMBERS TO ENCOURAGE THE DPRK TO RESPOND POSITIVELY TO THIS RESOLUTION;

5. DECIDES TO REMAIN SEIZED OF THE MATTER AND TO CONSIDER FURTHER SECURITY COUNCIL ACTION IF THE DPRK FAILS TO TAKE ACTION NECESSARY TO RESOLVE CONCERNS ABOUT ITS NUCLEAR PROGRAM.

NORTH KOREA NUCLEAR ISSUE - PRESS THEMES

- o North Korea's non-compliance with its International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) nuclear safeguards obligations, and its announced decision to withdraw from the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) potentially pose a grave threat to peace and stability on the Korean Peninsula and elsewhere.
- o The U.S. has joined the international community pressing North Korea to comply with its treaty commitments and remain a party to the NPT.
- o The U.S. is consulting closely with members of the U.N. Security Council about next steps. The U.N. has available to it a wide range of diplomatic measures from which to choose. The Security Council President's April 8 statement supportive of the IAEA and the NPT was a constructive first step.
- o We have said that we are prepared to play our part in that process.
- o The U.S. remains fully committed to a Korean Peninsula free of nuclear weapons, and to the security of the Republic of Korea.

IF ASKED:

- o We have not ruled out a U.S. meeting with North Korea if it could help resolve the situation.
 - But as we have consistently said, this is an issue between North Korea and the international community, and our task is to support the efforts of the appropriate international bodies in resolving this matter.
