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U.S., ROK and Japan Press Statement
March 3, 1995
2:30 A.M.

The United States, Japan and the Republic of Korea held meetings in Washington, D.C. March 2-3 to finalize plans for the founding of the Korean Peninsula Energy Development Organization (KEDO). Delegations were headed by Ambassador Robert L. Gallucci (USA), Ambassador Tetsuya Endo (Japan) and Ambassador Choi Dong Jin (ROK).

The three governments confirmed that there will be an international conference to prepare for the foundation of KEDO in New York City March 8-9. Approximately 20 countries from Asia, the Pacific, Europe, North America and the Middle East will attend the KEDO Preparatory Conference. The conference, which will be held at the US Mission to the United Nations, will be chaired by Ambassadors Gallucci, Endo and Choi.

On March 9, following the conclusion of the KEDO Preparatory Conference, the U.S., ROK and Japan, as Original Members of KEDO, will sign the KEDO Agreement, thereby establishing KEDO as an International Organization under international law.

The three governments again reaffirmed their full support for the Agreed Framework, and their intention to play a leading role in KEDO, which will provide for the financing and supply of a light water reactor project consisting of two reactors of the Korean standard design, and interim energy to the DPRK, and the implementation of any other measures deemed necessary to accomplish the objectives of the U.S.-DPRK Agreed Framework of October 21, 1994.

The three governments also reaffirmed that the ROK will play the central role in this LWR project, which is the only viable option.
