SUBJ: Reports of American Citizens Leaving Seoul

There is a news ticker item, which is false, that the U.S. Embassy in Seoul has ordered a withdrawal of non-essential personnel.

Embassy Seoul does report, however, that two U.S. firms, RJ Reynolds and Philip Morris, have instructed their expatriate employees in Korea to send dependents home. Additionally, expatriate employees of seven other U.S. firms have voluntarily withdrawn their children from school (the school year ends June 17) to send them out of Korea for summer vacation early. An additional sense of urgency and anxiety may have been created by a statement by an Embassy official to American businessmen that warning of war could be as little as twenty-four hours.

These developments have spawned news reports, including on CNN, and a wave of phone calls to the Department by concerned citizens and businesses. PA also reports that it has heard that the reports are widespread enough they are affecting the financial markets.

Attached is what the Department has been using both as press guidance and to answer direct inquiries from citizens and the business community. We have given a copy to the ROK Embassy.

We do not anticipate issuing a travel warning in the present environment, which we consider normal from a military perspective.

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TRAVEL CONDITIONS IN KOREA 6/9/94
(Statement for inquiries)

There is no change in the military situation on the Korean peninsula, and there is no sign of imminent hostilities. All is normal. U.S. Forces Korea (USFK) continues to closely monitor North Korea.

There has been no travel warning issued, either by the Embassy or the State Department, recommending against travel to Korea or recommending departure from Korea. There has been no order that Embassy personnel should leave Korea.

We understand concern over reports in the media of increased tensions over the Korean peninsula. Taking all available information into account, we do not believe that conditions warrant any special travel precautions at present.

The State Department will issue a "travel warning" when and if we believe such precautions are becoming necessary. This will be well-publicized.

LEAVE KOREA

1. SUMMARY: SOME AMERICAN EMPLOYEES OF US COMPANIES DOING
BUSINESS IN KOREA HAVE REPORTEDLY OPTED TO HAVE THEIR
DEPENDENTS DEPART IMMEDIATELY. THESE ACTIONS HAVE COME ABOUT
IN REACTION TO RISING TENSIONS OVER THE CURRENT SITUATION
WITH NORTH KOREA. IN ONE KNOWN CASE, A CORPORATE
HEADQUARTERS DIRECTED DEPENDENTS TO LEAVE. IN MOST OTHER
CASES, THE DECISION TO LEAVE HAS BEEN VOLUNTARY. END SUMMARY.

2. ON JUNE 2, 1994, POST LEARNED THAT TWO US COMPANIES, R.
J. REYNOLDS (RJR) AND PHILIP MORRIS (PM), HAVE TAKEN ACTIONS

IN RESPONSE TO THE CURRENT SITUATION REGARDING NORTH KOREA.
RJR INSTRUCTED ITS EXPATRIATE EMPLOYEES TO SEND THEIR
DEPENDENTS HOME IMMEDIATELY; THEY WILL DEPART DURING THIS
WEEK (THERE ARE A TOTAL OF SIX DEPENDENTS AFFECTED). THE
EMPLOYEES WILL REMAIN. RSO SPOKE WITH THE RJR EMPLOYEES, AND
THEY STATED THE DECISION WAS MADE BY THEIR CORPORATE
HEADQUARTERS. NO FURTHER DETAILS WERE PROVIDED. PM-SEOUL
STATED THAT THEIR COMPANY ISSUED A TRAVEL ADVISORY TO ALL
EMPLOYEES. THE ADVISORY PERMITTED TRAVEL TO KOREA ONLY IN
URGENT CIRCUMSTANCES. PM-SEOUL WAS ALSO INSTRUCTED TO REVIEW
ITS EVACUATION PLANS. THE LOCAL EXPATRIATE EMPLOYEES WERE
ALSO GIVEN THE OPTION TO SEND THEIR DEPENDENTS HOME
IMMEDIATELY.

3. ON JUNE 9, 1994, SEOUL FOREIGN SCHOOL (SFS) INFORMED POST
THAT PARENTS AFFILIATED WITH THE FOLLOWING COMPANIES HAVE
ELECTED TO WITHDRAW THEIR CHILDREN FROM SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY
AND SEND THEM HOME (FYI: THE SCHOOL YEAR ENDS ON JUNE 17,
1994):

3. SAMSUNG PETRO CHEMICAL (AFFILIATED WITH AMOCO OIL
COMPANY).

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**KOREAN ANNOUNCEMENT ON TEAM SPIRIT '94 EXERCISE
(UNOFFICIAL TRANSLATION)**

The ROK Minister of National Defense and U.S. Secretary of Defense have consulted about the Team Spirit '94 Exercise. They recalled that the ROK and U.S. had agreed to tentatively suspend Team Spirit '94, in accordance with the February 25 agreement between the U.S. and North Korea, so that a third round of U.S.-North Korea talks could be held. The February 25 U.S.-North Korea agreement also provided for the nuclear inspection requested by the IAEA to maintain the continuity of safeguards and for the resumption of South-North dialogue, including the nuclear issue. The ROK and U.S. agreed today to resume planning for Team Spirit '94 and expressed the view that if North Korea does not take the steps agreed to with the U.S. on February 25, then Team Spirit '94 will be held in November. But as the ROK and U.S. have already made clear, if North Korea takes the steps necessary to allow a third round of talks with the U.S., then the ROK and U.S. will again consider suspension of Team Spirit '94.
