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Bosnia Press and Congress

The situation around Gorazde is grim and unpredictable.

We should point out that the Bosnian Serbs violated agreements with respect to Gorazde with both the United Nations and the Russians.

The actions in and around Gorazde is a setback to the momentum that had been achieved through the success of the Sarajevo ultimatum and through the Bosnian-Croat agreement which is holding and has changed the realities on the ground.

The Principals Committee met this morning. We are assessing the options before us to regain the momentum towards a cessation of hostilities and an agreement.

Underscore that whatever we do, this situation will only be resolved through an agreement.

[NOTE: Do not discuss options underconsideration.]

To Congress: Solicit views on what are the limits of actions they would support.
