Public/Congress points

Bosnian Serbs continued shelling of Gorazde today.

They thus violated the NATO decisions and their own promise of a ceasefire.

NATO military authorities therefore recommended air strikes. NATO military commanders have met with UN representatives during the day. (The US agreed with the recommendation. At the President's direction, we have been in touch during the day with NATO, UN, Russian and Allied officials.)

UN officials in Bosnia believe there is evidence that the threat of NATO air strikes is having an effect and the Bosnian Serbs are beginning to move to comply. They wanted to provide them more time to do so.

As NATO Secretary General Woerner said yesterday, UN Secretary General Boutros-Ghali has said that he agrees with NATO's decisions of April 22.

Those NATO decisions stand. We are prepared to act if the Serbs fail to comply.

[To Congress: We are calling because we want you to know that air strikes could well occur.]

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
