We have been asked to search for the following:

1. **All communications with, and working files of, Peter Bourne (White House Science Advisor, Carter Administration) relating to tobacco or smoking and health;**
2. **All documents regarding the Tobacco Working Group (“TWG”) and/or the government’s less hazardous cigarette program, including any research funded or conducted by the U.S. government in conjunction with the TWG or less hazardous cigarette program;**

3. All documents relating to the Interagency Committee on Smoking and Health;
4. All documents concerning Liggett & Myers' proposal during the period of approximately 1975-78 to market the "XA" or "palladium filter" cigarette; and
5. All documents reflecting drafts, reviews, comments, communications, revisions, editing suggestions and other pre-publication communications discussing or referring to the following Surgeon General reports on smoking and health:
 - 1994 *"Preventing Tobacco Use Among Young People: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1989 *"Reducing the Health Consequences of Smoking. 25 Years of Progress: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1988 *"The Health Consequences of Smoking. Nicotine Addiction: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1983 *"The Health Consequences of Smoking. Cardiovascular Disease: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1982 *"The Health Consequences of Smoking. Cancer: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1981 *"The Changing Cigarette: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1979 *"Smoking and Health: A Report of the Surgeon General"*;
 - 1964 *"Smoking and Health: A Report of the Advisory Committee to the Surgeon General."*

A broader directive regarding tobacco and smoking issues will be forthcoming. You should continue to retain any materials regarding tobacco and smoking issues pursuant to my December 8, 1999 memorandum to E.O.P. Office Directors.
