SUBJECT: Information on White House Stenographers

In response to your questions of October 7, 1996, regarding nine contract stenographer personnel, the White House Communications Agency (WHCA) reviewed contractor invoice information dating back to December 1988:

Ms. Collins, Ms. Dirolf, Ms. Olcott, and Ms. Suntum were contract stenographers prior to January 1993; they still perform stenographic services under the terms of the current contract.

Ms. Horel and Ms. Leander were also contract stenographers prior to January 1993, but are no longer employed by the current contractor. WHCA contract records indicate Ms. Horel departed in May 1994, and Ms. Leander departed in August 1996.

Ms. Dumm, Ms. Mirabella, and Ms. Rogers worked as contract stenographers prior to April 1990; WHCA records show they have not worked as contract stenographers after that date. Last pay entry shown for Ms. Dumm is October 1989, Ms. Mirabella is April 1990, and Ms. Rogers is January 1990.

The WHCA is the administrator and contracting officer's representative for the White House stenographic support contract; however, the White House Press Office controls utilization, scheduling, and workload of the stenographers. The current contractor, Diversified Reporting Services, has been providing stenographic support since November 1992. KOBA provided services prior to November 1992.

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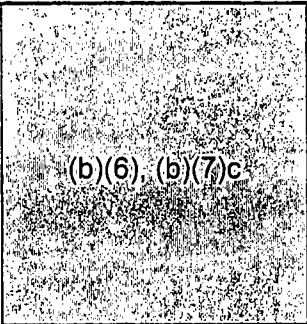
