[001] One clarification: I understand that HPSCI Majority has in fact finished their report and may send it to CIA as a "legislative privileged" document for CIA's declassification review alone. I have conferred with P3/(b)(3); we are in agreement that any such request would be inappropriate.

The classification issues cut-across agencies. As CIA is part of the executive branch and the appropriate request is for executive branch declassification review, any classification review should be conducted by inter-agency declassification experts from State, Defense and CIA who will make determinations on behalf of the executive branch. I coordinated this process last week for the SSCI report. While enormously time consuming, it worked. This same corporate knowledge should be utilized in reviewing any other related documents for national security information.

IRAQ: Deutsch appeared before SSCI today on Iraq. They then had a closed session with Downing on Khobar Towers.

-- Understand there was a dust up about DCI statement to the effect that Saddam is in a stronger political position in the North in response to a question from Sen. Cohen.

-- Johnston said that protecting Kurds is not in our national interest.

-- Lugar asked why Iraq's territorial integrity is important.

-- SFRC refused a closed briefing with Christopher tomorrow.

-- I called all L-ship staff, letting them know that Tony is available to talk with their bosses.

FOREIGN OPS: We are working closely with COS office, State, OMB on outstanding issues-- language and money. As reported last night, this will likely be in the CR.

BOSNIA-IRAN: HPSCI report now completed. CIA will work on declass issue. Haven't read it yet.

HAITI: Gilman subpoena and press conference this afternoon. Alan meets with Combust and Dicks at 9 AM tomorrow. Fulton and I will go with him.

-- Burton briefing lasted about 15 minutes. No press, no other members, no transcript.

-- Interagency meeting at State on Haiti notifications today to decide how to deal with holds. Will offer briefings next week, but this will, needless to say, be very difficult to work.

COMSATS/HOT SECTIONS: Got regs cleared through OMB and should be ready tomorrow to send them along with notification and reply to Gilman letter to President.

TUNA-DOLPHIN: Meeting today to discuss potential strategy for passage this year. Meeting was attended by WH, CEQ, OVP, NSC USTR. Sen Breaux has called the VP and requested a letter from him to the Senate L-ship. The VP will

respond and give the Breaux Bill our support. Sen Boxer has been saying that the Mexican tuna boats are a "front" for drug runners. Prior to the possible sending of a letter from the VPr, McCaffrey will assess this assertion and get the info back to us.

COUNTER-TERRORISM: Steve Simon briefed staff of HCONS on PDD-39 and our efforts to stem terrorism. They are looking for our help in educating Members on the infrastructure that we have in place and our continuing efforts to stem terrorism. They told us that much more Hill emphasis is likely to be placed on this issue next year. This was also a prep session for them, as the HCONS R&D Sub will be getting a closed brief tomorrow from DOD (Holmes) and State (Wilcox). This Sub Brief was requested by Harman, and agreed to by Weldon.

ECONOMIC ESPIONAGE: Senate passed by voice vote on Wed night. An interagency team will brief the House tomorrow morning on what we need in the Conference Bill.
