Statement by Dee Dee Myers
June 29, 1996

Gary Alrich's book, "Unlimited Access," is so replete with factual errors that nothing in it can be taken seriously. In the brief passage about me, much of what he says is demonstrably false.

Mr. Aldrich alleges that Craig Livingstone asked me how I would respond to press questions about my security clearance at a senior staff meeting attended by the President. No such meeting ever occurred. Craig Livingstone was not a member of the senior staff and to my knowledge never attended a senior staff meeting. I don't remember ever seeing Craig at any meeting where the President was present. And he certainly never asked me anything about my security clearance in front of the President.

Mr. Aldrich also writes that when the failure of some members of the White House staff, including myself, to receive the necessary clearances was first reported by the Washington Post, I answered questions about my own situation and offered assurances that "positive steps were being taken" to clear up the problem." He then states that the press never followed up to see what steps were actually being taken. But even a cursory review of contemporaneous briefing transcripts and newspaper stories proves this is false.

Finally, Mr. Aldrich's account is so sloppy that he boots even the most insignificant facts. He alleges I grew up in the San Fernando Valley next door to an FBI agent. Wrong on both counts.

If Mr. Aldrich can't even be counted on to get the easy stuff right, why should anyone believe a word he has to say about anything else?

I have just had an opportunity to review the four pages of Gary Aldrich's new book Unlimited Access which deal with me and my appointment to the Commission on the Roles and Capabilities of the U.S. Intelligence Community in late 1994. While I cannot speak to the allegations Aldrich makes elsewhere in his book about other individuals, I can state unequivocally that the section about me is absolutely and demonstrably slanderous and contains numerous actionable falsehoods. I am currently reviewing legal options with my attorneys, and I fully intend to pursue legal action against Aldrich and his publisher.

To cite just one of the most egregious examples, Aldrich claims that I take "a daily dose of a downer called . . . Quaalude. This drug, known to most boomers as 'ludes,' has the effect of producing a feeling of 'inner peace,' while removing *all* normal inhibitions. It's the drug of choice for seducers or those who want to be seduced." In fact, I have *never* taken Quaaludes or any other illegal drugs in my life. I *do* take a daily dose of Phenobarbital, which my doctor has prescribed to control my epilepsy. To add insult to injury, Aldrich later refers to my "'alleged' medical reasons" for taking this medication.

It seems to me that Gary Aldrich's abuse of confidential F.B.I. files for his own personal financial gain in the form of this book is the *real* file scandal in Washington today. In the short section that deals with me, Aldrich uses lies, innuendoes and other falsehoods to prop up his otherwise insupportable conclusions.

If the section of Aldrich's book about me is any indication of the book as a whole, then Unlimited Access is complete garbage and is not worth the paper it is printed on.

My novel, Juggling, was not a how-to book for teens on sex, and I never told Gary Aldrich that it was. If anything, it was a how-not-to book on teen sex -- a cautionary tale. The book was widely praised and won several awards, including the American Library Association's coveted Best Book Award in 1982 for excellence in young adult fiction.

There are two other inaccuracies in Aldrich's account. He says that I left Bentsen's office after writing the book. In fact, I wrote the book seven years before going to work for Senator Bentsen. He also says the book caused a "firestorm" in Texas. As far as I know, there was no reaction at all in Texas. I wish there had been; maybe I'd have sold more copies before the book went out of print years ago.

I am particularly offended by his distorted description of Doing Time, which was also an award winning book. If he really can't imagine anyone in law enforcement agreeing with my conclusions, he need look no further than the jacket of the book -- which prominently displays the endorsements of David Fogel, former Commisisoner of Corrections of the State of Minnesota and Executive Director of the Illinois Law Enforcement Commission and Jerome Miller, former Commissioner of Youth Services for Pennsylvania and then Massachusetts.

I have been a long-time resident of Washington D.C. and was familiar with the Easter Egg Roll as a cherished tradition of the White House. Mr. Aldrich's account is a complete fabrication.

Each year since President Clinton's inauguration, the White House has invited artists from around the nation to participate in decorating the White House Christmas trees by sending handmade ornaments to the White House. One of my responsibilities is to personally screen each of the thousands of ornaments received to determine whether it is suitable for display on the White House trees. I screen the ornaments not once, but twice. In 1994, I identified and removed two ornaments inappropriate for the White House trees in the first screening process in October. Thus, I ensured that no offensive ornaments were laid out for decorating teams to put on the trees at the beginning of December. It is simply not true that the numerous offensive ornaments mentioned in Mr. Aldrich's book were ever received by the White House, apart from the two that I removed in the screening process in October, and certainly never were or ever would be considered for hanging on the White House trees.
