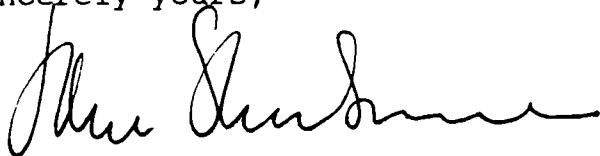

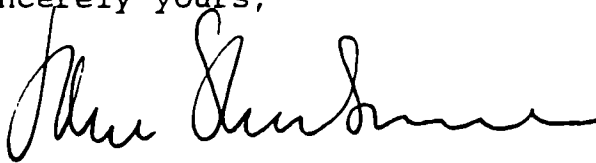

Quinn, Jane Sherburne, Beth Nolan, Cliff Mauton, Christopher Cerf, Trey Schroeder, Ed Hughes, Jonathan Denbo, Mari Anderson or Ms. Lisa Wetzel regarding --

1. Procedures for the updating of White House passes;
2. Security clearance procedures and the use of FBI background files requested by or on behalf of the White House Office of Personnel Security; or
3. The operation of the Office of Personnel Security.

The request, as we understand it, does not require production of your Personal Data Statement & Questionnaire or communications with the Office of Personnel Security about individual matters. In addition, you need not produce at this time any routine requests for White House passes or requests for security clearances prepared in the ordinary course of business.

We respectfully ask that the Judiciary Committee follow these precedents and excuse Mr. Marceca from appearing at today's hearing.

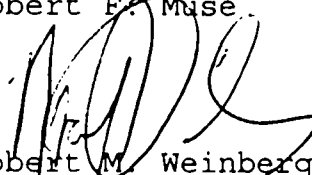

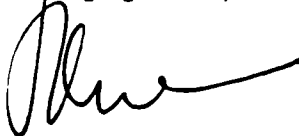
This letter is to confirm my oral request to you on June 26, 1996 that you undertake to determine which, if any, individuals on a list of 216 names have been GSA employees (or contractors) and, if so, whether the assignment of each on the date entered next to their name required access to the White House compound.

The list, which I telecopied to you, was attached to a June 25, 1996 letter from FBI General Counsel Howard Shapiro to Deputy Independent Counsel John Bates explaining that the White House made requests to the FBI for previous background reports related to these individuals. As I indicated (and as the attached letter from Mr. Bates confirms), we have been asked by the Independent Counsel to determine whether these requests were legitimate. In order to make such a determination, we need to know whether the assignment of each of these individuals required access to the White House compound at the time the White House requested background reports.

I informed the Independent Counsel that we believe most, if not all, of the 216 names are or were GSA employees and that we had requested the assistance of GSA in making the requested determination. In response to your request, we are working with the Independent Counsel to find an appropriate and efficient way to obtain the social security numbers of those listed.

Dear Ms. Sherburne:

Yesterday we received a letter from Howard M. Shapiro, General Counsel of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, which described "another alphabetical series of reports from the White House to the FBI for previous background reports." Mr. Shapiro explained that the series is dated between October 29 and November 26, 1993, and that it includes 216 requests. He enclosed a listing of names that the FBI identified as being part of the series of requests.

Mr. Shapiro's letter explained that "there is no way to determine from FBI records whether the White House had a legitimate need for these reports at the time these requests were made." We request that you provide, as soon as possible, your assessment as to whether the White House did have a legitimate need for the reports cited by Mr. Shapiro yesterday, and the reasoning for your conclusion.

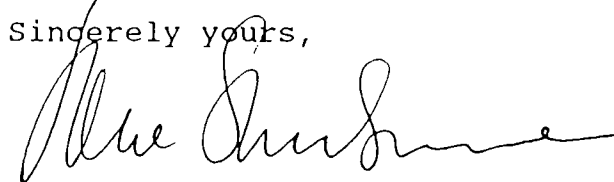

In accordance with the representation I made yesterday in my letter transmitting the bulk of the White House records you requested from the FBI, enclosed is a copy of the Update Project file you also requested. (CGE 48229-48342.) I understand we have now provided you with all of the White House records you requested from the FBI. Please let me know if you have a contrary understanding.

Let me clarify the misapprehension reflected in your letter of today to Mr. Quinn. On June 6, 1996, the White House provided the FBI with three boxes of material, two of which contained primarily FBI files and a third that contained what appeared to be miscellaneous files. We did not examine the contents of the boxes other than to identify file labels so we were not able to determine whether the third box contained material in which the FBI would have an interest. Erring on the side of caution, we decided to provide the entire box to the FBI and the FBI agreed to provide us with a copy. Contrary to the assumption in your letter, we did not just receive this material yesterday (although the FBI inexplicably did provide us with another copy). Rather, the FBI provided us with a copy within a few days of June 6, 1996. Mr. Shapiro's letter transmitting this material is attached.

When contacted by the FBI on July 3, 1996, we were simply asked whether the White House had any objection to the production of certain White House records to the Committee. We were not told when the Committee had made its request or that the Committee was expecting to receive such material on July 3,

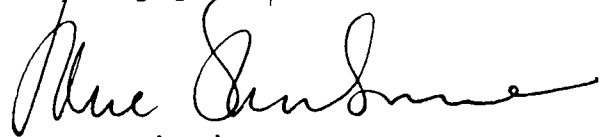

I am enclosing substantially all White House documents collected pursuant to the Subcommittee's document request of June 18, 1996 (Bate Nos. L 00580-L01202).

A very small number of documents have been withheld at this point because they appear to be subject to a claim of executive privilege. These documents include a number of handwritten notes by the President, a memorandum prepared by a White House senior advisor for the President, and notations made by the President in the margins of a newspaper article. With respect to these documents, we propose to follow the protocol set out in my July 11, 1996 letter to you whereby Chairman McCollum and Ranking Member Schumer and/ or their designated staff will review the documents in camera.

There is also a vetting file for Arthur Coia containing highly confidential information gathered in connection with the vetting process. We will need to discuss further the treatment to be given to this type of sensitive material.

Finally, in collecting responsive documents to the Subcommittee's request, we have received various printed matter published by LIUNA. At this point, we have merely included in the document submission a copy of the cover page of such material. If you are interested in reviewing the remainder of these catalogues and brochures, we will provide the materials to you.
