Dear Leon:


As you suggested, we have been discretely assessing the status of current U.S. private sector sponsored energy/environmental projects in China to plan how TDA might proceed when authority is given. We have not contacted any U.S. company directly and have worked with Commerce, DOE, State and Ex-Im as our sources of information.

We offer the following for your information:

- TDA will focus on 12 identified projects with a total investment of \$4.4 billion and an estimated U.S. export potential of \$1.6 billion (breakdown attached).
- Assuming clearance is given 10 days prior to the anticipated February visit by Chinese officials, TDA will work with the U.S. companies involved with the projects to determine if there is an appropriate TDA role.
- With the assistance of DOE, the Chinese will be advised of the projects we are most interested in, allowing them to provide additional information to us on which we can base our investment strategy.
- During the visit, the list of projects will be further refined in discussions with the Chinese to determine their priorities. At the same time, we will seek to reach preliminary agreement on the specific TDA assistance that would move the projects forward.
- Similarly, we will agree on the best timing for a TDA visit to China and the specific offers and acceptances which will be made during the visit. Hopefully, the visit will take place within 30 to 45 days of the February visit, and conceivably be part of a more comprehensive USG mission which evidences follow-through on the Initiative.
- At the same time we will work with Ex-Im Bank on the design of the \$50 million proposed financing facility and begin to plan a USG sponsored, private sector driven, project finance conference to be held in China.

DOE, Commerce and the individual companies all believe TDA assistance is necessary. We are ready to do our part to make the U.S.-China Strategic Environmental and Energy Initiative a success.
