[FBIS Transcribed Text] Osaka, Nov. 14 KYODO -- In a bid for early membership of the World Trade Organization (WTO), Taiwan will hold active bilateral talks in Osaka with other members of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) forum, Taiwanese delegation sources said Tuesday [14 November].

Chiang Pin-kung, Taiwanese minister of economic affairs, arrived in Osaka on Monday night to attend a two-day APEC ministerial meeting opening Thursday.

Chiang met with Rizalino Navarro, Philippine secretary of trade and industry, on Tuesday and plans to hold separate talks with ministers from Canada, Thailand, Australia and other APEC members from Wednesday, the sources said.

Chiang also plans to meet with U.S. Trade Representative Mickey Kantor and Commerce Secretary Ron Brown, the sources said.

Chiang referred to the possibility that he will also meet with Japanese trade minister Ryutaro Hashimoto.

Taiwan applied in 1990 for membership in the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, the predecessor of the WTO, and reduced tariffs on 758 items in July as part of its market-opening measures to comply with WTO policy.

A Taiwanese delegation source said the largest bottleneck for Taiwan's WTO membership is not economic issues but China's insistence that China and Taiwan should join the organization at the same time.

Taiwan's bilateral talks with other APEC members are expected to focus on that point, the source said.

[FBIS Transcribed Text] Osaka, Japan, November 18 (XINHUA) -- The trade ministers of China and the United States discussed here today a U.S. "road map" as the basis for China's accession to the newly established World Trade Organization (WTO), Chinese trade officials said.

Chinese Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation Minister Wu Yi and U.S. Trade Representative Mickey Kantor met for three hours in Osaka, where they attended the seventh ministerial meeting of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) forum.

During the talks, Wu gave Kantor the Chinese Government's response to the 30-page document presented to China last week by the United States.

After the meeting, Wu stressed that China would continue to make efforts to promote the process of its accession to the WTO, informed Chinese trade officials said.

"I believe that we will be able to sit down for objective and pragmatic talks on each of particular issues and work together effectively over a series of bilateral and multilateral issues if both sides bear in mind the strategic meaning of China's joining in the WTO to the two nations and to the development of global economy and development," one official quoted Wu as saying.

The trade minister hoped that the momentum of bilateral trade and investment will be maintained and that cooperation will be expanded between the two countries.
