gives remarks, followed by the Premier (3-5 minutes each; simultaneous interpretation). Qs and As are taken; consecutive interpretation).

4:30 p.m. Press Avail ends. President Clinton and Premier Zhu Rongji exit stage and proceed to the Holding Room, remaining briefly while members of the Chinese Delegation are escorted to their motorcade on West Executive Avenue.

4:35 p.m. President Clinton escorts Premier Zhu Rongji to his motorcade and bids farewell.

The President returns to the Oval Office.
