During a press conference on crime in Omaha, Nebraska this week, Jimmy Wilson, Sr. met Senator Bob Dole and discussed his foundation, the James B. Wilson Foundation. Mr. Wilson is a retired police officer, and his son, Jimmy Wilson, Jr., was the Omaha law enforcement officer killed by gang members in September 1995 during a routine traffic stop. Mr. Wilson, Sr. has since raised \$800,000 toward his goal of equipping all police vehicles in Nebraska with video cameras.

According to Fred Zwonechek, Administrator of the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety, who attended the Omaha press conference and spoke with Mr. Wilson, Senator Dole allegedly indicated he would earmark \$2,000,000 of Section 402 funds to support the \$2,500,000 needed to finish equipping all police cars in Nebraska. Mr. Wilson informed Senator Dole that he would personally raise the additional \$500,000. Fred stated that Mr. Wilson joined Senator Dole on his private jet back to Washington D.C., where Mr. Wilson participated in the National Memorial honoring fallen police officers. Mr. Wilson was also trying to arrange to speak to President Clinton while in Washington.

Additional Information: Over the past several months, Fred's office has formulated an agreement to partner with the James B. Wilson Foundation and assist local agencies in the purchase of cameras by providing 50 to 80 percent of the total equipment cost with Section 402 dollars. The foundation pays for 20 percent of the costs.

BACKGROUND: The Oklahoma City tragedy challenged the notion of providing federal
employees with a safe place for them to leave their children while they
are at work. This event will go a long way to reassure federal
employees that they do not need to think twice when they leave their
children at GSA run day care centers.

The 100th Center will open at USDA's new facility in Riverdale,
Maryland. The center will accommodate about 70 children in a site
that is close to the University of Maryland and within sight of the new
College Park Metro Stop.

GSA Day Care Centers have an excellent record. 50% of GSA centers
are now professionally accredited, compared to the national average of
5%. The federal government also has the largest system of on-site
child care for working parents in the country.
