Dear First Lady:

As Chairman of Young Astronauts Council, and as a Co-Host of The 2000 Violence Prevention for Juveniles - Education Program Campaign: *Universal Sportsmanship*, it is my pleasure to write this letter to you, a Co-Chairperson of Young Astronauts Council, on behalf of our campaign.

Pursuant to the telephone conversation Ms. Ann O'Leary had with my campaign staff yesterday, I am herein sending you the material on our violence prevention campaign, and I would like to suggest that you consider an area of prevention for violence that involves active participation of parents, teachers and children themselves.

The purpose of our violence prevention campaign is to provide an early education for our children now so that violence will be phased out as these educated juveniles grow up and proceed through junior and high school, and college. Scheduled to be launched on March 22, 2000 at the National Press Club in Washington, D. C., the participants of our campaign include various prominent people, teachers in charge of the children's education at school, and parents in charge of their kids' education at home. Our campaign targets the 28,000,000 elementary students, their 42,000,000 parents, and the 1,700,000 teachers of this Nation.

This campaign will provide a violence prevention program to help our children to develop and increase their decision-making power and to implant ethical principles to our children. It will help them to control their tempers, to respect one another, and to reject and avoid any form of violence through self-discipline. This campaign advocates for an education program for self-management.

Our campaign contains a tri-partite video/motion-picture program-- an ***individual program*** from which a child can educate herself, a ***school program*** from which a child can learn with his peers, and a ***family program*** from which the entire family can learn together. Distributed ***free of charge***, these programs will be produced and distributed through television broadcasting, computer websites, videotapes, CDs and books. They will contain valuable lessons not taught in our schools' regular curricula and will assist the busy parents not able to do more at-home teaching for their children.

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According to the October edition of the Journal of the Chicago University, the financial loss related to violence in the U.S. is a staggering 1.7 trillion dollars (about the same as the 1.85 trillion dollars owed by the U.S. public in their house mortgages). Violence prevention is thus a critical and serious matter that deserves fundamental measures.

As we proceed with this Campaign, we would like to know what type of specific policies you uphold or support for prevention of youth violence. It is our campaign's policy that this campaign shall reflect our national leader's opinions. We are sending our campaign material in the hope that they will give you a better idea about our efforts.

LaJaycee Brown in the White House Women's Office suggested that we write to invite the First Lady to speak at a unique gathering of educators, legislators, and policy makers in New York City on October 5-6 to examine ways to fiscally strengthen our public schools.

Ms. Brown informed us that President Clinton has endorsed a conference that we are holding in September on "Girls, Women & Money," which is focused on helping girls and women improve their financial lives and empower themselves through financial literacy.

Ms. Brown thought the First Lady might be interested in speaking at our "Reengineering Public School Finance" conference that will be held in New York City, October 5-6, 2000.

The "Reengineering Public School Finance" conference focuses on strengthening public schools in New York City and across the nation. This is the first conference to examine new financial solutions and alternative funding methods for public schools. The conference explores school budgets as tools for improving student achievement, decentralized school budgeting, new ways of funding schools and technology, funding sources for performance-based schools, and innovative cost-effective on-line courses for schools.

The conference includes keynotes by Tom Vander Ark, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation; Thomas Jandris, Division Director, Education Commission of the States; and Benno Schmidt, Chairman, Edison Schools. Attendees will also visit PS #20, a New York City magnet elementary school that has integrated the arts in its curriculum to improve student achievement, meet state standards, and develop social skills in children.

Since the First Lady is such a strong supporter of education and children, we hope that she can address this unique gathering of educators.

We appreciate all the support the President and First Lady have provided at our past conferences and hope this will continue. The First Lady welcomed attendees through a video-taped address at our 1999 "Learning & the Brain" conference, which brought neuroscientists and educators together to improve childhood education.
