SUBJECT: Haiti leg. strategy for Lake-Christopher-Perry meeti

We made calls on the opening of Guantanamo to process refugees this evening (Tuesday evening).

On Tuesday, June 28, Bill Gray, along with representatives from AID and DOD, testified before the SFRC Western Hemisphere Subcommittee. On Wednesday, June 29, Sen. Graham has requested a classified briefing with members of the SSCI. CIA, DOD and State have been asked to participate. On Thursday, June 30, Secretary Christopher testifies before SFRC. It is also quite possible that the Secretary will be asked about the situation in Haiti.

In addition to these two public appearances, HFAC has requested a staff level briefing on UNMIH and related issues this week. If the Foreign Operations Appropriations bill is taken up by the Senate this week, we can expect a Dole amendment on Haiti, requiring a Congressional authorization before any troops are deployed to Haiti.

Over the next week or so, we will make calls to the Hill to discuss the situation in Haiti and to take the temperature of members on Haiti. Beyond these initial conversations, we are discussing with other agencies the possibility of putting together an interagency high level briefing team once a decision on UNMIH has been made. This would include State, USUN, DOD and OMB.

I just had a long conversation with Rick Schwartz regarding getting these NGOs who support our Haiti safe haven policy in touch with reporters and more publicly visible.

1. Note for Tony and Sandy:

We, along with State, DoJ and DoD, made calls to our Cuba call list on the transfer of migrants from Gitmo to Panama and Suriname. The only reaction was to thank us for the heads up.

HFAC wants a staff briefing on Thursday on progress of talks, situation in Gitmo and next steps with regard to our policy. This may be a bit too speculative for a staff briefing. They would like Mort to do the briefing. Please advise.

DoJ has indicated that they are getting serious concerns from some Members on her statement that she will use parole authority to bring in immigrants from Cuba that reportedly reflects the U.S. position in the talks. Please advise.

Mort, Joe Velasquez and I met with Rep. Docilely this afternoon-- Joe set up the meeting. Torricelli talked a bit about his recent trip to Gitmo and had some suggestions about what we can do to force Castro's hand. I'm sure Mort will share those ideas with you that he feels are useful. I walked Rep. Torricelli to his car on 17th Street, and he had a group of reporters waiting for him.

Sen. Dodd wants to go to Havana-- not Gitmo-- Sept. 14-19. He wants to bring a staffer, wants a DoD plane and wants a DoD escort. State indicated that such decisions are done on a case by case basis. We should let State know of our thoughts on this.

Dr. Perry is meeting with Inouye and Murtha tomorrow and Nunn next week to discuss Cuba.

We will make calls tomorrow on the Taiwan PDD. We have coordinated with State on talking points and the call list. In addition to Sandy's call to Sen. Rockefeller, we will call the leadership, Rep. Pelosi and Sen. Roth.

DoD aprops conference should be meeting at a staff level soon, probably next week. Members are scheduled to meet the week of the 19th and the floor the following week. All this is, of course, subject to change.

Alan Kreczko and I are going to meet with Ed Jurith from the Drug Tsar's office tomorrow to discuss what we might do to head off any potential problems in the DoD aprops conference on shutdown legislation. We don't know of specific amendments or language, we only know that Sen. Wallop has a problem with Administration proposed language changes.

Spoke to Leahy's staffer, Tim Reiser, who is a good friend, about a number of things, and he raised with me two Haiti migration issues: whether Haitian migration is a refugee issue that should tap refugee monies, and whether ERMA reimbursement of DOD is appropriate.

I made two points to him:

first, that use of refugee monies for the Haiti operation is appropriate, as this is as much a response to a refugee crisis as an immigration control effort (Berman's staffer, Amit Pandya, has argued that this is an immigration control issue that should not use ERMA monies at all).

Moreover, I added that even if this was more a migration than a refugee issue, it was still a migration emergency that made ERMA funding appropriate.

second, on the reimbursement of DOD issue, I explained that if we want DOD to be available to deal with emergencies when we need them, we also need to make sure they don't foot all the bill -- and in fact, they will in this instance use a great deal of their O and M monies even with a State reimbursement. Tim seemed reasonable, and while he is not comfortable with ERMA being used to reimburse, I think he would be willing to agree to some sort of arrangement in this regard based on the concern I laid out.
